

FOREST MANAGEMENTAND CONSERVATION

A. FOREST PROTECTION AND LAW ENFORCEMENT

With the continuous conduct of massive ground operations in the implementation and enforcement of forest protection laws, rules and regulations within the province by the Isabela Environment Protection – Task Force (ISEP-TF) Operatives composed of representatives from the ENR Office, DENR, MLGUs concerned, PNP & Philippine Army Personnel. During the period, there were no confiscations/apprehensions happened.

B. FOREST RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT

1. Nursery Operations

Two (2) nurseries are being maintained by the Office, namely: the Provincial and Mega nurseries located at the Capitol Compound and Villa Imelda, City of Ilagan, respectively.

At the Provincial nursery, it is manned by **four (4) full time laborers** and **one (1) part time laborer** since he functions a multi-task assignments. From May 19, 2014 to June 6, 2014, they were able to maintain nursery operational activities and produced **One Hundred Eighty (180)** pieces of **mahogany** tree seedlings and **One Hundred Seventy (170) Golden Shower** tree seedlings.

For the Mega nursery at Villa Imelda, it is being watched over by another part time labourer doing nursery maintenance activities with seedling production of **Three Hundred (300)** pieces of potted **Mahogany** tree seedlings as he is but more often assigned to assist as ISEP-TF operative at Abuan Checkpoint.

A total of **Four Hundred Fifty Three (453) pieces** of assorted fruit, forest and ornamental seedlings were disposed to various recipients from the City of Ilagan, Gamu and Santiago City.

2. Partnership Activities with the DENR B+WISER Program

Forest Landscape Restoration Project in Divilacan, Isabela

The restoration of the forest focuses on the natural ecosystem functions (regulatory, habitat, production and information functions) while considering human needs. Forest restoration goes beyond the planting of trees. It is defined as the "actions to re-instate, re-establish" forest cover



and service delivery of the forest. The methodologies to be employed for forest restoration depend on the condition of the site and purpose of the restoration project.

Considering the above premises, the ENR Office has targeted 50 hectares for its initial forest restoration project located within the NSMNP along the proposed road network at Barangay Sapinit and 10 hectares mangrove rehabilitation at Barangay Dimasalansan, Divilacan, Isabela with technical assistance from the B+WISER Program of the DENR.

Initial activities undertaken were as follows:

- Actual field validation and survey of the areas eligible for 50 hectares forest restoration project of the Provincial Government thru this Office in support to the NGP. The site is located within the NSMNP area in barangay Sapinit, Divilacan, Isabela. The team composed of the PLGU-ENRO represented by For. Rosemarie T. Zabala together with partners from DENR B+WISER Program, PENRO & CENRO Palanan Sub-Office in Maconacon.
- Forest Management Unit (FMU) Planning Workshop attended by the PO officers and members of ANAK ng Divilacan, Sapinit Tribal Council and the Barangay Council and LGU Divilacan representatives led by the Municipal ENRO. Said activities were conducted in Barangay Sapinit Session Hall on May 27-31, 2014 with the desired outputs hopefully attained as follows:
 - ✓ Common understating of the Forest Management Unit concepts among the participants;
 - ✓ Development of sample FMU plans, and
 - ✓ Agreement on road map for FMU plan development of the forest restoration project.

Consolidation of the survey and data gathered thru GIS mapping followed.

The B+WISER Program had earlier conducted FMU Planning Workshop in Camp Samal Training Center, Tumauini, Isabela which aimed at prioritizing the critical watersheds of Tumauini Watershed Forest Reserve (TWFR) that currently provides important ecosystem services like irrigation to lowland farms. This is also one of the pilot areas for forest restoration by the DENR. This activity was participated by For. Joyce N. Cabalonga with participants from the People's



Organization existing in the area – the Sito Maguli Marginal Farmers Producers Cooperative (SMMFPC) and other farmers within the watershed vicinities of Barangay Antagan 1st, Tumauini, Isabela.

3. Conduct of Certificate of Stewardship Contract (CSC) Evaluation

Simultaneous with other activities of equal importance is the conduct of performance assessment and field evaluation of individual CSC holders within the Integrated Social Forestry (ISF) Project areas in the municipalities of Maconacon, Divilacan and Cordon. Using the DENR prescribed CSC evaluation rating sheet, herewith is the partial result of the holders that were assessed and evaluated, to wit:

MINERAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

A. PROCESSING OF PERMIT APPLICATIONS

This Office received and processed an additional One (1) Sand and Gravel Commercial Permit Application of Lapogan Multi-Purpose Cooperative represented by Rizalino Garcillam with the corresponding administrative/processing fees collected by the Provincial Treasurer's Office amounting to Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Pesos (Php 11,330.00).

B. ENFORCEMENT OF POLICIES CONCERNING MINERAL RESOURCES

From May 19, 2014 to June 6, 2014, there were no Accreditation Sticker was issued to different haulers.

C. FIELD MONITORING OF QUARRY AND MINING OPERATIONS

1. Quarrying Operations

As per request by the Municipal Council of Tumauini during their regular session held on May 26, 2014, an actual field survey, ocular inspection/assessment and verification were conducted at the quarry site



applied for Commercial Sand and Gravel Permit by Hon. Christopher B. Uy having a distance from the bridge of Sta. Visitacion, Tumauini, Isabela. And after thorough measurement of the area, Mr. Uy is recommended to have his extraction beyond five hundred meters from the foot of the bridge.

Moreover, one (1) staff of Mineral Resources Management Division conducted relocation of quarry area of Mr. Arnold S. Ferrer situated at Barangays Carpintero and Minanga, Tumauini, Isabela.

2. Mining Operations

On June 2, 2014, Office Order No. 2045 was issued by the Office of the Local Chief Executive to conduct compliance monitoring to issued Cease and Desist Order (CDO) to illegal miners at Sitio Dimakawal, Bukal Norte, Dinapigue, Isabela. Several members of Isabela Environment Protection – Task Force (ISEP-TF) led by ENR Officer Geronimo P. Cabaccan, Jr. proceeded to Dinapigue to implement the Order.

Following activities were undertaken:

- 1. Coordinated with the Office of the Municipal Mayor, DENR Suboffice, Local Police Station and the Barangay Officials.
- 2. Conducted dialogue with all stakeholders to plan course of action in relation to the issued Cease and Desist Orders.

Findings:

- 1. Miners were no longer in the area.
- 2. Ball mills still intact with presence of old piles of ores.

Actions:

The team dismantled all existing Ball Mills in the area. Several parts of Ball Mills were taken down and brought to the office for custody and others were just left behind in the area.

D. OTHER INTERVENING ACTIVIES

- Together with ENR Officer Geronimo P. Cabaccan, Jr. attended Sangguniang Bayan Regular Session of LGU Tumauini, Isabela relative to the implementation of Provincial Ordinance No. <u>05</u> series of 2014 Regulating the Extraction, Disposition, Utilization and Processing of Quarry and other Mineral Resources in the Province and in compliance with the provisions of RA No. 7942 or the Philippine Mining Act of 1995.
- 2. After thorough deliberation/review of the Provincial Mining Regulatory Board (PMRB) of Isabela led by Engr. Mario A. Ancheta, Chairman/PMRB



during the Special Meeting held on May 15, 2014, the Board endorsed to the Honorable Governor Faustino G. Dy III the approval of Commercial Sand and Gravel (CSAG) Permit Applications in which out of Sixteen (16) CSAG Applications only Fourteen (14) were qualified for complying all the requirements, the application of Mr. Jun P. Bulos and Mr. Edwin P. Uy, both from Furao, Gamu quarry site were excluded from the list subject for further evaluation.

3. Joined and assisted together with the Mines and Geo-Sciences Bureau (MGB) personnel in the five-day delineation of areas for the Declaration of Minahang Bayan at Barangays Anonang, Camarao, Caquilingan and Villa Miemban, Cordon, Isabela from June 3-7, 2014.
