A total of 5,491 scholars were able to apply for scholarship until March 14, 2020 before application were temporarily postponed due to CoViD-19 pandemic, that is, including application submitted to extension offices in Cauayan City and Echague.

Council NAGKAISA - Provincial Youth Development Council 1st Quarterly Meeting, FY 2020 (March 9, 2020)	Council NAGKAISA-PYDC, in its 1st Quarterly Meeting, includes in its agenda the discussion of the (1) 2019 Youth Development Accomplishment Report and Assessment; (2) Initial planning of priority projects and programs for FY 2020; and the (3) Presentation of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution on the Provincial Youth Development Plan (PYDP 2020-2022) and the Isabela Youth Code/Ordinance, among others.	Fourteen of Nineteen (14/19) Council members attended the meeting presided by the Chairman and SK Federation President Hon. Dax Paolo C. Binag. Also present to witness and share insights is the DILG-Isabela represented by Mr. Michael L. Benigno and Ms. Einnor M. Dugay. Aside from the adopted agenda, an urgent topic was also discussed by the Provincial Administrator himself. Atty. Noel Manuel R. Lopez divulged information re the province's initial precautionary measures against CoViD-19 and the role of the youth in such crisis, as the country was put under a National Health Emergency.
Local Youth Development Officers' Capacity-Building Cum Training (March 13-14, 2020)	The LYDO Capacity-Building is a seminar/workshop specifically designed to further capacitate the Youth Development Officers of Isabela. The provincial government desires to ensure that the welfare and development of the youth are promoted in every region of the province and in all levels of governance. It aims to pave way for more competent Youth Development Officers further committed to provide empowering projects and programs for our Kabataang Isabeleños.	The two-day LYDO Training was divided into 5 comprehensive lectures and 2 workshops. At the end of the training, LYDOs were reviewed with Youth Development Laws; the relationship among SK-LYDO-LYDC functions; YORP Policy Guidelines; LYDC Convening and Election Guidelines; and the crafting and updating of the Local Youth Development Plan. Resource Persons during the training include Atty. Karla Louise Dioquino-Agbayani of PLO; Mr. Michael Benigno of DILG-Isabela; Mr. Rey Mel Resposo, OIC-PYDO and the Provincial Administrator himself, Atty. Noel Manuel R. Lopez.


