FARMERS' CONGRESS REPORT September 23, 2015 Roxas, Isabela

The registration started upon arrival of participants coming from the twenty-six (26) Barangay of Roxas. The program started around 8:40 in the morning with a prayer followed by the singing of the national anthem and Isabela Hymn. Subsequently, Mr. John Soriano has begun introducing the different services the Province offers. Afterwhich, FO1 Prejilliana of Bureau of Fire Protection informed the participants on precautions regarding the occurrence of Fire. He also discussed about the different types of fire and its several sources and concluded that it's not that being burned of what leads to death but the smoke that suffocates us on the said occurrence not only about fires but also calamities preparedness and having knowledge about the unpredictable occurrence of earthquakes. The PDRRMC Rescue Team also taught first-aid and the proper way of reviving a patient when heart attack occurs to someone. Dietician Heralda Cabrera also shared information concerning about the health of every individual. Provincial Cooperative Officer Lilia Castillo, stress out the different services the Government of Isabela offers and gave some insights for the participants to be aware and what can they availed. The said services are the following, to start, in Agriculture (BROs ASP, PPP, PSP, LAMFP, PAIWI and livelihood); Health (BROs Healthcare & PhilHealth); Insurance (BROs PNB Gen & SSS); Scholarship (BRO Education) for their children and Nutrition (BRO Lusog) the new service offered by the provincial government to ensure that the their children receives the right nutrition.

Soon as the Provincial Governor Hon. Faustino G. Dy III arrived at the venue, the Municipal Mayor, Hon. Benedicto Calderon gave his welcome address to all the participants and thanking them for their overwhelming support in the local government. The Governor then delivered his most awaited message where he highlighted the services for marginalize farmers which include the 3 P's, Pantawid Pamasahe Program and looking forward for the Cityhood of Roxas, Isabela.

Subsequently, the presentation of other services continued just after the speech. The ENR Office through its focal person formally opened the table to serve the participants regarding environmental concerns and issues.

The ENR Office was able to serve **Two-hundred fifty eight (258)** clientele from 26 Barangay and disposed a total of **Two-hundred fifty (250)** assorted fruit bearing seedlings and 8 packs of fertilizer to wit:
