PARTICIPATION TO THE CONDUCT OF TODAS DENGUE, TODO NA

'TO! (IKAPITONG KAGAT) IN ACCORDANCE TO EXECUTIVE ORDER

NO. 26 s.2020 OF THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

As a pro-active measure against the possible rise of dengue cases and other mosquito-borne diseases in Isabela during the wet season, the provincial government, for several years now, has consistently championed the welfare and health of the entire Isabela community through the annual conduct of Todas Dengue, Todo Na 'To! – a simultaneous, massive, multisectoral, and inter-agency clean-up activity aimed at eradicating all and possible dengue mosquito breeding sites along public and private spaces in the province, therefore reducing the incidence and preventing mortality caused by dengue fever.

On its seventh successful year, the provincial government released Executive Order No. 26 series of 2020 signed by the Honorable Governor Rodolfo T. Albano III enjoining all government and non-government offices in the province for the conduct of Todas Dengue, Todo Na 'To (Ika-Pitong Kagat) on June 12, 2020 (Friday). Consequently, the Office of the Sangguniang Kabataan Pederasyon President released Memorandum No. 4 – 2020 directing all SK Federation Presidents, Chairpersons and other Officials to lead the simultaneous clean-up activity within their respective barangays and thereafter submit an accomplishment report.





Despite the CoViD-19 pandemic, the provincial government recognizes the importance of addressing other health concerns, such as dengue, to avoid the risk of having to face another health crisis besides CoViD-19. Acknowledging that the fight for health security is a shared responsibility of the general community, the provincial government, through the Provincial Youth Development Office, advise all members to (1) actively participate and exhaustively eliminate mosquito breeding sites in public and private communities; (2) document the conduct of the clean-up activity and the participation of your respective agency/organization; and, (3) submit a report to the Provincial Youth Development Office or send it at pydoisabela@gmail.com not later than June 30, 2020 – all while observing social distancing and other precautionary measures, i.e. wearing of face mask.
