Team responded a *Trauma Incident* at Francisca Village, Baligatan, City of Ilagan, Isabela last *August 14, 2022.* The patient Conscious and coherent, abrasion at left check, left arm, and left knee with swelling. Under influence of alcohol (Gin) as verbalized by the victim. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.

Bliss Village, City of Ilagan, Isabela last *August 08, 2022.* The patient diagnosed COPD (Pneumonia), accordingly he suffered difficulty of breathing, blurring of vision. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.








