Cabagan Municipal Hall 	<p>From the previous ease of doing the application process due to the restrictions of the pandemic, the provincial scholarship coordinators are gradually shifting back to the conventional way of how the application is done before, that is, without compromising the safety standards and health protocols set by the authorities.</p> <p>Two years into the pandemic, BRO for Education has been exclusively conducting the scholarship application process via online. This year, the provincial government is bringing back the personal/face-to-face orientation and interview during the submission of requirements which was not present for the past two years of online application.</p>



