#### **D. PERSONNEL STAFFING**

As of February 2022, there are Eighty (89) Plantilla Positions, wherein sixty-Three (63) personnel are with permanent positions. At present, there are 7 Permanent Physicians and 1 Contractual Physician, 6 Private Doctors and 9 Doctors from CVMC with different specialties serving the hospital under Memorandum of Agreement with the Provincial Government of Isabela. In the Nursing Service, there are 19 permanent Nurses, 10 contractual Nurses, 9 permanent Nursing Attendants, and 6 contractual Nursing Attendants. In the Ancillary Services, 3 permanent Med. Tech., 2 contractual Med. Tech., 1 Permanent Lab. Aide., 1 Permanent Rad. Tech, 1 Permanent MET, 5 Contractual Rad. Tech., 2 Permanent Pharmacists, 3 Contractual Pharmacists and 1 Contractual Pharmacy Aide. In Administrative Services, 22 permanent employees and 27 contractual employees.


