


<p>2024 BAMBANTI FESTIVAL SPORTS ACTIVITIES (iRUN FOR YOUTH CENTER: A 5K COLOR FUN RUN AND RAVE PARTY & 25K FUN BIKE CHALLENGE FOR YOUTH CENTER January 22 & 27, 2024</p>	<p>With the theme, "Ettam Ngana ta Isabela!", this year's Bambanti Festival highlighted the magnificence of Isabela culture through astounding performances and thrilling scheduled activities. Evidently, one of the most anticipated events this year were the Color Fun Run and Fun Bike Challenge both for the benefit of establishing an Isabela Youth Center and facilitated by the Bambanti Festival 2024 Committee on Sports Events composed of the Hon. Marco Paolo Meris and Hon. Catherine L. Legaspi as Chairpersons, Hon. Edgar Capuchino and Mr. Rey Mel C. Resposo as Co-Chairpersons, and Mr. Ruben Pagayatan and Mr. Robert Plata as members.</p>	<p>Different from the usual route, iRUN for Youth Center passed along the Baligatan – Alibagu area with its starting point at the Isabela Police Provincial Office Compound and its finish line at the Queen Isabela Park. Led by Sangguniang Kabataan Officials and Youth Organizations in Isabela, nearly 8,000 of the 13,245 total registrants gathered at the IPPO Compound to get hyped with bubble machines and color blasters and dance through the zumba led by guest artists and influencers before the official start of the Run.</p>

	<p>Dubbed as iRUN for Youth Center: A 5K Color Fun Run and Rave Party, this year's Fun Run was among the opening activities of the Bambanti Festival scheduled on its first day, January 22, 2024. Registration went for a week from January 15 to the noon of January 22 with most, if not all, government offices and agencies, state universities and colleges, and non-government organizations in the province, invited to register and participate.</p> <p>To ensure the participation of the entire province, particularly the youth, Hon. Marco Paolo Meris, Hon. Catherine Legaspi, and Mr. Rey Mel C. Resposo scheduled meetings with the Isabela State University and the Department of Education Divisions of Isabela, City of Ilagan, and Cauayan City to request for the commitment of their respective institutions. True enough, the ISU Office of the President issued a Memorandum requiring all BRO for Education Scholars and other students to participate. Likewise, DepEd Isabela issued a Division Memorandum encouraging all students, faculty, and staff to register and participate.</p> <p>The Sports Committee led by Hon. Meris and Hon. Legaspi also called for a Coordination Meeting with the Provincial Public Safety Office, the Bureau of Fire Protection, the Philippine National Police (PNP) Isabela and City of Ilagan, City of Ilagan Public Order and Safety Management Office, the Provincial General Services Office, and the Bambanti Logistics Committee to discuss matters on safety, traffic, and logistics.</p>	<p>No less than the Vice Governor and Bambanti Festival 2024 Director General, Hon. Faustino G. Dy III, together with the other members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, marked the start of the iRUN for Youth Center. Runners jogged from the IPPO to the Queen Isabela Park where a Rave and Bubble Party was awaiting featuring guest artists and DJs.</p> <p>Awards were given to the Youngest Finisher, Oldest Finisher, First Couple Finisher, First Barkada Finisher, First Family Finisher, and the Biggest Group Finisher at the finish line. The Youngest Finisher was awarded to Alexander Lanuza, 9 years old; the Oldest Finisher was Angel Ceralde, 56 years old; the First Couple Finisher was Rochelle Sanique and John Lloyd Duque, the First Family Finisher was 202nd CDC, 2RCDG, the First Barkada Finisher was Lloyd Mark Lope and his friends, and the Biggest Group was awarded to the HGB College with 1,098 registrants.</p> <p>Another sports event awaited by many enthusiasts was the 25K Fun Bike Challenge where a total of 429 Bikers from across Isabela and its neighboring provinces registered and joined. The Fun Bike was among the final activities of the Bambanti Festival scheduled on January 27, 2024, Saturday. The Start and Finish line of the Fun Bike was at the Isabela Provincial Capitol Grounds and traversed the barangays of Alibagu, Bliss (Villa Jesusa), Namnama, Fugu, Malalam, San Felipe, Guinatan, Osmeña, Calamagui (ISU), and Baligatan.</p> <p>Hon. Catherine Legaspi, SK Federation President and Chairman of the Committee on Sports Events officially opened the Fun Bike Challenge with almost 400 bikers in attendance. After nearly thirty-five</p>

		<p>minutes, the first two finishers have arrived at the finish line. The first, second, and third male and female finishers were given special recognition along with the youngest, oldest, and biggest group finishers.</p> <p>The first male finisher was Joffer Cuyob, the second male finisher was Gregory Jade Coloma, and the third male finisher Ken Cabacungan. The first female finisher Bernadette Tulagan, the second female finisher was Mary Grace Clarino, and the third female finisher was Sophia Chan. The oldest finisher was Francisco Ramones, 85 years old, the youngest finishers were Kurt Cauilan and Jaren Andrei Tomas, both 10 years old, and the biggest group was Roxas, Isabela Bikers.</p> <p>With 13,245 total registrants for the Fun Run and 429 registrants for the Fun Bike, the total proceeds reached One Million Three Hundred Three Thousand and Six Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php1,303,650.00) all for the benefit of establishing the Isabela Youth Center – a centralized base for youth movement and development in Isabela. When established, it shall be home to an inclusive and wide range of assistance and support to the youth such as mental health counseling, teen and peer coaching, music, arts, and sports classes, BRO Scholarship Center, volunteer and training center, and other services catering to the overall needs and concerns of the Kabataang Isabeleños. The Youth Center shall be an effective mechanism to ensure that the wellbeing of the youth is not just heard and considered, but are also acted upon in the most convenient, efficient, and responsive manner – a priority of the provincial government through the leadership of the Albano-Dy administration.</p>
