TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE DURING THE ISU- ECHAGUE STUDENTS FESTIVAL 2023 April 12, 2023	As part of the 2023 Students Week Celebration of the Isabela State University – Echague Campus, the Office of the Student Services, through the Supreme Student Council, invited the Provincial Government of Isabela, through its Provincial Youth Development Office as one of the Resource Persons during the conduct of the Students Festival Symposium. With the theme, "Invigorating the Culture of Camaraderie and Ingenuity for every ISUan," the Symposium focused on issues concerning the youth and the students, i.e. mental health and youth participation in governance.	Attended by some 200 student and youth leaders, the symposium was held at the De Venecia Hall of ISU-Main Campus. OIC-PYDO Rey Mel C. Resposo presented and discussed the local Youth Organization Registration Program as one of the primary youth development services provided by the provincial government to the Isabeleño Youth. TINIG NG SIERRA MADRE: A FORUM ON ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION IN COMMEMORATION WITH EARTH DAY April 24, 2023	In celebration of this year's Earth Day, the Provincial Government of Isabela, through the Isabela Coastal Development Office, the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office, and the Provincial Youth Development Office, in partnership with the Isabela State University, spearheaded the Tinig ng Sierra Madre — A forum on Environmental Protection which aims to raise awareness about the importance of the Northern Sierra Madre Natural Park and the need to exhaust all efforts to protect and preserve the country's last frontier of biodiversity.	Graced and supported by no less than Isabela 6th Congressional District Representative, Hon. Faustino "Inno" A. Dy V as the Keynote Speaker, Forum participants were able to engage in an open dialogue with the Congressman specifically in relation to House Bill 1214 or the Sierra Madre Conservation and Development Authority Bill, which the Hon. Dy has sponsored before the House of Representatives.	

The Tinig ng Sierra Madre Forum was participated in by 250 stakeholder representatives from the different sectors of society to include local and national government agencies, non-government organizations, youth and student leaders, women, IP, the academe, lawyers, barangay officials, and the private and business sector.

Advocates and experts on the field of Environmental Conservation and Climate Change Adaptation were invited as Resource Persons during Provincial Forum. The Administrator, Atty. Noel Manuel R. Lopez discussed the Environmental Programs and Projects of the Provincial Government of Isabela. Meanwhile, Regional Director Troy Alexander G. Miano, through Ms. Kristine A. Wandagan, presented the of Ecotourism Overview Management in the Province of Isabela, For, Nestor S. Lorenzo, DENR Region 2 Park Operations Superintendent, and Ms. Luzviminda U. Rosario DENR Region 2 Ecosystem Management Specialist, presented the Sierra Madre Overview and the Current State of the Coastal Areas in Isabela while Mr. Bondee L. Peñaflor. Cabagan Campus Planning and Development Director of the College of Forestry discussed Climate Change Mitigation and Marine Ecosystems Biodiversity.

As one of the major outputs of the Forum, the Multisectoral Network for Sierra Madre Protection was organized as facilitated by ICDO Head Ms. Gretchen Valdez and PYD Officer-in-Charge Mr. Rey Mel C. Resposo. Another highlight of the Forum was the recitation and signing of the Covenant for the Protection and Conservation of Mother Earth led by Asst. ENRO Rosemarie T. Zabala.





