Governor Dy further requested the city and municipal mayors in the province to seriously consider hiring or designating city and municipal veterinarians whose primary responsibilities will be to immunize dogs and ensure the proper implementation of Anti-Rabies and Stray Dog Control ordinance. He compared the present rabies situation of the province to a calamity that threaten people's

lives 24/7 and 365 days. Hence, he asked the local chief executives to include in their local development agenda and prioritize for funding the implementation of Anti-Rabies program in compliance with Republic Act No. 9482, otherwise known as the Anti-Rabies Act of 2007. Dr. Edgar G. Peleo, Medical Specialist III of the Department of Health Region 02, informed that the Philippines ranks sixth among Asian with the most number of cases of rabies infection next to

Bangladesh, India, Pakistan, Myammar and China. In Region 02, he said the province of Isabela has been the consistenttopnotcher for the past several years in terms of casualties of rabid dog bites with an average

of 10 deaths per year. Dr. Rosa Rita B. Mariano, Provincial Health Officer II of the Isabela Provincial Health Office, stood as one of the speakers in the said event. In her lecture, she discussed the Rabies infection in human. How rabies virus from


animals are transmitted to human, its clinical sign and symptoms and its treatment. She gave emphasis on proper wound care in treating animal bites. She

also encouraged everyone to always consult a health officer or go directly to the Animal Bite treatment Center for appropriate treatment.

She revealed that Rabies is a neglected and highly fatal disease killing 10-12Isabeleños every year. Children and 15 years old above are the most vulnerable to dog bites and rabies infection if not properly treated. Joining the summit, Dr. Angelo C. Naui, Provincial Veterinarian, discussed to the delegates the Rabies Control Program of stressed out the importance




