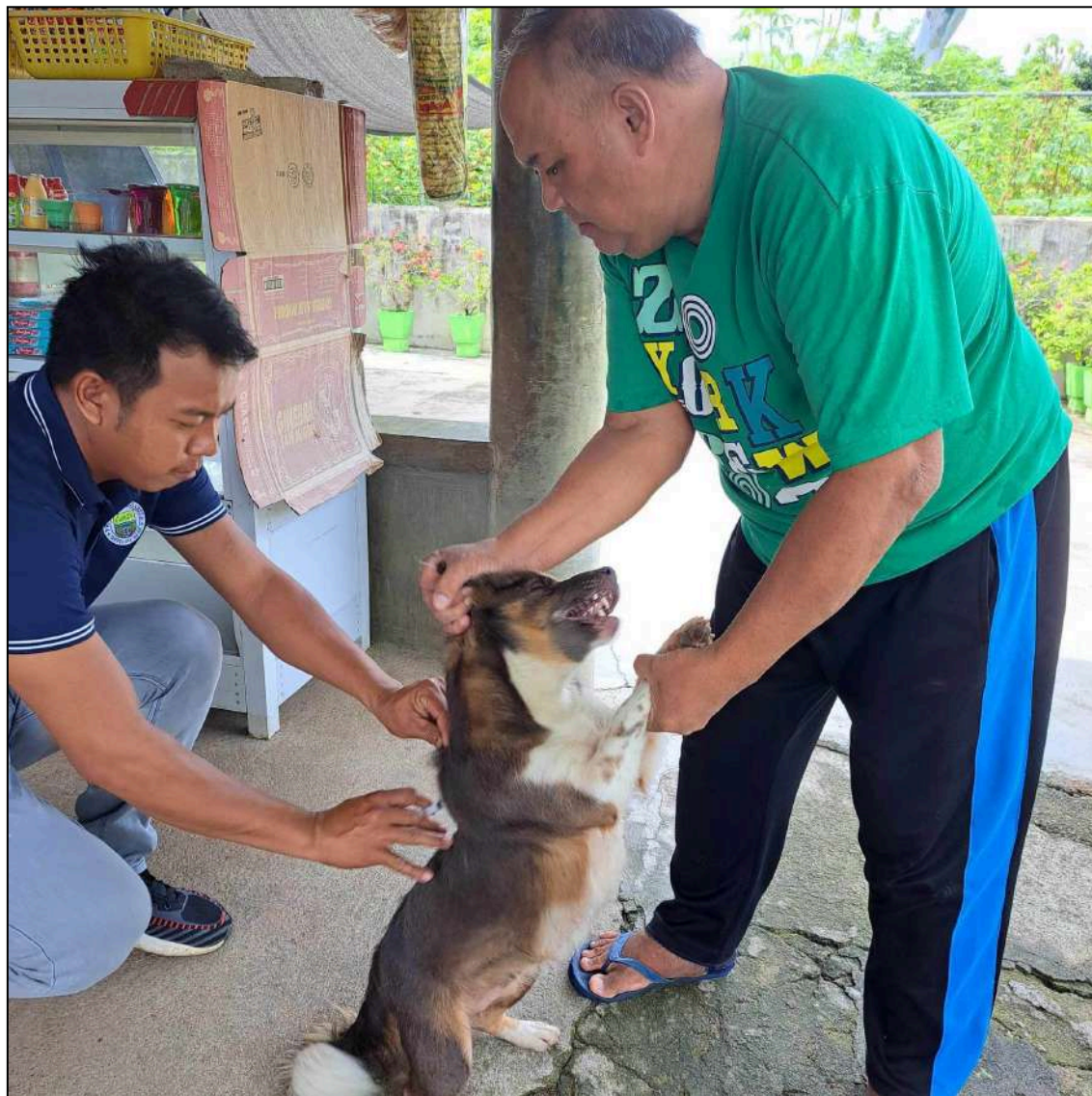
## **RABIES CONTROL PROGRAM**

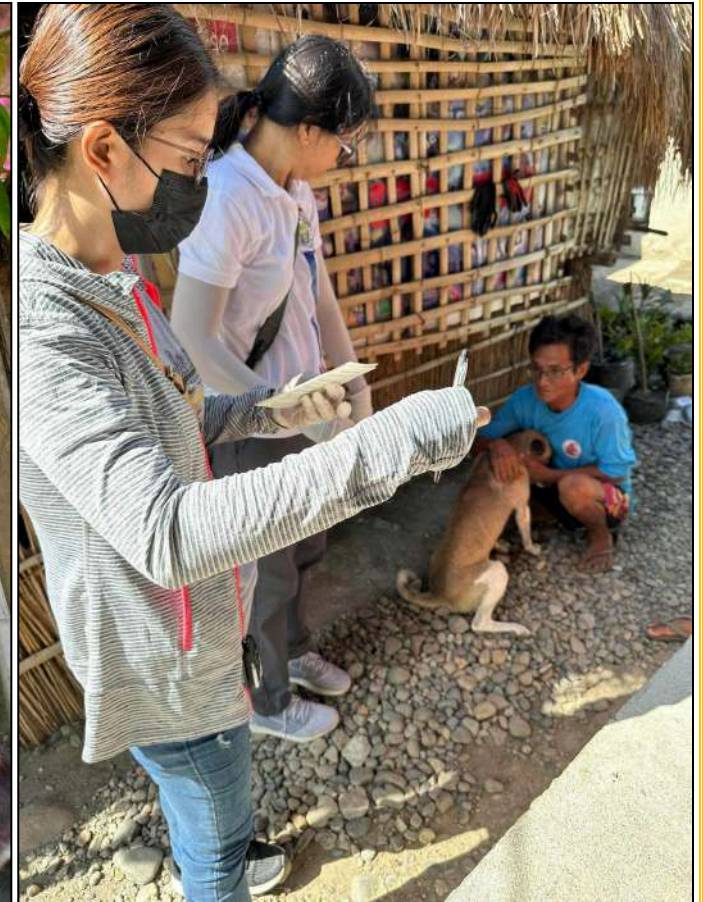

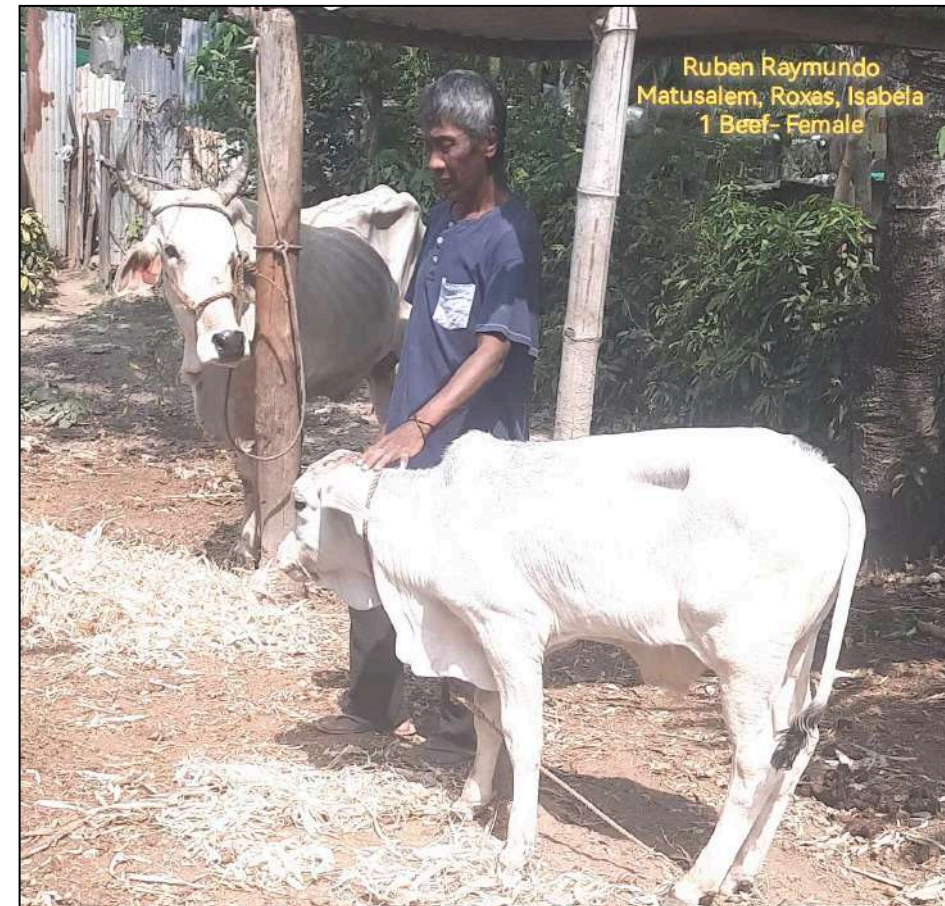

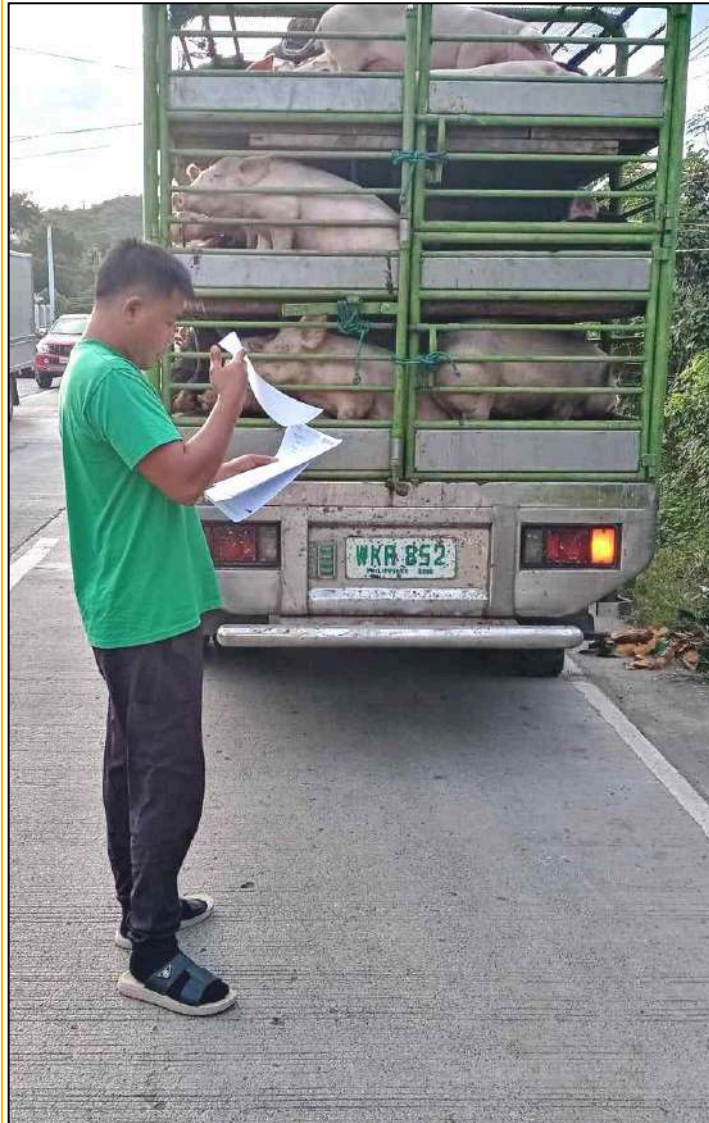
### ANIMAL HEALTH QUARANTINE CHECKPOINT
