and knowledge thru various trainings related to Safety and Health programs.

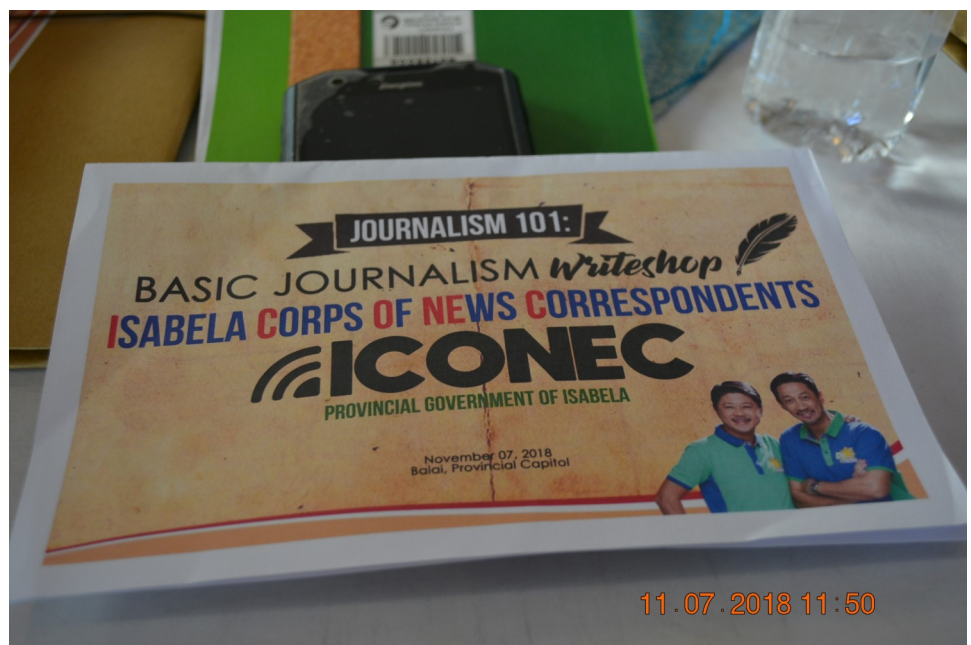

who just completed their training 2 weeks prior.
