<b>BRO for Education release of allowance for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester AY 2019-2020</b>	<p>The Bojie-Rodito Opportunities for Education commenced with the release of Scholarship Allowance for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester of AY 2019-2020, with the following municipalities scheduled and through for the month of January, 2021:</p> <p><b>March 9 – Jones, Isabela</b> with 479 scholars and <b>San Agustin, Isabela</b> with 177 scholars;</p> <p><b>March 10 – San Mariano, Isabela</b> with 462 scholars;</p> <p><b>March 11 – Cabagan, Isabela</b> with 831 scholars;</p> <p><b>March 17 – Palanan, Isabela</b> with 262 scholars, <b>Maconacon, Isabela</b> with 50 scholars, and <b>Divilacan, Isabela</b> with 34 scholars;</p>	<p>Municipalities scheduled for March were successfully visited and scholars were granted their scholarship allowance and a 10-kilogram sack of NMIAC rice (except for those in coastal municipalities), all while strictly adhering to health protocols and standards. Unclaimed allowances during the release date can be claimed at the Provincial Capitol up to three days after their official schedule.</p>



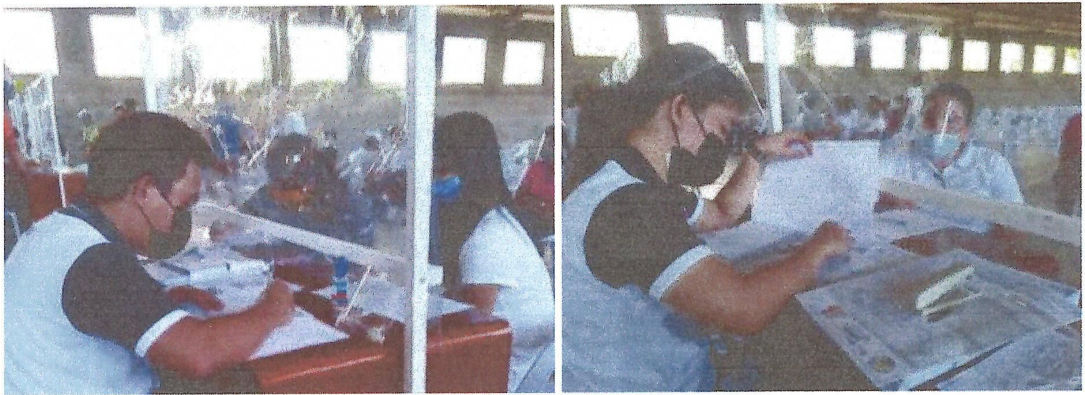
