MONTH AT A GLANCE

For the month of OCTOBER, the Public Safety Office, led by department head Atty. Constante A. Foronda, Jr., together with Jimmy U. Rivera Sr., Assistant department head and concurrent Provincial Security Group Officer-in-Charge participated in various activities for the Province. The Office joined various coordinating meetings, capability enhancement trainings and worked on confidential matters in line with the initiatives and orders of the Governor. PSO personnel con-

tinue to support the various programs and activities of the Office, true to it's mandate of providing training and community awareness programs, facilitate coordinating meetings and produce updated Safety IEC materials by constantly researching new safety measures and acquiring skills and knowledge thru various trainings related to Safety and Health programs.

The Office, tasked to monitor and facilitate implementation of various Road Safety Laws across the Province thru the PNP-PDRRMC Quick Response Motorcycle Riders also known as the EO 18 Riders, continue to monitor operations, provide necessary reports and spread Road Safety Awareness by distributing Road Safety tips, Road Safety Program Laws and Ordinances Handbook to LEO's and flyers through various platforms such as the Farmers Congress Reloaded and Social Media.

For the month, the Office joined Road Safety activities, facilitated the training of the 2nd batch of PNP-PDRRMC Isabela Provisional Police Motorcycle Unit.

An 8 day training course consisting of 3 days Highway Patrol Group Motorcycle Riding, 3 days Basic Life Support / First-Aid and Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation, and 2 days Land Transportation Office - Law Enforcement Deputization was held at Balai Isabela Guest House and different locations from October 15-23, 2018.

As part of the initial vision of the Provincial Governor, keys to new Quick Response motorcycle units were symbolically awarded to the Philippine National Police at Camp Adduru, Tuguegarao City, Cagayan on October 29, 2018.

"EO 18 RIDERS BATCH 2" (ISABELA PROVISIONAL POLICE MOTORCYCLE UNIT BATCH 2)

The Isabela Provisional Police Motorcycle Unit, more popularly known within the Province as the "EO 18 riders", recently had a major upgrade in terms of manpower, training and equipment. A brainchild of the Provincial Governor, the concept of creating a quick response motorcycle unit from the ranks of the Philippine National Police equipped with skills and knowledge on Road Safety Laws, First Responder education and Land Transportation Office enforcer deputization came into fruition on the year 2015 in order to supplement Local Government Unit operatives in responding to emergencies and enforcing Road Safety Laws such as Executive Order no. 18, series of 2014, hence the moniker "EO 18 riders". Initially, 16 motorcycle



units out of the planned 48 units and 16 PNP riders constituted the first batch as they started operations across the Province as Deputized Law Enforcers mid-2016 together with the Highway Patrol Group and Land Transportation Office operatives.

As of 2018, the Provincial Government of Isabela, true to the Governor's initial vision, acquired additional motorcycle units to complete the 48 initially planned for during project inception 3 years prior. Upon learning of this development, the Isabela Provincial Police Office provided 32 new riders from their ranks through the coordinated efforts of the Isabela PDRRM Council and the Isa-

bela Public Safety Office for a series of trainings and seminars for 8 days which constituted of a 3-day Motorcycle riding course facilitated by the Highway Patrol Group-Region 2, a 3-day First Responder training (Basic Life Support, First Aid and Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation) facilitated by the Isabela PDRRMO-Dart 831 Emergency Medical Technicians and a 2-day Land Transportation Office Law Enforcer deputization training from October 15-23, 2018.

On October 29, 2018, the Provincial Governor, together with the Provincial Public Safety Officer symbolically turned-over the keys to the new motorcycle units to the Philippine National Police at Camp Adduru, Tuguegarao City, Cagayan during the 117th Police Service Anniversary.


























































