Amidst the pandemic, BRO for Education Scholarship Program continues to provide cash allowances to encourage more Isabeleño youth, especially the marginalized, to finish their studies.	A total of 16 thousand viewers has participated on the FB Live Broadcast while a maximum of 300 participants was able to participated via Zoom. During the activity, Mr. Reymel C. Resposo, the Scholarship Coordinator, discussed the Provincial Scholarship Program's History, Background, and Beneficiaries. For the two-way application process and the application requirements, Mr. Jayson Aquino discussed and provided a sample of the requirements that the applicant should submit, while Ms. Diane Bagain discussed how to fill out the google form in the Online Application. After the orientation, an Open Forum was set where the students were given a chance to ask their queries re: BRO- Ed Application. On the same day, BRO for Education opened the Online Application and the submission of the hard copy of the requirements through the Local Youth Development Officers and SK Officers in their respective Cities/Municipalities. Present during the launching of the PYDAC are members from the different line agencies, the academe, and the departments and offices from the provincial government. The National Line Agencies were well represented by the Provincial/Regional Directors, the academe by the College/University Presidents, and the PGI Departments/Offices by the Department Heads. After the Launching of the PYDAC, Mr. Rey Mel C. EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 26 Series of 2021

ORGANIZING THE PROVINCIAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COUNCIL (PYDAC)

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the state to recognize the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth, patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act 10742, otherwise known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act, provides that the State shall establish adequate, effective, responsive, and enabling mechanism and support system that will ensure the meaningful participation of the youth in local governance and nationbuilding.

WHEREAS, Section 14 of Republic Act of 8044, otherwise known as "The Youth in Nation-Building Act," strengthens the existence of youth advisory council in national and regional level;

WHEREAS, the development of the youth sectors in the Province of Isabela is one of the priorities of the Provincial Government as it passed and later amended the *Isabela Youth Welfare and Development Code* acknowledging therein the important role of Isabeleño youth in nation-building by recognizing their right to have a representation in the formulation of the provincial government's policies, promoting their political, civil, social and economic rights, recognizing the plight of out-of-school and vulnerable youth, young mothers, youth with special needs, and the financially disadvantaged, and providing them with necessary and age-appropriate assistance;

WHEREAS, similar advisory council in the provincial level would provide venues for the consolidation of issues concerning the youth and for quick coordination to address these;

WHEREAS, despite having an existing and active Provincial Youth Development Council chaired by the Sangguniang Panlalawigang Pederasyon President, a supplementary advisory council for the youth chaired by the Honorable Governor himself shall provide and guarantee a more holistic and inclusive approach to various youth concerns and issues in the province;

NOW THEREFORE, I, RODOLFO T. ALBANO III, Governor of the province of Isabela, by powers vested in me by law, do hereby decree the following:

SECTION 1. ORGANIZATION. The PROVINCIAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (PYDAC) is hereby organized.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION. The PYDAC shall be composed of, to wit:

- 1. Provide reports and updates on all youth-related affairs and activities, including but not limited to, plans, programs, policies, projects intended for the youth sector of the province;
- 2. Coordinate with and recommend to the Provincial Youth Development Council (PYDC) strategies of implementation for a short, medium, and long-term youth development programs and activities of the province;
- 3. Recommend to the Provincial Governor policies, programs, projects, and activities for the youth based on the consolidated felt needs as discussed in the Council.

SECTION 4. MEETINGS. The PYDAC shall meet once every three (3) months or as often as may be necessary, upon the call of its Chairman, on important matters relating to youth affairs, welfare, and development.

The Council may form task forces who shall convene between meetings. The Provincial Youth Development Office shall provide technical support and Secretariat required to function as required by this Order.

SECTION 4. FUNDING. The Provincial Government shall allocate a portion of its fund from the Provincial Youth Development Plan (PYDP) for the Council operations.

SECTION 5. EFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
