

## MONTH AT A GLANCE

For the month of February the Public Safety Office, led by department head Atty. Constante A. Foronda, Jr., together with Jimmy U. Rivera Sr., Assistant department head and concurrent Provincial Secu-Group Officer-in-Charge participated in various activities aimed at ensuring Peace and Order, Parking and Security preparations, Traffic Management and Crowd Control measures are disseminated across the Province.

Various coordinating meetings, walk-through and board map planning were held in full coordination with the Isabela Police Provincial Office, City PNP, Kabalikat, PGI Safety Officers and Peace and Order Council counterparts throughout the month.

The Provincial Development Council, League of Municipalities of the Philippines, PGI Department Heads had a joint meeting at Cabatuan Social Hall, Cabatuan Isabela February 6, 2018 while the 1st Quarter regular business meeting for PDRRMC was held at Balai Capitol, Ilagan, Isabela on February 9, 2018.

The Provincial Government of Isabela, true to its commitment of bringing the services of the Provincial Capitol nearer to it's constituents continue to hold the Bojie-Rodito Opportunities program thru it's Farmers Congress Initiative which are being held at various locations, Towns and Cities across the Province.

The 1st Quarter National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill was held on September 15, 2018 at exactly 2:00pm to which PSO personnel, together with the PGI Safety Officers and PDRR-MO (Dart Rescue 831) counterparts worked hand in hand to ensure evacuation procedures and disaster mitigating measures are observed during the Drill.

The Office, tasked to monitor and facilitate implementation of various Road Safey Laws across the Province thru the PNP-PDRRMC Quick Response Motorcycle Riders also known as the EO 18 Riders, continue to monitor operations, provide necessary reports and spread Road Safety Awareness by distributing Road Safety tips and flyers through various platforms such as the Farmers Congress Reloaded and Social Media.

### **EO 18 MONITORING AND OPERATIONS**

The Public Safety Office and the PDRRMC Quick Response Motorcycle Riders continue to work hand-in-hand in ensuring that Peace and Order as well as Road Safety and Security are of utmost importance at all times especially during major Provincial events / activities where the likelihood of disorder or chaos are at a high risk due to the volume of vehicles and

participants.

The EO 18 riders resumed operations across the Province upon receiving the new Deputation Licenses provided by the Land Transportation Office last week of January.

## 1st Quarter National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill

The Public Safety Office and the PGI Safety Officers, in full coordination with the PDRRMO Dart Rescue 831, Philippine Red Cross - Isabela chapter representatives among other volunteer groups once again responded to the call of the Office of Civil Defense in conducting the 1st Quarter National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill last February 15, 2018 at exactly 2:00 pm.

The Bureau of Fire Protection acted as observers for the said event and provided the customary critique at the Balai Isabela Conference Hall immediately after the event.

Various scenarios were prepared by the Dart 831 Emergency Medical Technicians to make the Drill as close as possible to the real thing, even adding a breakout fire scenario wherein BFP personnel from the Isabela Provincial station provided a fire-fighting simulation

at the rear portion of the Provincial Capitol.

Bureau of Fire Protection observers noted the skill exhibited by the Dart 831 rescuers as well as Safety Officers in responding to those distressed and also commended the whole group for the unity and cooperation shown during the whole exercise. Other comments and critique were discussed during the post-activity meeting as the Public Safety Officer, Provincial Information Office, Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer thanked all participants and volunteers.


