	 prayer and devotion (evening and morning) were provided to all residents to improved spiritual growth. Religious group also conduct Bible sharing to all residents for enhancement of spiritual knowledge and relationship with God.
Recreational, Sports and other Socio-	 Welcoming 2024/New Year was simply celebrated with provision of food, gifts, and goodies provided to all residents.
Cultural Activities	 Three (3) residents have celebrated their natal day and afforded them with traditional food and cake (baked by the children).
