# ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT AUGUST 2023

#### I. REFERRAL AND PLACEMENT

### A. ONLINE JOB POSTING ANNOUNCEMENT

The PESO Isabela was able to do the job posting announcement for the following employers:

- ✓ Country Funders Finance Corporation 58 applicants who filled out the online PSRP Form were referred.
- ✓ Army Recruitment Office Luzon
- ✓ Staff Search Asia Service Cooperative 18 applicants who filled out the online PSRP Form were referred.

A total of 76 applicants were referred for employment.



## B. ONLINE SKILLS TRAINING POSTING

The PESO Isabela was able to do the training posting for the following TESDA courses:

- √ Food and Beverage Services NCII (4MF Resources Inc.)
  - 25 applicants who filled out the online PSRP Form were referred.
- ✓ Bookkeeping NC III (East Asia International Systems College Inc.)
  - 100 applicants who filled out the online PSRP Form were referred.

A total of 125 applicants were referred for upskilling.



## II. LABOR MARKET INFORMATION (LMI)

With an audience of 1,331 scholars of Angadanan, Isabela, the Provincial Government of Isabela through the PESO provided the Labor Market Information last August 1, 2023 so as to guide the students and fresh graduates of in demand jobs as well as the emerging industries in the province.





 The Provincial Government of Isabela (PGI) brought its youth development services closer to the 3,602 BRO-Ed scholars of Cabagan, Sta. Maria and San Pablo through a youth caravan at Josefina T. Albano Sports & Cultural Complex in Cabagan on August 16, 2023.

The PGI through the Provincial PESO provided the scholars with Labor Market Information and Employment Coaching through PESO Manager Ms. Jeng Reyes. The PESO also distributed printed information materials of the said discussion.





The Provincial PESO through PESO Manager Ms. Jeng Reyes delivered LMI to the displaced OFWs in Region 2 during the Entrepreneurial Development Training (EDT) conducted by the Overseas Workers Welfare Administration Regional Welfare Office 02 (OWWA RWO2) at the Amphitheater, Capitol Compound, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela last August 18, 2023.

The training is a component of Balik Pinas Balik Hanapbuhay (BPBH) Program that aims to prepare our aspiring business owner-OFWs with the skills and mindset of becoming an entrepreneur, additional knowledge on budgeting, bookkeeping and other business-related topics as part of their intergration as former OFWs.
