








The Office continuously conduct *daily disinfection and thorough cleaning* of work places, most especially ambulances and other office vehicles as well as the rescuers themselves after an emergency response to prevent the spread of the virus.





Team responded a *Trauma Incident* Infront of Kape Ilocano Brgy. Baligatan, City of Ilagan, Isabela last *December 17, 2023*. The patient was conscious but not coherent (unable to gather information due to excessive liquor intake), he suffered laceration on chin approximately 3-4 inces. Driving Under the Influence of alcohol (DUI) as verbalized by the victim. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDY Sr. Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.





Team responded a *Trauma Incident* Infront of Ropali, Brgy. Baligatan, City of Ilagan, Isabela last *December 24, 2023*. The patient suffered abrasion and contusion on left cheek. Driving Under the Influence of alcohol (DUI) as verbalized by the patient. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDY Sr. Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.





Team responded a *Trauma Incident* Infront of Andoks, Brgy. Baligatan, City of Ilagan, Isabela last *December 25, 2023*. The patient was conscious and coherent with GCS 15, he suffered laceration of right lower leg approximately 2 cm. Driving Under the Influence of liquor (gin) verbalized by the patient. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDY Sr. Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.
