ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT 2022

The Isabela Museum and Library (IML) was inaugurated on May 11, 1999 in celebration of the 143rd Anniversary of the province. The provincial Government rehabilitated the old Capitol Building to a new modern structure and was designed by Architect Baltazar Gigantone. The nativity of the institution was in cognizance to the potential and significance of the youth in nation-building. For former Governor Benjamin G. Dy, an advocate of the youth empowerment who's ideal and dedication geared towards its fulfillment. The institution is under the supervision of the Office of the Governor and it aims to be the repository and custodian of the rich and historical and cultural heritage of the People of Isabela.

Vision

Service to the people of Isabela by means of collecting and preserving cultural materials, written documents and print materials relevant to local culture and history and bring about ultimate individual and societal development extending popular education in the province.

Mission

IML is committed to the repository, preservation of Isabela's culture materials, and promotion of its library collections thereby contributing meaningfully to the education and cultural fulfilment of its audiences.

Objectives

- To be the repository of all kinds of print/non-print materials.
- To preserve and exhibit the socio-cultural heritage of the people of Isabela.
- Public Library as partners in community build-up through linkages/networking on global access through Internet service.
- To promote tourism in the province.
- To foster progress and advocate empowered citizenry or the motto "Knowledge is Power".

Museum Services

The Museum is dedicated to collecting objects which are scientific, aesthetic, or historical in significance; caring for them; and studying, interpreting and exhibiting them for the purposes of advancing knowledge and educating the public. It is a public gathering place where visitors can be entertained, inspired and exposed to new or unfamiliar ideas. The Museum offers the following services:

- a) Permanent and Changing Exhibits
- b) Educational Program such as guided tour, cultural lecture, film showing, in-house and traveling arts and history program (i.e., Tilamsik ng Liwanag Exhibit)
- c) Research on cultural heritage, and eco-tourism
- d) Preservation on Ethnographic and Cultural materials
- e) Accepting museum materials for exhibit

Library Services

Libraries are the repositories of knowledge for it provide information resources from local, national and international subjects. Libraries play a vital role in molding the minds of young people and instilling the importance of acquiring knowledge and introducing children the early habit of reading and inquiry. This has a great effect for individual development and national progress. The following are the services offered in the library:

- a) Main Library Section – wide array of books collection such as general references, encyclopedias, almanacs, yearbooks, dictionaries, atlases, periodicals, government publications, theses and dissertations.
- b) Children's Library Section – adequate children's literature book to enhance the love of reading books. This section is inter-active well equipped with TV, DVD /VCR's and children's video tape.

Other Services

- a) Function Room – suited for conferences, lectures and discussion.
- b) Assist and facilitate in the establishment of City, Municipal and Barangay Libraries

Rules in Borrowing Books

1. Library opens at 8:00 AM and closes at 5:00 PM, Monday to Friday, no lunch break.
2. Present any valid ID/ student ID to the librarian.
3. Books may only be taken out at 4:30PM and should be returned at 8:00AM the following morning.
4. Only selected books are allowed to be taken out.
5. Damaged or lost books must be reported at once and should be replaced or paid for within one week from due date.
6. Deliberate marking, mutilation or defacing of book or any library material will merit recommendation for suspension of library privileges.
7. Any unauthorized withdrawal of books or materials is considered THEFT and any such deliberate act shall be reported to the Library-In-charge for an appropriate action.
8. Fiction books can be loaned for one week and can be renewed from time to time.

Guidelines for Museum Tour

1. Museum opens at 8:00 AM and closes at 5:00 PM, Monday to Friday, no noon break.
2. For group tour/s, write a letter (at least one week in advance) addressed to the Office of the Governor and/or The Isabela Museum or Library , stating the schedule of visit / date / time , and number of visitors. For walk in tour, fill up tour request form.
3. The letter will serve as reservation and maybe rescheduled by informing the office through a telephone call or text message.
4. For walk-ins, fill –up the log book intended for unscheduled visit.
5. Strictly no touching of museum displays and other materials.
6. Other rules in the tour will be announced by the Tour Guide/s.

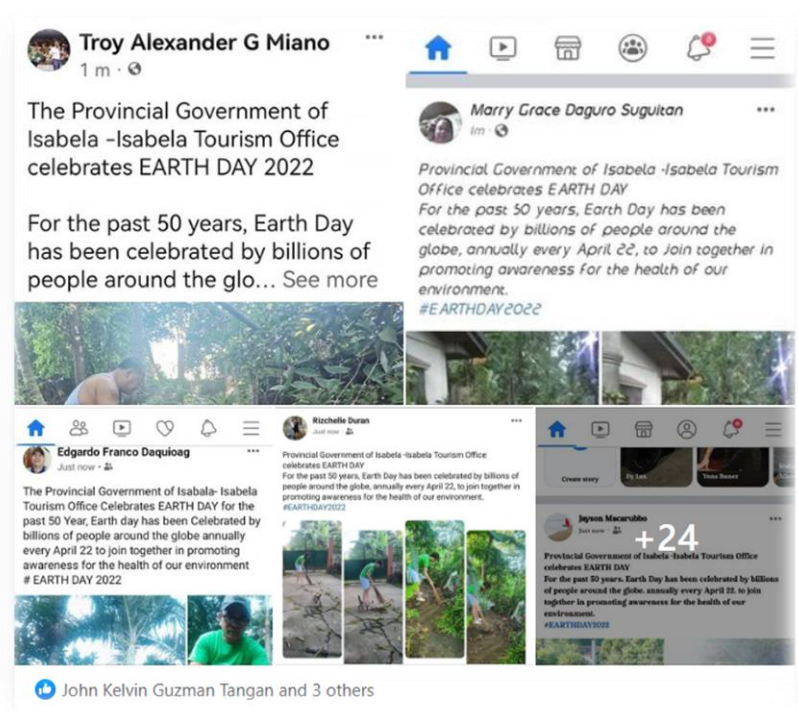

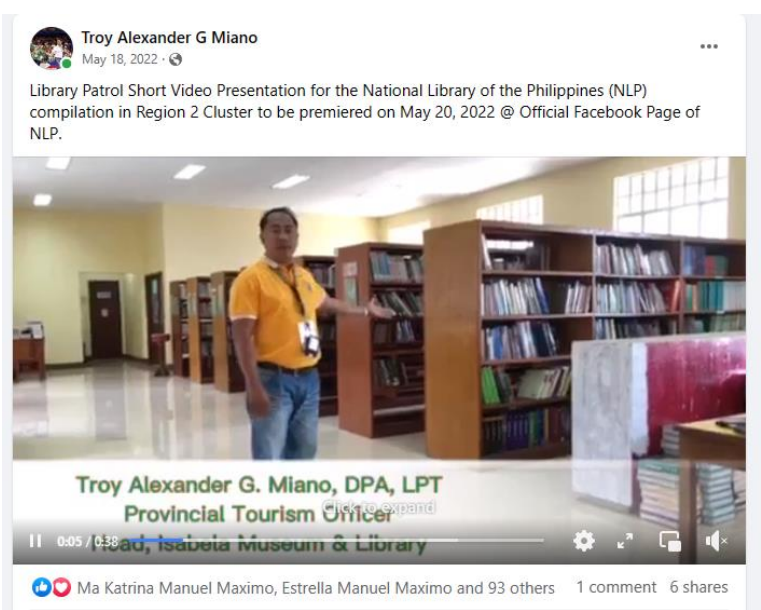

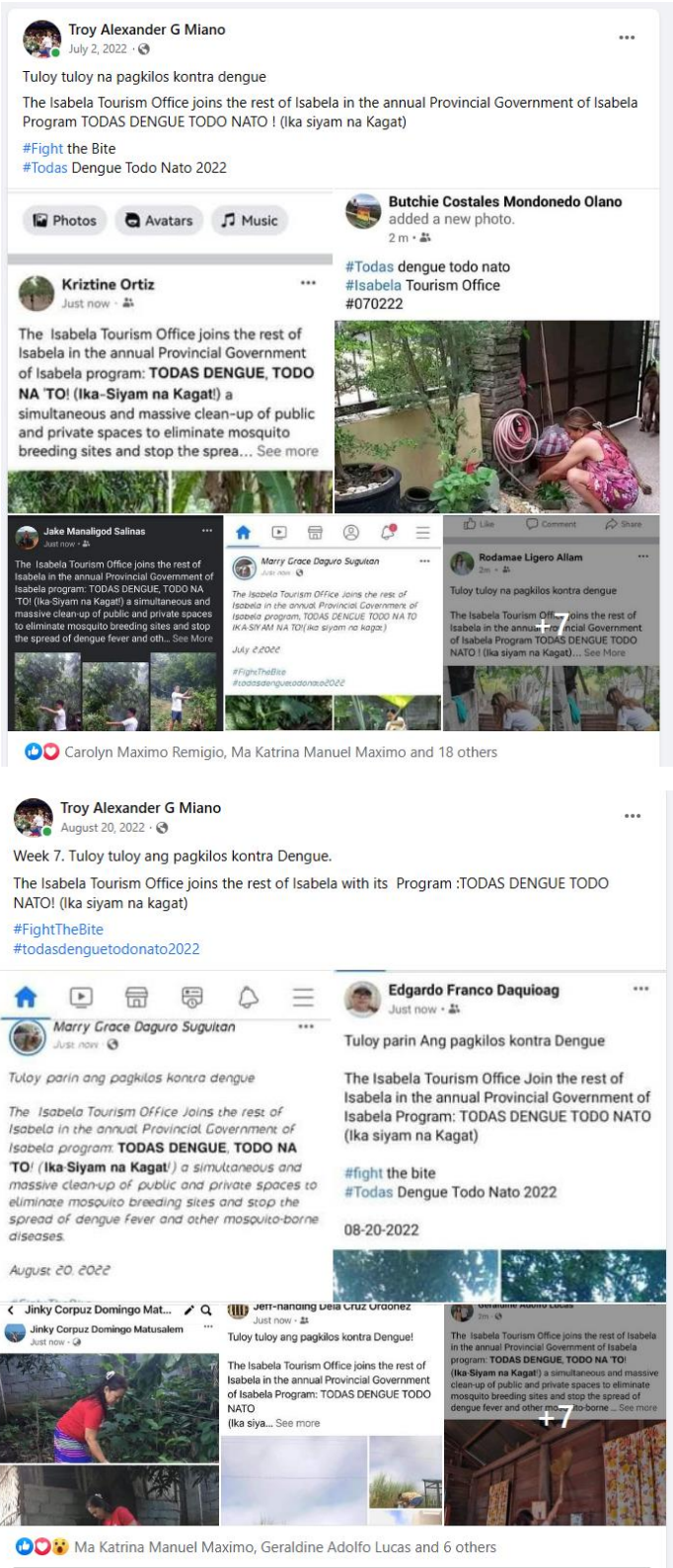
