FARMERS' CONGRESS REPORT September 11, 2015 San Guillermo, Isabela

Upon the arrival of the Isabela Provincial Government Employee, 7:00 in the morning, the registration immediately started. The ENR Office opened the table for the distribution of seedlings at around 7:40 A.M, few minutes later, the opening program begun, headed by the different LGU personnel. Information Officer John Soriano introduced the different services of the Province that can be availed in the community. Therewith, starting from Agriculture (BROs ASP, PPP, PSP, LAMFP, PAIWI and livelihood); Health (BROs Healthcare &PhilHealth); Insurance (BROs PNB Gen & SSS); Scholarship (BRO Education) for their children and Nutrition (BRO Lusog) the new service offered by the provincial government to combat obesity and malnutrition. He also educated the participants about Earthquake Preparedness and followed by the demonstration of the safety measures during earthquake, then later they showcase a video presentation concerning the 3 principles of safety survey which include getting under and or beside, identifying safe places and practicing. Lastly he tress out to always keep our eyes open. Afterwhich, Provincial Health Officer, Dra. Arlene Lazaro discussed Bro Lusog to Combat obesity, starzation and Malnutrition.

Governor Faustino "Bojie" G. Dy III arrived at 10:30 a.m. accompanied by the LGU of San Guillermo together with Mayor Marilou Sanchez and Board member Karen Abuan. Subsequently Mayor Sanchez delivered her welcome address, acknowledging Governor Faustino G. Dy III and the rest Focal Persons of the said event. After Mayor Sanchez speech, Gov. Bojie Dy, III turn to deliver his message. He gave thanks to the people of San Guillermo for their warm welcome to him. His message highlights were first, on the Department of Agriculture for the 25 Billion funds for those who were affected by drought. Mayor Sanchez opened a proposed project to Governor Dy for the renovation of their Barangay road going to Cauayan City, the proposed budget causes 500 million Pigalo bridge (10,000 bags of cement). Second, Price support for the farmers, and lastly, He hopes that San Guillermo will join the PRDP in which 80% will be shouldered by the World Bank, 20% coming from the province and the rest 20% comes from the Department of Agriculture that would cover 9-15 km.

Vice Mayor of San Guillermo closed the program with his short message. The table in each booth were declared open to act on all requests received from the clients. The ENR Office was able to served **Two-Hundred Thirty (230)** clientele from 24 barangays and disposed a total **Two-Hundred Thirty (230)** assorted fruit bearing seedlings, to wit:
