## "PasaDOH ba ang DATA natin"? Part IV

March 11-13, 2014

Provincial Health Office, Ilagan City–Focusing mainly on Maternal, Newborn, Child Health and Nutrition (MNCHN) and Family Planning Programs of the Department of Health, the four(4) PHO Technical teams in partnership with USAID-LuzonHealth continue to implement the simultaneous conduct of Data Quality Check (DQC), a three-day workshop which aims to generate valid and sound data to determine public health priorities.

Now on its 4<sup>th</sup> week of execution, this endeavor covered four municipalities namely, Sta. Maria, Tumauini, Roxas and San Manuel where Rural Health Unit personnel keenly participated. Using different forms such as Target Client List, Summary Table, Monthly Consolidation Tables and Monthly Form; all of which make up the Field Health Service Information System (FHSIS), were accurately reviewed by the four teams.

With the advent of this initiative, it is expected to contribute towards the attainment of Millennium Development Goal 5 on Improvement of Maternal Health to be achieved by 2015. It is strongly endorsed that standards of Data Quality Check be institutionalized in every RHU.

#### "Ideal Feeding Practices for Infants"

March 10-14, 2014

Provincial Capitol Food Court Training Hall, Ilagan City —Under the mandates of Universal Health Care for all Filipinos by the DOH, National Nutrition Council Region 2, in close partnership with the Provincial Government through the PHO paved the way for another batch of training intended for frontline health workers - barangay health workers, barangay nutrition scholars and parent leaders from three municipalities- Alicia, Sto.Tomas and Cabatuan.

Entitled, "Promote Good Nutrition and Infant and Young Child Feeding Training ", this training aims to capacitate the participants with necessary knowledge, proper counseling skills and behaviors on appropriate feeding methods on infants from birth until the first two years of life. The 5-day workshop involves interactive strategies eliciting considerable amount of involvement from the participants such as role-plays, fun games and actual demonstration on food preparation suitable for specific age groups.
