


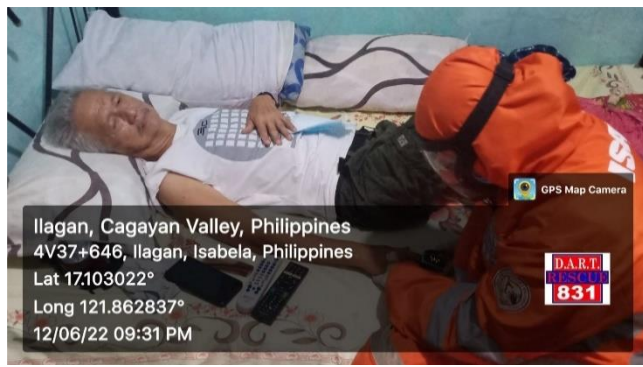


Team responded a **Trauma Incident** at Infront of IDGH, Baligatan, City of Ilagan, Isabela involving Tmx 125 vs Suzuki smash 125 last **June 01, 2022**. The patient suffered laceration at back part of the head (approximately 1 inch) contusion at back part of the head, abrasion at both knee and knuckles, positive alcohol intake as verbalize by the victim. After immediate intervention the patient was brought to GFNDyMH.



Team responded a **Trauma Incident** at Infront of Department of Agriculture Office, Upi Gamu, Isabela last **June 14, 2022**. The patient suffered abrasions at left leg, both knees and upper lip. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



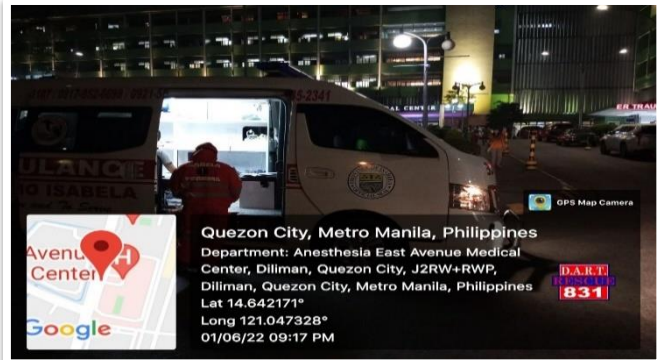

The patient conscious and coherent, accordingly he suffered dizziness, vomited once, weak and pale in appearance. History of hypertension. After immediate intervention the patient was brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.

The patient suffering body weakness, sudden lost of consciousness and under influence of liquor as verbalized by the significant others. After immediate intervention the patient was brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.





PDRRMO/DART 831 provided **Medical Evacuation (MEDEVAC)** to a patient conscious and coherent, pain at left ear with presence of pus. Diagnosed with Squamous cell carcinoma at left ear canal. The patient was transferred from Baligatan City of Ilagan to East Avenue Medical Center, Diliman, Quezon City last **June 01, 2022**.
