RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ISABELA, REPRESENTED BY THE GOVERNOR, HON. RODOLFO T. ALBANO, III, FOR THE PROCUREMENT THROUGH SHOPPING OF COVID-19 ANTIGEN RAPID TEST LATERAL FLOW METHOD TO BE AWARDED TO ISAIAH 8:15 ENTERPRISES FOR VARIOUS RECIPIENT IN THE PROVINCE USE

WHEREAS, Rule XVI Section 52.1(b) of R.A 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, provides for Shopping as an Alternative Method of Procurement of Goods;

WHEREAS, Shopping is a method of Procurement of Goods whereby the Procuring Entity simply requests for the submission of price quotations for readily available off-the-shelf goods or ordinary/regular equipment to be procured directly from suppliers of known qualifications;

WHEREAS, Section 52.3 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations requires at least three (3) price quotations from bona fide suppliers shall be obtained;

WHEREAS, Section 52.1(b) of the RIRR which provides that the procurement of ordinary or regular office supplies and equipment not available in the Procurement Service involving an amount not exceeding the thresholds prescribed in Annex "H" of this IRR have been complied;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE RESOLVES AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED TO RECOMMEND THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ISABELA, REPRESENTED BY THE GOVERNOR, HON. RODOLFO T.
