














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

Team responded to a *Medical Incident* at Gamu, Cockpit Arena, Upi, Gamu, Isabela last *December 01, 2021*. The patient experienced elevated blood pressure, dizziness, vomited several times. After immediate intervention the patient was brought to City Ilagan Medical Center (CIMC) for proper disposition.







Team responded to a *Medical Incident* at California Homes Subdivision, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela last *December 05, 2021*. The patient was conscious and coherent, vaginal bleeding with fever and chills. Accordingly she suffered post dilation and curettage last November 15, 2021. After immediate intervention the patient was brought to Isabela Doctor's General Hospital (IDGH) for proper disposition.









Team responded a *Trauma Incident* (Vehicular Incident) (SUV v/s Sedan) at Linglingay, Gamu, Isabela last *December 17, 2021*. The patient was possible fracture at mandile, avulsion at chin area at left part. 
