✓ As member of the Child Friendly Local Government Audit (CFLGA), Ms. Charmiya Rosalinda L. Cruz, SWO III of the PSWD Office represented PSWDO Ambatali during the meeting with DILG, DepEd and representatives from the different L GUs conducted last July 24, 2014 held at the DILG Provincial Office. The main objective of the activity was to discuss the conduct of LGU validation for the CFLGA for this year.

Six (6) municipalities namely Roxas, Burgos, Quirino, jones, Alicia and San Mateo and two (2) cities namely Ilagan and Cauayan were recommended for final evaluation by the Regional Team as contenders to the first ever Seal of Child Friendly Local Governance.
