## FARMERS' CONGRESS REPORT February 04, 2016 San Mariano, Isabela

The registration started upon the arrival of the Provincial Government of Isabela Employee/Personnel and participants coming from the different Barangays of San Mariano, Isabela. The ENR Office opened the table for the distribution of seedlings, and to entertain some environmental issues and concerns of the constituents.

At around 8:30 AM, the program formally started with a simple prayer followed by the singing of the National Anthem and Isabela Hymn. Then, the different BRO programs which aim to uplift the situation of our farmers were also discussed in the program by the respective representatives of each program. At around 10:20 AM, Mayor Dean Anthony G. Domalanta delivered the opening/welcoming address. Then, Hon. Faustino U. Dy IV and Hon. Ed Christopher S. Go delivered their messages respectively. Afterwhich, Gov. Faustino G. Dy, III, also delivered his message. He introduced to the participants the different BRO-Programs. He also mentioned about financial assistance and crop insurance that will be awarded to farmer beneficiaries. Subsequently, the continuation of extending technical support and assistance to the farmer recipients was ongoing.

The discussions of the different BRO programs were continued. The program ended with the issuance of financial assistance to the different Barangays of San Mariano, Isabela.

The ENR Office was able to serve Five Hundred Three (503) clientele from 32 over 36 Barangays and disposed a total of (503) assorted fruit bearing seedlings to wit:
