AGENCY PROFILE

Echague District Hospital, formerly Primo Gaffud District Hospital was originally located at San Fabian, Echague, Isabela and started operating in 1974 as a ten-bed (10) capacity Primary Hospital. In May 2005, it was relocated at Ipil, Echague, Isabela in one of the four (4) district hospitals constructed during the incumbency of Governor Faustino S. Dy Jr. The new hospital was inaugurated on June 29, 2004. On September 13, 2005, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Isabela approved and adopted a Resolution naming the new hospital as Echague District Hospital. It is a core referral hospital of the Southern Inter-Local Health Zone which includes the municipalities of Echague, Jones, San Agustin, San Isidro, Ramon, Cordon, Dinapigue and Santiago City with a combined population of about 429,156. The population served is not only confined to its catchment areas but also to patients coming from adjacent municipalities of Alicia, Angadanan, San Guillermo, San Mateo and as far as the provinces of Quirino and Ifugao.

The Echague District Hospital is a 25-bed general hospital which is continuously experiencing tremendous influx of patients with a bed occupancy rate of 183.12% in 2018, the reason why they're a need to upsize the hospital from 25 beds to 50 beds.

Vision – The Echague District Hospital envisions to be a 50 bed hospital with modern facilities and equipment, complete and competent personnel to ensure quality medical and surgical services that is affordable, accessible and cost effective.






Total OPD Patients Attended


In the last five years (2014-2018), 2018 had the highest OPD Cases attended.

Urinalysis/Fecalysis




Hematology/Clinical Chemistry




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X-ray procedures



Dental Services (tooth extraction)




There was a tremendous increase in the **urinalysis** performed in 2018 as compared to the previous 4 years. While the **hematology** performed had an almost two-fold increase. There was also a slight increase in the number of X-ray procedures done and in the number of tooth extraction performed. These contributed significantly to the huge increase in the Laboratory/X-ray/Dental fee **income** of the hospital, the bulk of which came from the laboratory procedures.


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Animal Bite Treatment Center Patients

Hospital Facility Improvement

Clogging of our water pipes and faucets by sand and dirt had always been the problem of the hospital. In June 2018, our source of water which was previously 9 meters deep only was improved. Drilling of a 24 meters deep well water system and installation of submersible pump with enclosure was done by the General Services Office and the Provincial Engineering staff of the Provincial Government of Isabela. Upon completion, our water system had been functioning well.






Construction of submersible pump

In the same month, repair of Comfort Rooms and installation of ramps for Persons With Disability were carried out by the Provincial Government of Isabela and is now in full use.

In September 2018, installation of water sprinkler, smoke detector and fire alarm system as required by the Bereau of Fire Prevention was started and funded by the Provincial Government of Isabela. The project is still on-going at present.

Last November 2018, construction of a new (8) Private Rooms Annex Building was started through the Health Facility Enhancement Program of the Department of Health. It is around 70 percent completed as of this time.

In May 2018, syphoning of septic tank waste and cleaning was done through the General Services Office of the Provincial Government of Isabela. The whole project amounted to P 190,000.00.
