#### **D. PERSONNEL STAFFING**

As of September 2019, there are Seventy Two (72) Plantilla Positions, wherein fifty seven (57) personnel are with permanent positions. At present, there are 8 permanent physicians, 1 Dentist, 5 private Doctors with different specialties serving the hospital under Memorandum of Agreement with the Provincial Government of Isabela. In the Nursing Service, there are 9 permanent Nurses, 4 contractual Nurses, 8 permanent Nursing Attendants, 1 permanent Midwife and 21 contractual Nursing Attendants. In the Ancillary Services, 2 permanent Med. Tech., 4 contractual Med. Tech., 1 permanent Lab. Aide., 2 permanent Rad. Tech, 5 contractual Rad. Tech., 2 Permanent Pharmacists, 5 Contractual Pharmacists and 1 contractual Pharmacy Aide. In Administrative Services, 23 permanent employees and 30 contractual employees.
