

ANNUAL ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT C.Y. 2023

I. REFERRAL AND PLACEMENT

a. JOB FAIR

- The PESO hosted the first-ever **Bambanti Job Fair last January 24, 2023** at the PSWDO Lobby, Provincial Capitol Compound, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela, in which, 385 applicants, 40 employers and National Government Agencies (NGAs) like TESDA, DTI, PHILHEALTH took part.

As a result, 42 applicants were hired on the spot, which is 11% (DOLE's aim is 10%), and 256 applicants, or 66%, were determined to be candidates for near hires.



- The PESO conducted a **Job Fair in celebration of the Isabela Day last May 10, 2023** at the Ground Floor, Queen Isabela Park, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela.

The event was participated by 41 employers, various NGAs and 249 applicants. 46 participants (18.47%) were hired on the spot and 79 near hires or applicants for final interview and assessment were obtained.



- The PESO conducted a **Job Fair for the 3rd quarter of 2023**, with the aim of bringing together various employers and jobseekers to facilitate easy and immediate employment opportunities for our stakeholders last **September 1, 2023** at the Ground Floor, Queen Isabela Park, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela.

The aforementioned event was participated by 40 employers, NGAs (SSS, PAGIBIG, PhilHealth, PSA, BFP, TESDA, etc.) and 470 applicants. 103 participants were hired on the spot (21.90%) and 172 were near hires or applicants for final assessment.

An employment coaching session was also delivered to the jobseekers of the said Job Fair to assist them with their application process as well as for their career endeavor.

c. LOCAL RECRUITMENT ACTIVITY

- The Provincial Government of Isabela through the PESO held a Local Recruitment Activity (LRA) at the Lobby of the PSWDO Bldg., Provincial Capitol Compound on July 5, 2023. The LRA is a mechanism to bring together applicants at a convenient place and time through the request of an employer. The Staff Search Asia who handles the hiring for Jollibee was able to Hire-on-the-Spot all their needed 10 service crews for Jollibee Ilagan Branch.

A discussion on employment coaching was also conducted by the Provincial PESO through PESO Manager Ms. Jeng Reyes to give the applicants tips on how to ace their job interview.



- The Provincial Government of Isabela through the PESO held a Local Recruitment Activity (LRA) for Alorica Teleservices Inc. at the Lobby of the PSWDO Building, Provincial Capitol, City of Ilagan, Isabela on July 10, 2023. The PESO also conducted an employment coaching session to the job seekers.



d. ONLINE JOB POSTING ANNOUNCEMENT

PESO Isabela entered into the digital world by creating a Facebook page believing that social media could be a powerful tool to reach a wider audience and connect with individuals in need of upskilling and employment opportunities.

As we are now in the 21st century where most people are using social media, on January 12, 2023, PESO began utilizing its Facebook page as a platform to announce job and training postings.

Upon observation after the first few posts, we discovered that this approach proved to be highly effective in attracting a diverse pool of applicants from various municipalities in Isabela. It provides access to a wide range of opportunities, information, and a convenient application process.

The posts spread as people shared and tagged their friends and family, enabling the announcements to reach a wider audience. As more individuals became aware of these announcements, they visit the PESO Facebook page in search of opportunities.

Recognizing the need for a more organized and streamlined approach, PESO decided to provide access via Google Form. This allowed applicants to submit their applications directly through the form where they can input their personal data. The Google Form contains the needed information in PESO Employment Information System (PEIS) and registrants are automatically captured in the Provincial Skills Registry Program (PSRP).

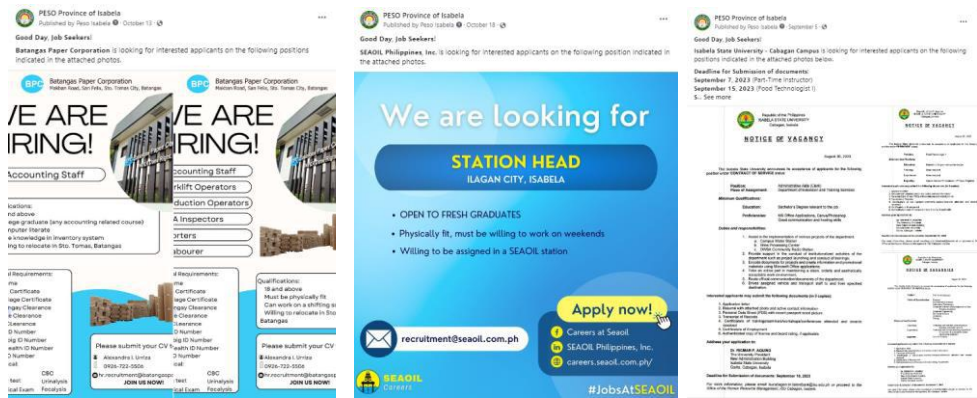
From January to December, the PESO Facebook page garnered a total of 8.2k page likes and 12k followers. PESO's commitment to connecting job seekers with upskilling and employment opportunities had struck a chord with the online community.

Through Facebook page and the utilization of a Google Form, PESO had become a beacon of hope for applicants and employers. The platform's reach had grown exponentially, allowing them to bridge the gap between those in need of work and trainings and those offering employment.

II. LABOR MARKET INFORMATION

- The PESO Manager shared the Labor Market Information (LMI) to participating mothers during the Cabatuan Isabela’s Women’s month Celebration. The PESO Manager also informed them the important labor trends (in demand jobs and skills shortages) as basis of the career choices their children will make as soon to be jobseekers



- The PESO Manager discussed the Labor Market Information and trends to youth leaders of different municipalities of Isabela during the Joint 1st Regular Quarter Meeting 2023 of the Provincial Youth Development Advisory Council (PYDC), the Sangguniang Kabataan City/ Municipal Federation Presidents, the League of Local Youth Development Officers, the Council NAGKAISA-Provincial Youth Development Council (PYDC), and the YORP - Registered Youth and Youth-Serving Organizations in Isabela on March 13, 2023



- PESO Manager Ms. Jeng Reyes was invited in the Migrant Workers Symposium at Ilagan Community Center. Discussed the Labor Market Information and guided the OFWs and their families on the in- demand jobs vis a vis the available trainings in TESDA where they might want to upskill or find more opportunities for themselves.



- Aside from the help of inviting employers and job seekers, the PESO Manager also conducted an employment coaching and LMI session to the job applicants of the Job Fair conducted by the LGU Roxas last July 3, 2023. This aims to guide them with their career path and to have higher chances of getting their desired jobs.



- The PESO participated in the Pre-Employment Training Seminar and Job Fair at Isabela State University (ISU) - San Mariano, Isabela on July 13, 2023. Other than the task of inviting the employers to the Job Fair, Provincial PESO was requested to speak on the Labor Market Information delivered by LMI Focal Person - Ms. Kaili Kim Soriano. The information gathered will definitely help them in their career paths as well as assist them in landing the jobs they want to pursue.



- Last June 7, 2023, PESO Manager provided Labor Market Information (LMI) during the Balik-Pinas, Balik-Hanapbuhay Entrepreneurial Development Training organized by Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA).



- The Provincial PESO through PESO Manager Ms. Jeng Reyes delivered LMI to the displaced OFWs in Region 2 during the Entrepreneurial Development Training (EDT) conducted by the Overseas Workers Welfare Administration Regional Welfare Office 02 (OWWA RWO2) at the Amphitheater, Capitol Compound, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela last August 18, 2023.

The training is a component of Balik Pinas Balik Hanapbuhay (BPPH) Program that aims to prepare our aspiring business owner-OFWs with the skills and mindset of becoming an entrepreneur, additional knowledge on budgeting, bookkeeping and other business-related topics as part of their intergration as former OFWs.



- With an audience of 1,331 scholars of Angadanan, Isabela, the Provincial Government of Isabela through the PESO provided the Labor Market Information last August 1, 2023 so as to guide the students and fresh graduates of in demand jobs as well as the emerging industries in the province.



- The Provincial Government of Isabela (PGI) brought its youth development services closer to the 3,602 BRO-Ed scholars of Cabagan, Sta. Maria and San Pablo through a youth caravan at Josefina T. Albano Sports & Cultural Complex in Cabagan on August 16, 2023.

- Networked with TESDA Director General-Secretary Danilo Cruz and officials of TESDA and DOLE on March 13, 2023



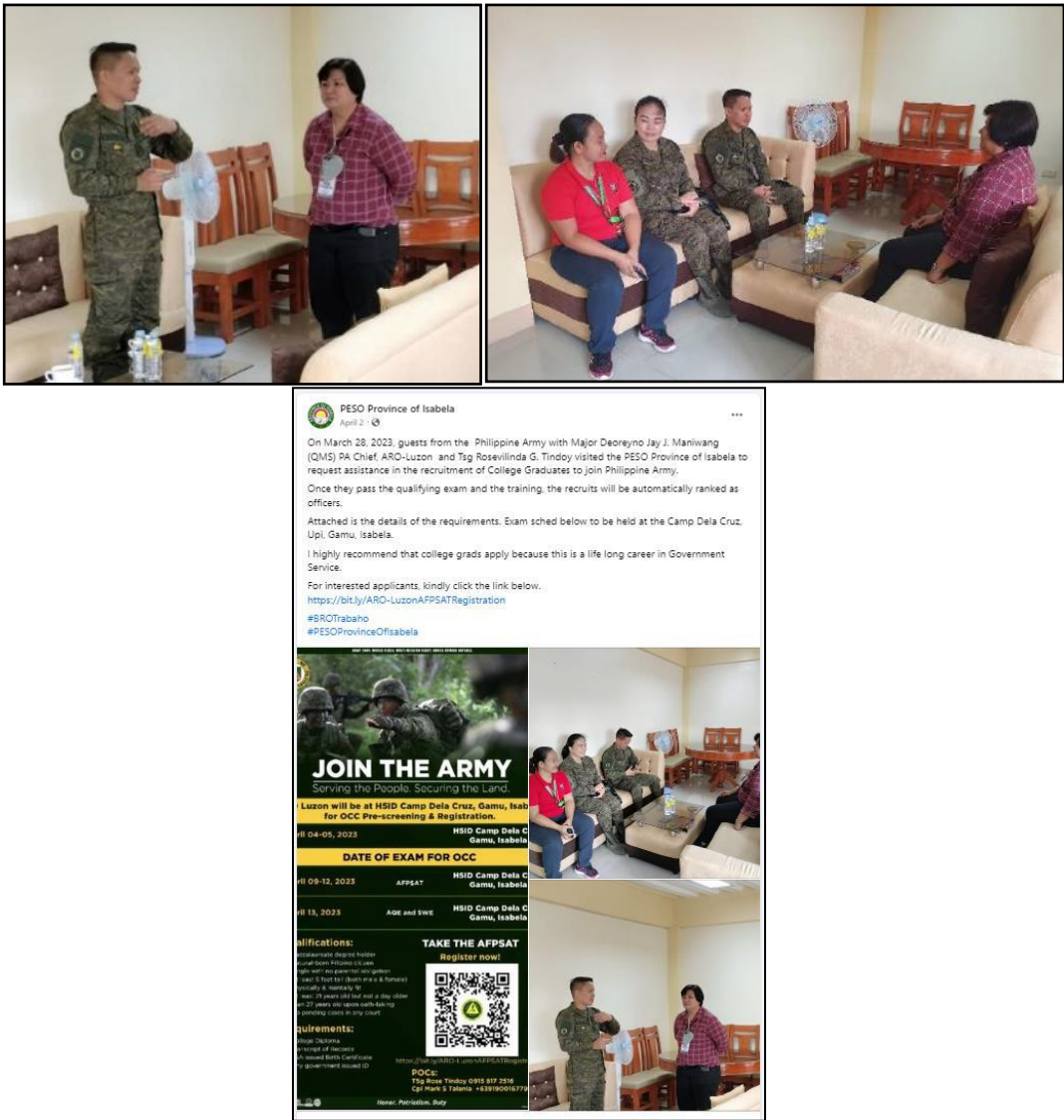

The training courses offered to the detainees were Bread and Pastry Production NC II, Dressmaking NC II, and Electric Installation and Maintenance NC II.

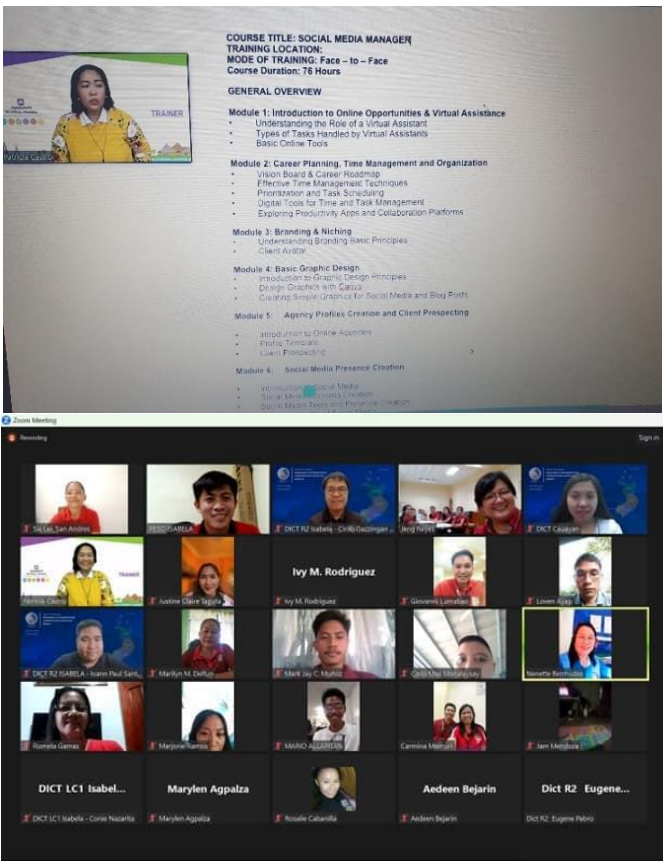
