



## 2ND PROVINCIAL RABIES SUMMIT

**ILAGAN CITY, Isabela** - To avert the increasing incidence of dog bite cases in the province of Isabela, the Provincial Government in coordination with the Provincial Veterinary Office and Provincial Health Office conducted the **Second Provincial Rabies Summit last October 09, 2014** at FN Dy Hall, Provincial Capitol.

With the theme **"TOGETHER AGAINST RABIES"** the event aims to raise awareness about rabies and engage various stakeholders to achieve a rabies free-Isabela. It seeks to reach out to others and form partnerships that will help make elimination of rabies a reality.



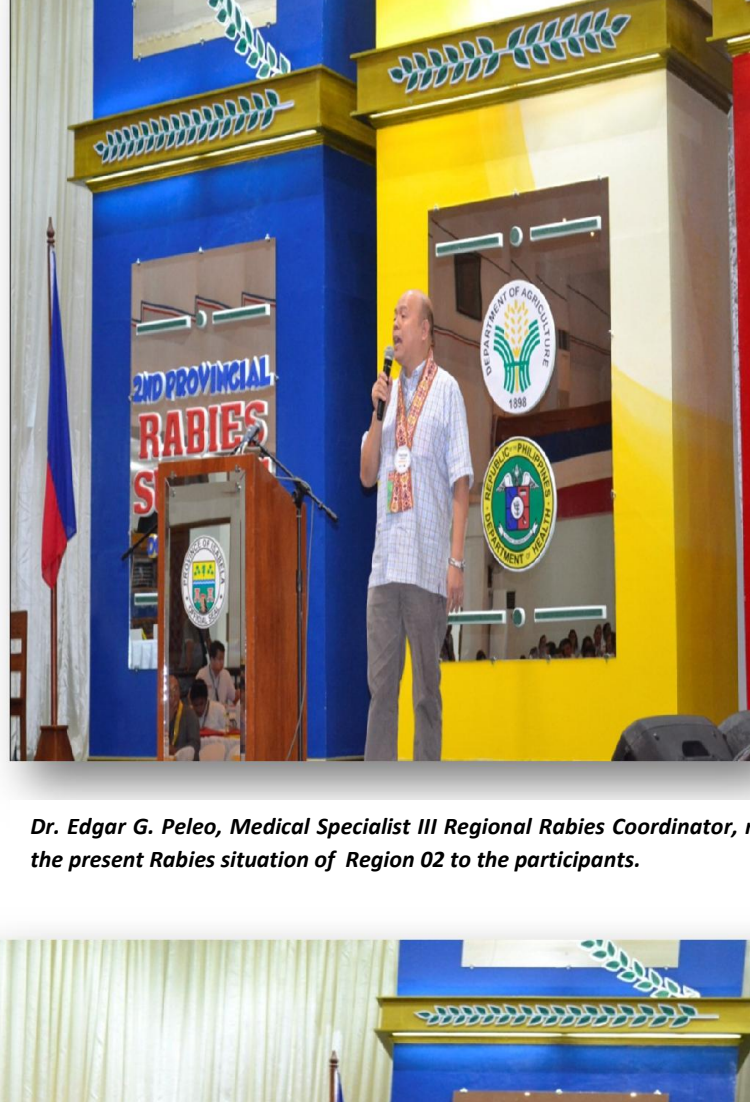
Dismayed by the increasing cases of rabies dog bites and deaths, **Governor Faustino G. Dy III** called on all local chief executives, barangay officials and other sectors in the province to help in the

control and prevention of the spread of human and animal rabies in their places.

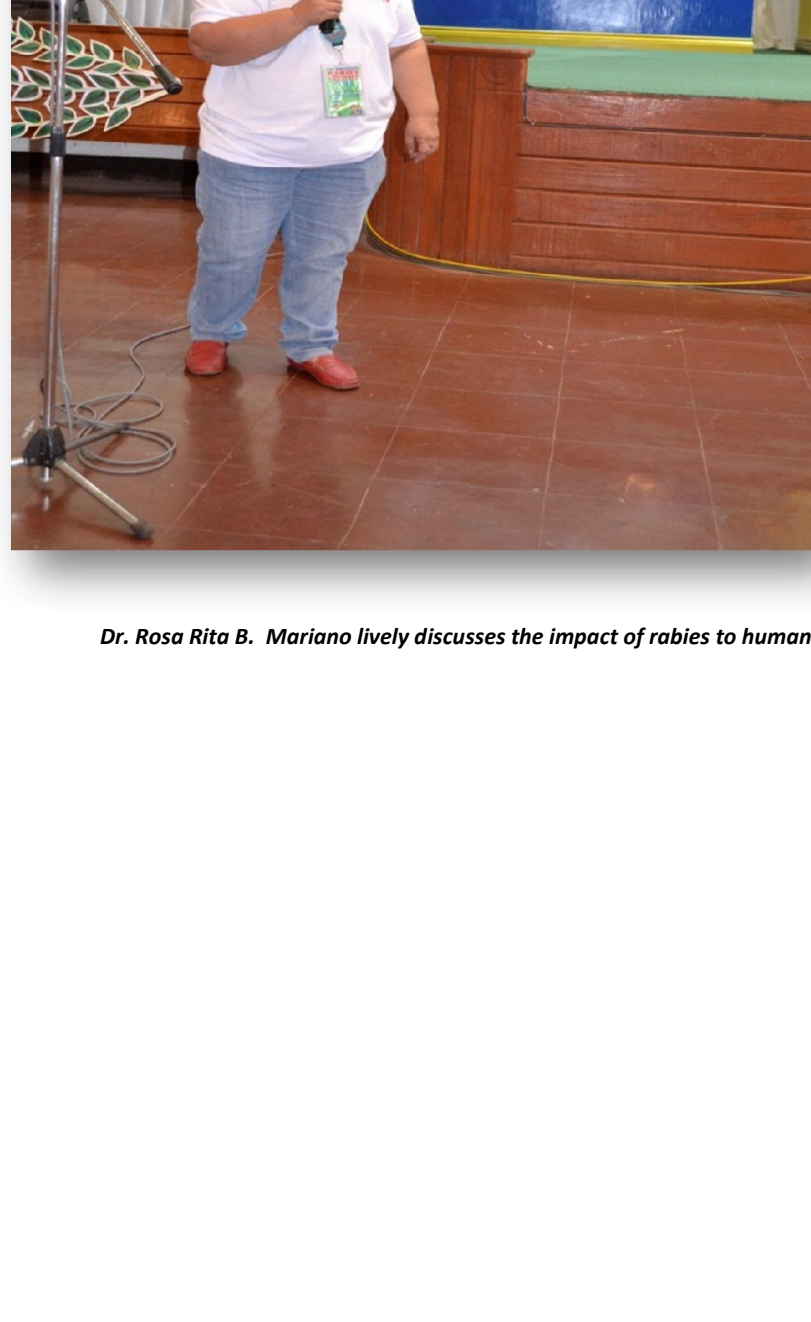
In his message, the governor expressed his ardent desire for the establishment in every barangay a "Dog Pound" wherein astray dogs are treated and taken care of before they are release to interested and responsible individuals for adoption.

Governor Dy further requested the city and municipal mayors in the province to seriously consider hiring or designating city and municipal veterinarians whose primary responsibilities will be to immunize dogs and ensure the proper implementation of Anti-Rabies and Stray Dog Control ordinance.

He compared the present rabies situation of the province to a calamity that threaten people's lives 24/7 and 365 days. Hence, he asked the local chief executives to include in their local development agenda and prioritize for funding the implementation of Anti-Rabies program in compliance with Republic Act No. 9482, otherwise known as the Anti-Rabies Act of 2007.

**Dr. Edgar G. Peleo**, Medical Specialist III of the Department of Health Region 02, informed that the Philippines ranks sixth among Asian with the most number of cases of rabies infection next to India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Myanmar and China.

In Region 02, he said the province of Isabela has been the consistent

topnotcher for the past several years in terms of casualties of rabid dog bites with an average of 10 deaths per year.

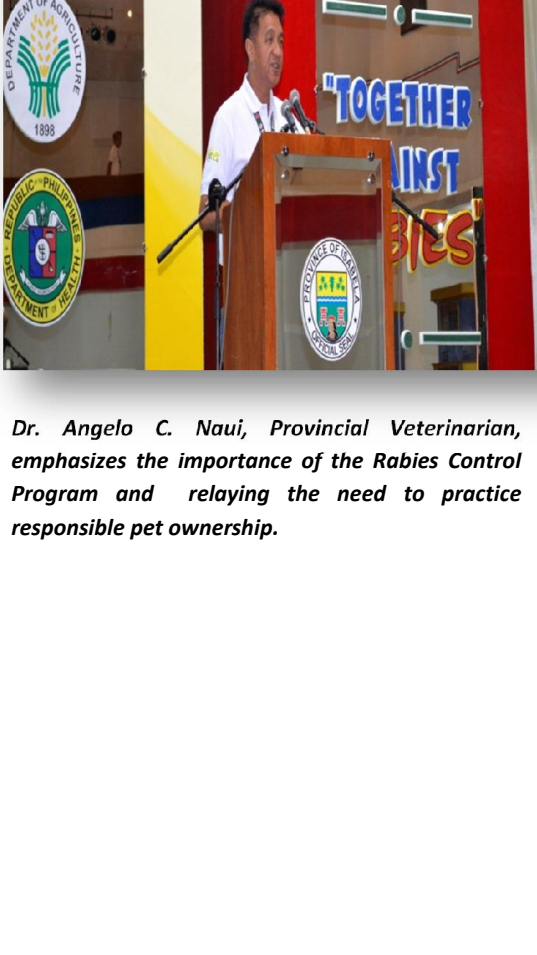
**Dr. Rosa Rita B. Mariano**, Provincial Health Officer II of the Isabela Provincial Health Office, stood as one of the speakers in the said event. In her lecture, she discussed the Rabies infection in human. How rabies virus from animals are transmitted to human, its clinical sign and symptoms and its treatment. She gave emphasis on proper wound care in treating animal bites. She also encouraged everyone to always consult a health officer or go directly to the Animal Bite treatment Center for appropriate treatment.



She revealed that Rabies is a neglected and highly fatal disease killing 10 – 12 Isabeleños every year. Children and 15 years old above are the most vulnerable to dog bites and rabies infection if not properly treated.

Joining the summit, **Dr. Angelo C. Naui**, Provincial Veterinarian, discussed to the delegates the Rabies Control Program of the Provincial Veterinary Office. He stressed out the importance of Responsible Pet Ownership-that all pet owners are required to have their dog vaccinated annually against rabies with a registration card which shall contain all vaccinations conducted on their dog as mandated by the law.

Meanwhile, **Director Elpidio A. Durwin**, DILG Provincial Director reminded the

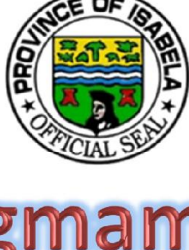
summit attendees during his talk to adopt and implement Republic Act 9482 or the Rabies Act of 2007 in their own localities.

He also informed the delegates about the National Rabies Prevention and Control Program Manual of Operations which enumerates the responsibilities of all concerned individuals regarding the control and prevention of human and animal rabies in the countryside.

Municipal Mayors, Sangguniang Bayan (SB) members chairing Municipal Committee on Health, Municipal Health Officers (MHO), Municipal Agriculturists, LNB Presidents, Barangay Captains, Livestock Coordinators, Associations of Barangay Council (ABC), PNP and Department of Education heads and other invited guests attended the said summit.

The summit concluded with each delegate given a Certificate of Appreciation for their diligence and commitment to curb down dog bite incidence solidifying concerted efforts towards the common goal of preventing human rabies in the province of Isabela.





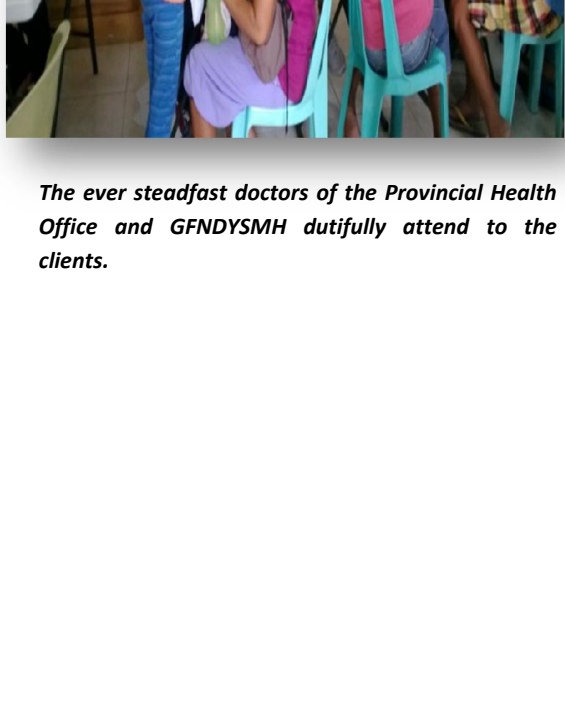

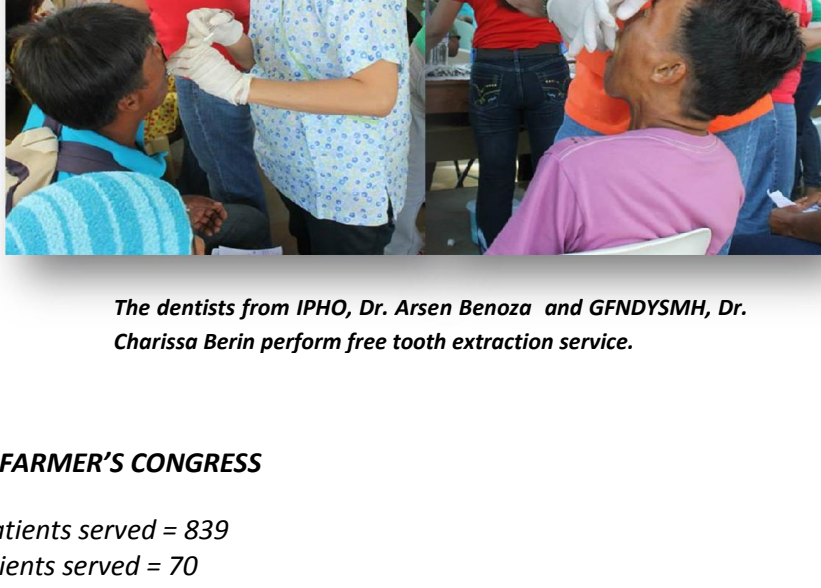

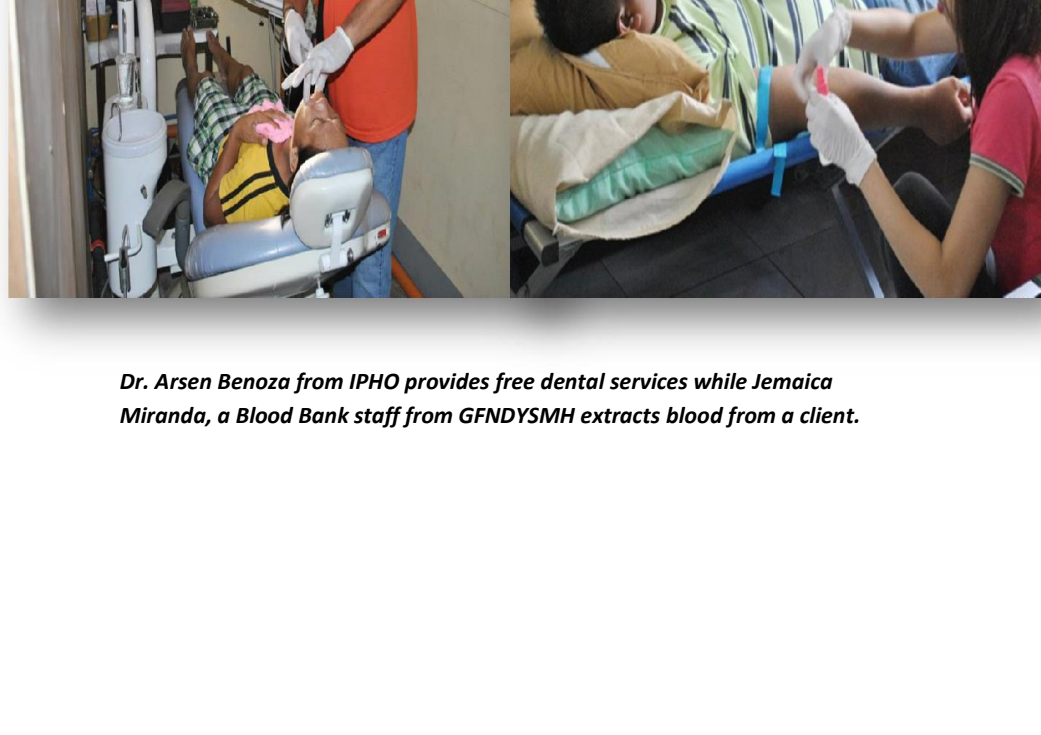

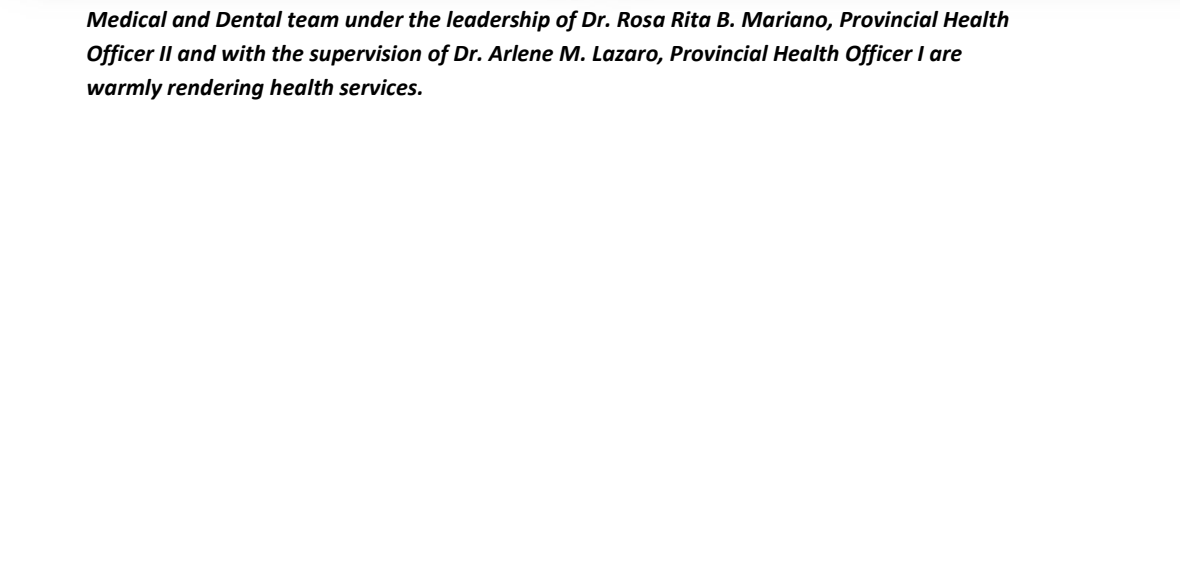

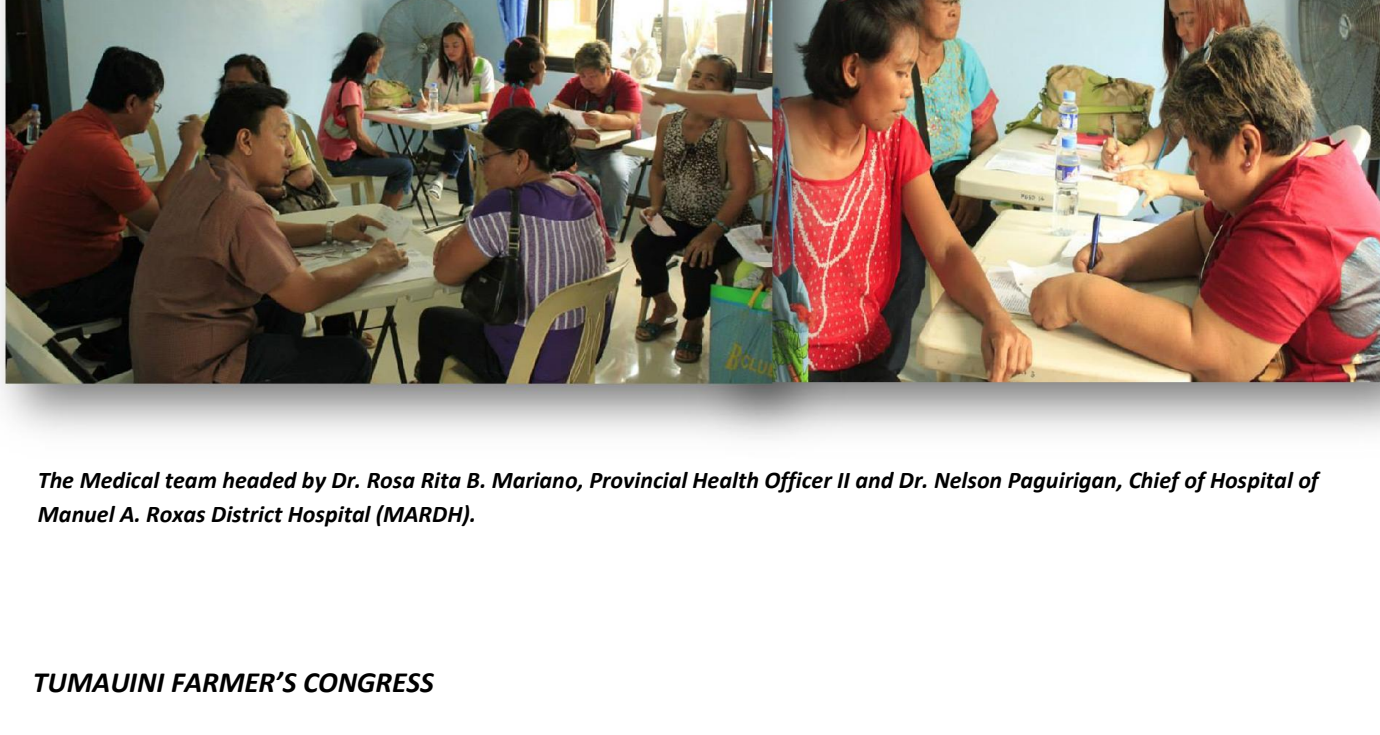

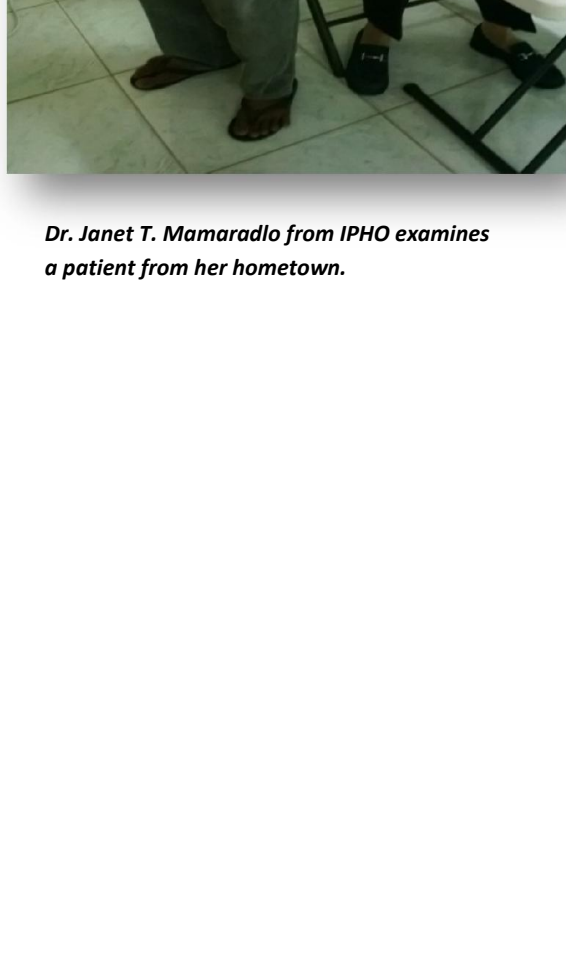

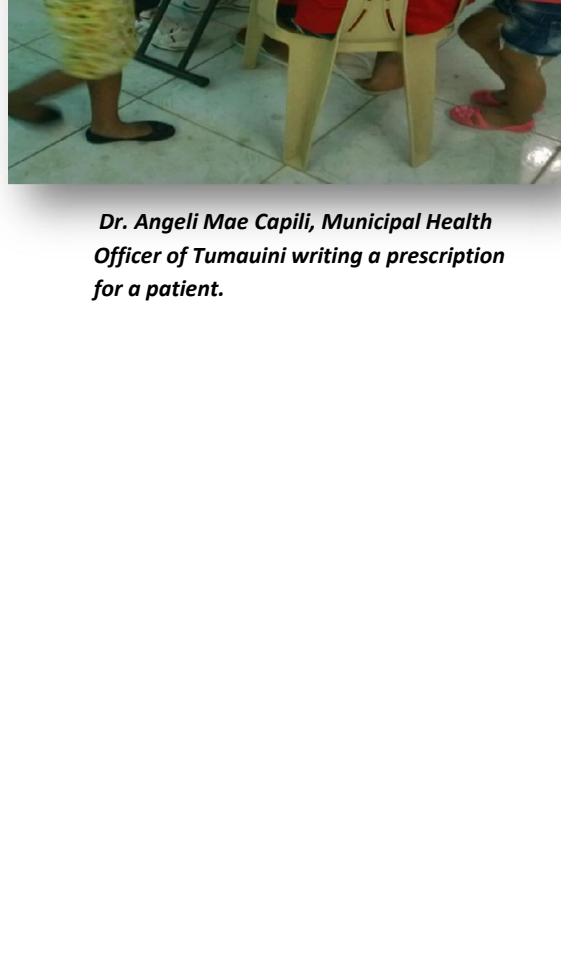

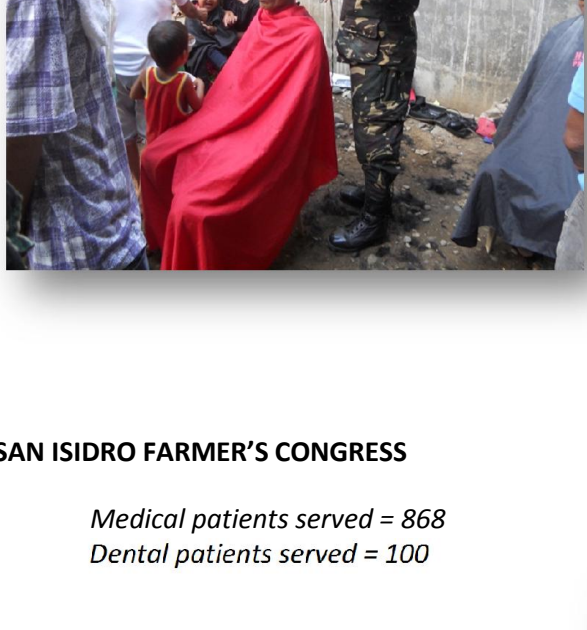

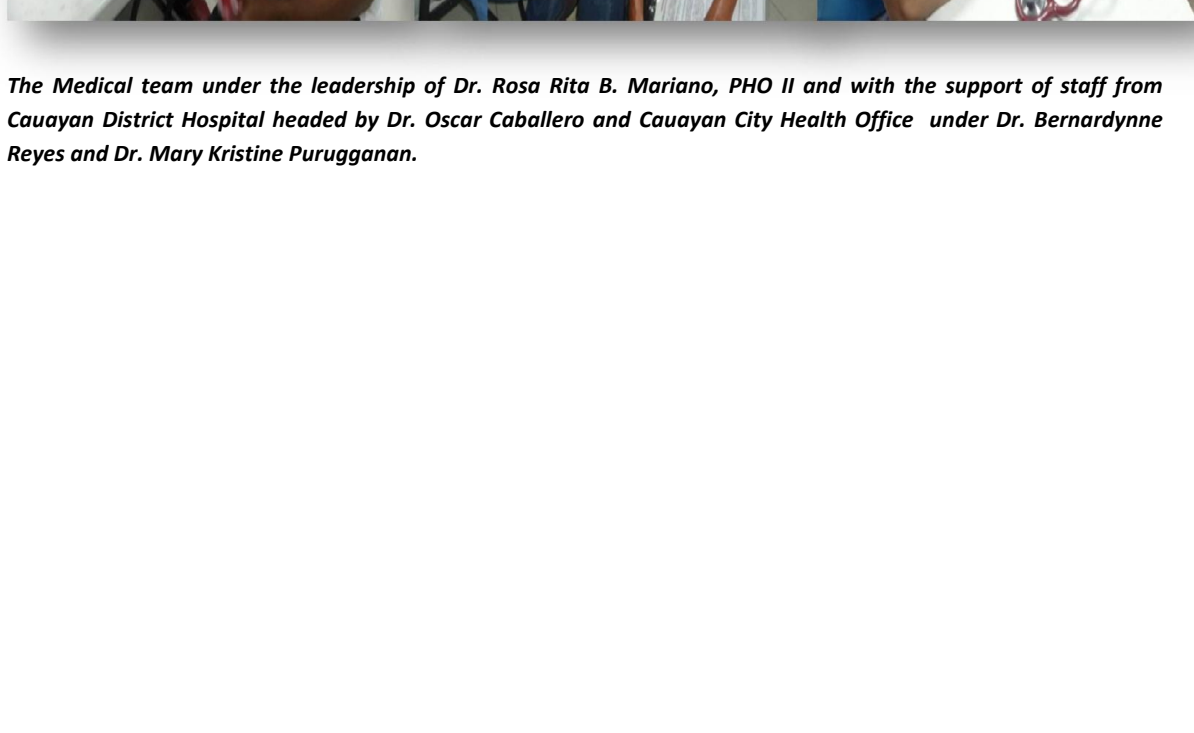

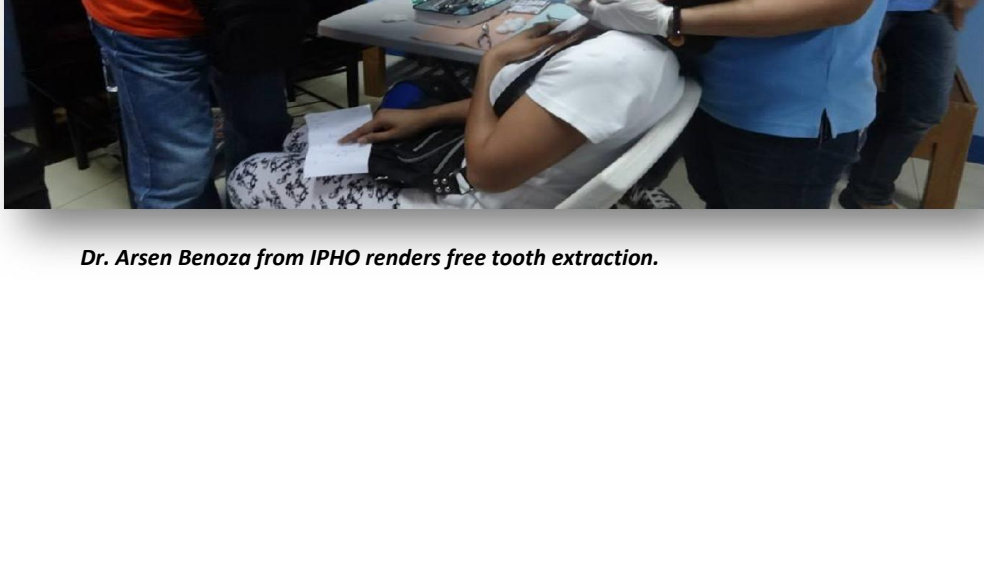
