## FARMERS' CONGRESS REPORT January 19, 2016 Aurora, Isabela

The registration started upon the arrival of the Provincial Government of Isabela Employee/Personnel and participants coming from the different Barangays of Aurora, Isabela. The ENR Office opened the table for the distribution of seedlings, and to entertain some environmental issues and concerns of the constituents.

At around 9:00 AM, the program formally started with a simple prayer followed by the singing of the National Anthem and Isabela Hymn. Hon. Damian A. Duldulao, Vice-Mayor of the Municipality of Aurora expressed his warm gratitude to all the employee of the Provincial Government of Isabela, officials of every Barangay, and to the farmers attended the said event. Afterwhich, Hon. William T. Uy delivered his message thanking the Provincial Government of Isabela for extending its support to the Municipality. Then, Gov. Faustino G. Dy, III, also delivered his message. He introduced to the participants the different BRO-Programs. He also mentioned about financial assistance, crop insurance, and on Self-evacuation to those constituents' houses located in areas prone to flood and landslide for them to be safe. Subsequently, was the continuation of extending technical support and assistance to the farmer beneficiaries.

The different BRO programs which aim to uplift the situation of our farmers were also discussed in the program by the respective representatives of each program. The program ended with the issuance of financial assistance to the different Barangays of Aurora, Isabela.

The ENR Office was able to serve Three Hundred Nine (309) clientele from 31 over 33 Barangays and disposed a total of (258) assorted fruit bearing seedlings and (51) vermi-casts fertilizer to wit:
