The patient suffered pain at left shoulder with possible fracture or dislocation, laceration at left part of the forehead and left cheek, abrasion at left knee. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Trauma Incident** at Brgy. Dammao. Gamu, Isabela, involving motorcycle (honda XRM 125 vs hand tractor) last **July 13, 2022**. After immediate intervention the patient was brought to GFNDyMH.
