The Department of Budget and Management (DBM) informed this Office of the failure of Barangay/City/Municipal local government units to comply with the provision of RA 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act (GPRA) and Administrative Order No. 17 issued by the Office of the President, on the registration of LGUs, national government agencies, Government-Owned and Controlled Corporations (GOCCs), and State Universities (SUCs) to the **Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System or PhilGEPS**, and the use of the PhilGEPS in *Procurement Activities*.

The PhilGEPS promotes a more open, transparent, and competitive environment for government procurement. The very low compliance by barangay/city/municipal LGUs to register in and use the PhilGEPS can be perceived as defiance and a deliberate attempt to sabotage the national government's anti-corruption program.

You are hereby directed to ensure that your LGUs are registered with the PhilGEPS and your procurement personnel, BAC Secretariat, technical working group members, and Barangay Officials are using the system. No Isabela town, city, or barangay is to be included in the list of non-compliant LGUs henceforth.

Should your LGU personnel require training on PhilGEPS, attached is a copy of the DBM letter for your consideration.
