# PROVINCIAL YOUTH SUMMIT 5.0

December 16-18, 2022

The Provincial Youth Summit 5.0 Hiraya ng mga Bata at Kabataang Isabeleño is anchored towards the fulfilment of the mandates of the Sangguniang Kabataan Federation, the Council NAGKAISA – Provincial Youth Development Council, and the Local Youth Development Offices through the Local Youth Development Officers in the successful formulation and effective implementation of the Provincial Youth Development Plan.

It is an initiative of the Provincial Government of Isabela, through the Office of the SK Panlalawigang Pederasyon President and the Council NAGKAISA – Provincial Youth Development Council, to ensure a holistic and inclusive governance where the youth are able to fulfil their roles and actively participate in the formulation of the local government's actual action plans.

Specifically, the Provincial Youth Summit 5.0 HIRAYA Isabela aims to accomplish the following objectives:

- 1. Present and impart among the Isabeleño Youth the priority youth agenda of the Provincial Government of Isabela through its Local Development Plan, and that of the National Youth Commission through its Philippine Youth Development Plan;
- 2. Identify issues, concerns, and struggles among the Isabeleño child and youth based on the data presented by PYDAC memberagencies.
- 3. Develop a strategic plan to address the identified Child and Youth issues for the next three years by means of a comprehensive and efficient timetable of programs, projects, and activities.
- 4. Finalize and adopt the Provincial Youth Development Plan through a Resolution by the Council NAGKAISA Provincial Youth Development Council (PYDC).

The honorable Vice Governor Faustino G. Dy III graced the opening of the Provincial Youth Summit 5.0 attended by 200 Isabeleño Youth Leaders from among the Sangguniang Kabataan, members of the Council NAGKAISA – PYDC, representatives of YORP-registered youth and youth-serving organizations, representatives of the Local Council for the Protection of Children – In-school Youth, Out-of-School Youth, IP Youth, PWD Youth, and the Local Youth Development Officers of Isabela.

Atty. Noel Manuel R. Lopez, in the first Summit session, discussed the Hiraya Pamahalaang ng Panlalawigan: The Child and Youth Agenda of the Provincial Government of Isabela. On behalf of the National Youth Commission, Mr. Rey Mel C. Resposo, OIC-PYDO, discussed, for the second Summit session, the Hiraya ng Pambansang Pamahalaan: The Youth Agenda of the National Government through the Philippine Youth Development Plan 2023-2028.

During the third Session, the Hiraya ng Pagkakaisa: The Provincial Youth Development Advisory Council Inter-Agency Consultation on Child and Youth Issues, ten PYDAC Member-Agencies and Offices, based from the PYDP 2023-2028 10 centers of participation, presented data on children and youth situation and issues identified by their offices and agencies as well as their current interventions in trying to address these.

After the discussions, a panel discussion went through with the participants having a chance to ask the speakers their questions.

In a survey conducted by the Provincial Youth Development Office, known as the Isabela Youth Assessment Survey, concerning figures came out which Mr. Resposo also presented to the Summit participants.

All the discussions and sessions were intended to be the participants' input in their formulation of the three-year Provincial Youth Development Plan 2023-2025. The participants were then clustered into four (4) centers of participation and crafted their plans for the specific centers assigned to their cluster.

Cluster representatives presented their plans to the body for scrutiny and review. After final revisions, clusters gave their plans to the PYDO secretariat for consolidation.

For the final day of the Summit, NAGKAISA **PYDC** Council members convened, with other participants as witnesses, to finalize and adopt the Provincial Youth Development Plan 2023-2025. With a motion raised by the memberrepresentative from the Philippine Normal University North Luzon, the PYDP 2023-2025 was approved and adopted by the Council NAGKAISA -PYDC followed by the ceremonial signing of the members and the Chairman of the Council NAGKAISA - PYDC of the Resolution adopting the plan.

Another milestone for the Kabataang Isabeleños, it was also during the Summit that the Council NAGKAISA – PYDC Manual and Operations Handbook was launched. The province of Isabela shall be the first in the Region to the Local Youth Development Council members.


