Hereunder are the highlights of our office accomplishments to wit:

PROGRAM/PROJECT/ACTIVITY	ACCOMPLISHMENT
I. RICE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM	
A. Extension Delivery Service	Validated farmer beneficiaries during the distribution of seed assistance in participating in Early Wet Season (WS) Planting Program of the NIA-MARISS Division at NIA Santiago City, Ramon and Cordon.
II. CORN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM	
A. Extension Delivery Service	Served as facilitator in the Farmer Led Extensionist (FLE) Corn Techno Demo Field Day at Bitabian, Pallutan, Sta. Filomena, San Mariano and Maluno Norte/Sur, Benito Soliven.
III. HIGH VALUE COMMERCIAL CROPS DEVT PROGRAM (HVCCDP)	
A. Nursery Operation and Management	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Produced 320 pieces of asexually propagated sweet tamarind and 140 pcs pomelo seedlings.2. Distributed 279 pieces of assorted fruit tree seedlings to 20 beneficiaries.4. Produced 4700 pieces eggplant vegetable seedlings5. Distributed 5,750 pieces of eggplant vegetable seedlings to 29 beneficiaries and 4,700 pieces of pepper seedlings to 26 recipients involving 3 municipalities6. Sourced-out fruit tree planting materials for propagation at Provincial Nursery.

IV. FISHERIES DEVELOPMENT

A. San Pablo Fish Farm Operation

1. Produced 114,500 pieces of tilapia fingerlings.
2. Distributed 50,000 pieces of fingerlings to Furoo Dalag SWIP, Sta. Maria and 63 pieces fingerlings to 4 individual farmers of Sta. Maria, Delfin Albano and Gamu.

B. Extension Services Delivery

Inspected operation of 2 smokehouses provided to municipality of Mallig coming up with 65 kilos smokefish production.

BFAR & LGU jointly monitored the dispersal of tilapia fingerlings in the different barangays of the following municipalities/cities:

- 1. Burgos, Isabela – 60,000 pcs.
- 2. Sta. Maria, Isabela - 50,000 pcs.

C. Provision of technical assistance

1. There were 3 fishpond operators having total area of 0.21 hectares visited and provided technical services on their pond management operations.

Provided assistance to MLGU's of Sto. Tomas, in the Fisheries Registration Program (Fish R) of the BFAR.
