The patient suffering abrasion on left part of forehead and both knuckle, laceration on the back of the head, left middle finger and right waist. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a *Trauma Incident* Infront of Queen Isabela Park, Brgy. Alibagu, City of Ilagan Isabela last **June 26, 2023**. The patient was conscious and coherent. Accordingly, he suffering chest pain with pain scale 7/10. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.
