

COVID – 19 Monitoring One Isabela CoViD-19 Command Center (OICCC)	The One Isabela COVID-19 Command Center aims to harmonize the admission and management of COVID-19 patients at the appropriate level of health facilities. In addition, ensuring the prioritization of decking and admission among COVID-19 confirmed, suspect, and probable cases. Also, to provide a proper and prompt referral to Provincial Department of Health Office (PDOHO) for severe and critical cases require admission to identified COVID-19 referral hospitals, namely SIMC and CVMC. Conduct of COVID- 19 Mass Vaccination (Isabela Evacuation Center, October 5-7, 2021)	A 3-day mass vaccination which aims to increase the total number of Isabeleños inoculated with COVID-19 vaccines. Primary clients of the activity include employees of the Provincial Government of Isabela whom waited months before being fully vaccinated.	 IPHO's vaccination team devised a 3-day vaccination plan with adherence to standard health protocols required by the IATF against COVID-19. The whole duration of the activity produced a total of 1,605 individuals inoculated with COVID-19 vaccines. • RESBAKUNA on Wheels (October 26, 2021)

The Province of Isabela along its "Isabela BIDA, Handa sa Bakuna" campaign has recently kick started the RESBAKUNA on Wheels vaccination drive. The mass immunization of COVID-19 vaccines through the birth of the RESBAKUNA on Wheels was an innovation in vaccination which

aims to deliver the services among our adult and pediatric populations nearer to their homes. Furthermore, this innovation also speaks as the province's response for having recorded an alarming 4,995 active cases for the months of August, September, and October specifically.

• COVID-19 vaccination for Pediatric A3 Roll-out (October 29, 2021) The Roll-out of the COVID-19 immunization for Pediatric A3 (12-17 years old) kickstarted in which aims to inoculate the pediatric population especially to those who were identified with co-morbidities.

- A cumulative total of 2,094 individuals were vaccinated during the whole duration of the augmentation.
- The RESBAKUNA on Wheels was manned by the members of the vaccination team from the Integrated Provincial Health Office – Field Health Services.
- **IPHO** formulated vaccination teams whom rendered daily immunization the whole in province. Total number of individuals vaccinated catered:1,450

- IPHOs Maternal and Newborn Health Program Coordinator cascaded to LGU coordinators of the following vital information:
 - Any COVID-19 vaccine (excluding SPUTNIK V) may be administered to pregnant women during their 2nd trimester of pregnancy;
 - Pregnant women whom are high risk of complications during pregnancy must present Medical and/or Obstetrical Clearance from their attending physician indicating that the recipient is fit to receive a certain COVID-19 vaccine;
 - 3. Any COVID-19 vaccine (excluding SPUTNIK V) may be administered to lactating women following precautions and observation of breastfeeding health protocols.
 - For RAT (+) and RTPCR
 (+) lactating woman,
 breastfeeding the newborn
 is still encouraged provided
 that minimum health
 protocols are observed and
 practiced.
