Once registered under the YORP, the Provincial Youth Development Office, through the PYDO Focal Person on YORP, uploads the required documents of the Youth and Youth-Serving Organizations to the NYC YORP Hub for verification. After which, verified Organizations are given a Unique Registration Number as their identification to the NYC's database of YOs and YSOs. Organizations need to renew their registration every three years and shall submit an accomplishment report annually. 

The Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Law of 2015 (Republic Act 10742) provides that every province, city, municipality, and barangay shall formulate their Local Youth Development Plan (LYDP), Comprehensive Barangay Youth Development Plan (CBYDP), Annual Barangay Youth Investment Plan (ABYIP) through their respective SK Officials, members of the Local Youth Development Council (LYDC), and assistance of the Local Youth Development Officers (LYDO).

Accordingly, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) has issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-138 relative to the Guidelines on Monitoring the Implementation of the LYDP, CBYDP, and ABYIP set forth by a resolution adopted by National Youth Commission (NYC).

The said guidelines provide that preparation of such documents should begin by January of every year where barangay SK Officials shall accomplish the M&E Form 1 and submit this to the C/MYDO on or before the last week of the month. Further, by February the C/MYDO consolidates the M&E Form 1, accomplishes M&E Form 2 and submits this to the PYDO on or before last week of the month.

In reference thereof, may we respectfully request your office to submit the accomplished M&E Form 2 on or before 27 February 2023.
