This is relative to Administrative Order No. 22 by the President of the Philippines Re: **Directing All Government Agencies and Local Government Units to Strictly Implement and Comply with the "National Zoning and Movement Plan for African Swine Fever" under Department of Agriculture Administrative Circular No. 12 S. 2019** (Copies hereto attached). Together with Executive Order (EO) No. 07 -2020 dated 6 February 2020 issued by the undersigned Re: *"Directing All Local Government Units to Intensify the Monitoring and Regulating the Movement, Distribution and Sale of Swine, Pork and Processed Meat Products Within the Province Through Mandatory Establishment of Anti-ASF Checkpoint Between Municipal and City Boundaries and Known Ingresses and Egresses in the Province"* there is a need to localized and unify these strategies to fit our local ASF disease status.

This memorandum intends to further strengthen the said directives and all guidelines provided herein are based from these orders as defined in the Framework for Ground Actions in Defined Zones. The zones are defined and classified based on geographical limits established by the veterinary authorities upon identification of the Infected Zone and Quarantine zone.

Attached herewith as "Annex A" is the Recommended Provincial Zoning Movement Plan in compliance with the National Zoning Movement Plan for African Swine Fever under DA AO No. 12 s. 2019 for your reference and implementation in your checkpoints and area of responsibility, viz;

- Based from the Zoning provided, it can be held as a rule that there will be no moving out of pigs and pork inventories coming from the RED ZONE, everything that is ASF FREE that are produced in the RED zone must be consumed within the RED zone, unless such inventory had undergone thermal processing until totally cooked and/or canned. RED ZONE can accept pork and pork inventories from all zones.
- All of our gateway municipalities and those located on our western corridor had been declared under the RED Zone, passing through this points possesses risks, therefore, a decontamination and disinfection points along the routes must be established.

- Until the area is declared to be highly contagious that's the only time we take abortive measures and a lockdown be implemented. Just make sure that transit of ASF Free pork products will not be hampered, it is imperative that we provide alternate routes or enforce a detour so as not to impede continuity.
- In delivering pork inventories, make it a priority that the final off load of all products ends in the RED Zone meaning there will be no deliveries on other zones after you have unloaded products in areas under the RED Zone.
- Remember that the best way to fight ASF is through proper regulation and handling. Imposing total ban will only complicate matters as meat sellers will always try to find alternative ways to sneak in their products, hence, detection will be hard as this will only encourage many businessmen to resort to smuggling.
- Remember also that Red Zones are categorized into 3 areas and Infected Barangays are remote and distant from major thoroughfares, or is outside the quarantine zones, meaning that transit and transport of pigs and pork inventories are still allowed in our national highways provided they possess necessary documents and papers mentioned. If they have incomplete or no documents, apprehend them at once and effect the necessary protocols regarding the disposal of confiscated inventories.

The implementation of a provincewide zoning and movement plan is seen by the provincial government as a way to not to disrupt trade among cities and municipalities, particularly among ASF-free areas. This is to address the series of bans being imposed by local governments on the trade and entry of hogs, and pork-related products within their jurisdictions. Under the zoning plan, local areas would be classified based on their ASF status, which entail corresponding guidelines on the extent that they can transport and sale hogs, pork and pork products. Zone classification status will be reviewed regularly depending on the epidemiological changes of the disease. We need to follow this guidelines to maintain the normal flow of hog industry in our province.

Please be reminded that any violations of provisions relative to animal quarantine shall suffer the penalties provided in Republic Act No. 3639. Adulteration of carcass as product of a diseased animal which has died through ways other than slaughter is a violation and violators shall suffer penalties in Republic Act No. 10611 as stated on the Sanctions and Penalties clause under DA Administrative Circular No.12 S. 2019.

Please be guided accordingly.

"ANNEX A"

**RECOMMENDED MOVEMENT AND ZONING PLAN AGAINST AFRICAN SWINE
FEVER IN THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA**

1. **CONTAINMENT ZONE** will be the Luzon Island where initial cases of ASF were detected. Province of Isabela is marked as PROTECTED AREA where respective protocol movement affecting the defined zones are to be observed. As a rule, provinces affected by the disease for the first time must observe the 1-7-10 protocol, this is a set of actions to do in areas that have infected farm premises (ASF Contingency Plan, AHWD, BAI, 2019), Infected premises and 1 km Infected Zone.
2. To provide a Zonal Status for ASF in the province, the following are the areas identified with each Zone;

RED ZONE (INFECTED ZONE)

Will include municipalities/ cities in the province with confirmed cases of ASF.

This is categorized into 3, namely;

- a. Infected Premises (IP) - specific locations with live pigs which tested positive for ASF virus using Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) Test.
- b. Quarantine Area (QA) - areas up to the 1 kilometer radius from the infected premises.
- c. Outside Quarantine Area (OQA) - the areas outside the 1 kilometer radius from the infected premises.

RECOMMENDED MOVEMENT PROTOCOL IN THE INFECTED PREMISES.

- As a general rule, there will be no movement- in and movement- out of live pigs, genetic material, feeds, pork meat, pork products, persons (except those who are involved in the stamping out process), vehicles, wastes, supplies and veterinary medicines from commercial farms, backyard farms, slaughterhouse, stockyard, meat cutting plant, meat depot, cold storage warehouse, retail markets, meat shops and meat processing plants within the Infected Premises.
- NO PASS THROUGH IS ALLOWED ESPECIALLY DURING STAMPING OUT, CULLING AND DESTRUCTION of all live pigs, genetic material, feeds, pork products, supplies and veterinary medicines in the IP.
- For uninfected farms with high bio security protocols within the IP, extreme preventive measures against contamination must be strictly implemented. Movement- in and out is discouraged until premises is reclassified.

- All vehicles even with permits and certification issued by the Bureau of Animal Industry must not be allowed passage in this area until reclassified into less vulnerable zone by authorities.
- Cleaning and disinfection of facilities, vehicles and persons shall be observed within this area.

RECOMMENDED MOVEMENT PROTOCOL IN THE QUARANTINE AREA

- For Commercial Farms in the area

Movement-in

ALLOWED

1. Piglets for grow out coming from other zones with Veterinary Health Certificate (VHC), Certificate of Farm Disease Free Status-ASF(CFDFS-AFS) and Shipping Permit(SP) issued by BAI;
2. Genetic materials with requirements stated in DA AO no. 13 s. 2012;
3. Feeds with approval from competent authority;
4. Pork Products defined as any product made wholly or in part from any pork meat cut or other portion of pig carcass accompanied with requirements stated in DA AO no. 8 s. 2019

NOT ALLOWED

1. Persons, vehicles, wastes, vet medicines- Limit entry. Only person and vehicles involved in stamping out process shall be allowed. All will be subjected to necessary biosecurity protocols. Government employees who validate the health status of the farm are allowed entry provided they have complied with quarantine protocols. External vehicles shall be cleaned and disinfected upon in and out of the farm.

Movement-out

ALLOWED (RED ZONE ONLY)

1. Pigs for slaughter with VHC, BAI Certificate of Farm Disease Free Status- ASF (7 days validity), BAI Shipping Permit (7 days validity); BAI Livestock Handler's License; BAI Livestock Transport Carrier License; BAI Certificate of Fully Integrated/ Closed Herd Management.
2. Breeder pigs with VHC, BAI Certificate of Farm Disease Free Status-ASF (7 days validity), BAI Shipping Permit (7 days validity); BAI Livestock Handler's License; BAI Livestock Transport Carrier License; BAI Certificate of Fully Integrated/ Closed Herd Management. BAI Certificate of Laboratory Compliance, Negative Lab Test Result of different swine disease; and Certificate of Swine Breeder Farms Accreditation Program.
3. Delivery of genetic material to the commercial farm with requirements stated in DA AO No. 13 Series of 2012 to commercial farms on the RED Zone only.

NOT ALLOWED

1. Movement- out of feeds are prohibited.

2. No movement- out of pork products. Any inventory of pork within the commercial farm shall be cooked inside and any leftover and scraps shall be disposed in the farm mortality pit.
3. Limit entry. Only person and vehicles involved in stamping out process shall be allowed. All will be subjected to necessary biosecurity protocols. Govt. employees who validate the health status of the farm are allowed entry provided they have complied with quarantine protocols. External vehicles shall be cleaned and disinfected upon in and out of the farm.

- Backyard farms in the area

Movement-in and out

NOT ALLOWED

1. All pigs with no biosecurity measures are to be culled and destroyed as pre-emptive measures. On site burial is preferred. If no available space, closed van must be used as transport to the available burial site. No live pig is to enter backyard farms in the quarantine zone. Farms with minimum biosecurity measures in place can be subject for testing.
2. Barako or any semen inventory are to be destroyed on site including equipment and supplies associated with the pig. Discontinue any planned service of a boar. Discontinue delivery to other farms or internal use of semen.
3. Dispose any remaining feeds/ swill at the burial pit. No feeds for backyard farm is to be brought inside the quarantine area.
4. No pork product shall be brought out of the premises. Any inventory must be cooked and disposed inside the farm (food scraps and leftovers with pork).
5. Limit entry. Only person and vehicles involved in stamping out process shall be allowed. All will be subjected to necessary biosecurity protocols. Residents of the farm are prohibited from entering any live pigs population during stamping out process. Manure, supplies and vet meds stamp out in the same pit.

- Slaughterhouse in the area

Movement in and out

ALLOWED

1. All pigs from other zones even those coming from outside 1 km. radius provided all products/by products coming out are consumed within the red zone area only. Permits such as VHC issued or concurred by the government veterinarian, SP with 7 days validity after issuance date and BAI CFDFS- AFS with 7 days validity from date of release within 1 km. radius and 21 days validity outside 1 km. radius must be secured.
2. Pork meat coming in the abattoir must be ASF Free and all inventory of pork products inside the premises with a production date prior to the declaration of quarantine area can be moved out and marketed only to RED ZONE areas.

3. All other products can be sold to the same locality provided source processor is certified as ASF free.
 4. People who comes in and out of the facility must strictly follow biosecurity protocols. Facility must be disinfected and cleaned in days without operation. Any manures should be disposed of in the burial or waste treatment facility.
 5. Vehicles must thoroughly cleaned and disinfected regularly and should strictly follow biosecurity protocols
- Stockyards in the area

NO MOVEMENT IN AND OUT

1. Stockyard within the 1 km. must discontinue operations. No In and Out during the pre-emptive culling and destruction of pigs inside the radius. Any pig arriving during the period will be destroyed.
 2. Restrictions on used of vehicles, disinfect and clean accordingly and personnel involved in stamping out activity will be allowed and shall fully observe biosecurity protocols. Manure and vet meds disposed in the burial pit.
 3. Any stockyard related equipment and supplies must not be moved out of the premises.
- Meat cutting plant, meat depot, cold storage warehouse, retail markets, meat shops and meat processing plants
 1. Movement –In and out is allowed if meat are from other zones specifically for consumption within the area. Accompanied by Meat Inspection Certificate (MIC) and Shipping Permit.
 2. Movement –Out is allowed if production date is prior to the date of positive detection and for consumption within the red zone only.
 3. Selling of pork and pork products within the Quarantine Zone will be allowed
 4. Facilities and vehicles must undergo regular cleaning and disinfection. If from cold storage warehouses, meat cutting plants and meat depots this should be accompanied by a Meat Inspection Certificate (MIC) or Certificate of Meat Inspection (COMI) to validate production date.
 - Pork based manufacturing plant/ Meat processing plants
 1. All pork inventories coming from other zones are allowed with issuances like- Veterinary Quarantine and Meat Inspection and Laboratory Certificate (VQMILC), SP, MIC and COMI;
 2. Movement Out- Semi processed is allowed within the RED ZONE only with issuances like SP, Food and Drug Administration License To Operate(FDA LTO) and Certified Product Registration (CPR).
 3. Movement out Fully Cooked/ Thermally processed allowed to all Zones with issuances like SP, FDA LTO and CPR.

- Cold Storage Warehouse (CSW) in the area.
 1. CSW in the quarantine area can be used for storage of pork products from all zones and ASF Free countries with necessary permits such as VQMILC, SP MIC and COMI.
 2. Move out of the warehouse will be limited to RED and PINK ZONE (Buffer Zone) only.
- Agri- Vet Outlet Store
 1. Allowed to sell feed, supplies and veterinary products for swine preferably to commercial farms within 1 km. zone only.
 2. All vehicles subject to a thorough cleaning and disinfection.
- Establishment of Cleaning and Disinfection Areas is recommended to be in place in the routes going in and out of the Quarantine Zone.
- All *commercial farms* must undergo regular testing for ASF -15 adult and 15 young (3-6 mo. old) pigs using RT- PCR. If negative, the BAI shall issue Certificate of Farm Disease Free Status- ASF with 7 days validity from date of release and shipping permit. Testing after 7 days shall continue until classification of the zone is changed.
- Generally, passing through this area is ALLOWED provided that necessary permits are on hand except for areas that are NOT ALLOWED and RESTRICTED which is limited or no pass through shall be enforced. Barangay Enforcers/Tanod of barangays that are in the Quarantine Area in the RED ZONE Municipalities are enjoined to establish their check points for this purpose or to effect DETOURS if needed.

RECOMMENDED MOVEMENT PROTOCOL OUTSIDE THE QUARANTINE AREA

- Commercial Farms in the area

Movement-in

ALLOWED

1. Live Pigs (Piglets, Fatteners, and or Breeders), genetic materials, feeds from other zones are allowed to be brought in the commercial farms in this area.
2. Lab testing is still required. Documents written in DA AO no. 8 shall apply. For animals going out for slaughter, growout and breeder- VHC, SP and Certificate of Farm Disease Free Status- ASF with 21 days validity (except for growout and breeder which is 7 days validity).
3. In case of a "fully integrated closed- system" where special safety audit can be implemented; pigs from the red zone can already be slaughtered in the nearby exposed areas with AA or AAA slaughterhouses. Pig Delivery trucks should have Accreditation/ Handler's License.
4. Vehicles involved in delivery should have the necessary permits required by regulation and should be subjected to thorough cleaning and disinfection procedures onsite or in points along routes.

NOT ALLOWED

1. Pork Products are prohibited.

Movement-out

ALLOWED

1. Live pigs for slaughter, for growout and Breeders are allowed within RED and PINK Zones only.
2. Delivery of genetic material to the commercial farm with requirements stated in DA AO No. 13 Series of 2012 to commercial farms on the RED Zone only.

NOT ALLOWED

1. Movement- out of feeds are prohibited.
2. No movement- out of pork products. Any inventory of pork within the commercial farm shall be cooked inside and any leftover and scraps shall be disposed in the farm mortality pit.
3. Limit entry. Only person and vehicles involved in pig farming shall be allowed. Farm workers are not involved in any hog raising outside the premises. All will be subjected to necessary biosecurity protocols such as showering and changing of clothes. No visiting of other premises with live pig population. Govt. employees who validate the health status of the farm are allowed entry provided they have complied with quarantine protocols. External and internal vehicles and delivery personnel shall be cleaned and disinfected upon in and out of the farm.

- Backyard farms in the area

Movement-in

ALLOWED

1. All pigs, genetic materials and feeds will be allowed in only after the stamping- out activities on the ground zero and after checking for compliance of backyard farms to the minimum requirements of good animal husbandry practices (GAHP) for backyard farms.
2. Vehicles involved in delivery should have the necessary permits required by regulation and should be subjected to thorough cleaning and disinfection procedures onsite or in points along routes.

NOT ALLOWED

1. Pork products are prohibited

Movement-out

ALLOWED

1. Backyard pigs intended for slaughter should be sent to LGU accredited slaughterhouse (Locally Registered Meat Establishments) outside the 1 km radius and within the Red Zone. Accompanied with necessary permits VHC, SP and should be marketed within the red zone only.
2. Genetic Materials allowed within the same municipality/city where there is a reported case only but outside the 1 km quarantine area.

NOT ALLOWED

1. No pork product shall be brought out of the premises. Any inventory must be cooked and disposed inside the farm (food scraps and leftovers with pork).

- Slaughterhouse in the area

Movement in and out

ALLOWED

1. All pigs from RED ZONES SHALL BE SLAUGHTERED WITHIN THE RED ZONE ONLY.
2. Pork meat coming from the abattoir can be moved out and marketed only to RED ZONE areas.
3. Eventual Meat from the Slaughterhouse in the RED Zone from sources with CFDFS-ASF can be sent to markets within the RED and PINK Zones only
4. Vehicles moving in and out must thoroughly cleaned and disinfected regularly and only personnel doing abattoir works are allowed in the facility and should strictly follow biosecurity protocols. Facility must be disinfected and cleaned outside operation hours.

- Stockyards in the area

All stockyard operations in this area shall be suspended until further notice from government authorities concerned.

- Wet Market/ Meat shops

1. Selling of pork meat and products will be allowed.
2. Movement into the wet market is allowed from ALL sources specifically for consumption within the area.
3. The pork brought into the RED Zone should be accompanied by necessary government permits.

- Pork based manufacturing plant/ Meat processing plants

1. All product movements should be accompanied by necessary permits like- FDA LTO, CPR and BAI SP in case of semi- processed products.
2. Pork material that can be used for production must be sourced from all zones except from red and pink zones.
3. Inventory or raw materials and finished products PRIOR to declaration of Infected Premises can be moved out to RED and PINK Zones only.
4. Movement out of semi- processed products are allowed to be distributed to RED and PINK Zones only.
5. Movement out of Fully Cooked/ Thermally processed are allowed to all Zones.
6. Delivery vehicles in and out of the plant must be cleaned and disinfected at points along the route.

- Cold Storage Warehouse (CSW) in the area.
 1. Pork products from all zones except red and pink zones can be brought in CSW in this area with necessary permits.
 2. Fully cooked pork products can be distributed to all zones except the RED zone.
 3. Semi processed pork products can be distributed to red and pink zones only.
 4. Other Inventory of finished products, excluding the fully cooked pork products (if any) PRIOR to declaration of Infected Premises can be moved out to PINK Zone only with accompanying MIC and SP.
 5. All vehicles going in and out of the CSW should be subjected to thorough cleaning and inspection.
- Establishment of Cleaning and Disinfection Areas is recommended to be in placed in the routes going in and outside the Quarantine Zone going to the Buffer Zone/Surveillance Zone.
- Generally, passing through this area is ALLOWED. It is recommended that disinfecting stations must be established on all ingresses and egresses of the province as areas in all entry points are now under RED Zones.
- As a Rule of Thumb, all pigs and pork (products, by- products, semi-processed) from RED ZONES must ne contained on RED ZONES except on Infected Premises where culling and immediate destruction is required. All pigs and pork coming in from other zones are mostly allowed including those that are in- transit provided they have complete certifications and documents.
- Only INFECTED PREMISES are subject to no pass through. Detouring or alternate roads must be established to ensure continuity.

PINK ZONE (BUFFER ZONE) and **YELLOW ZONE** (SURVEILLANCE ZONE)

Municipalities and Cities adjacent to RED Zone (Infected Zone). This will include ASF Free localities in the province. For the purpose of this zoning, this will include cities or municipalities neighboring the red zones which are considered “High Risk Areas”. Combining this two zones is necessary due to proximity of one town to the other.

Municipalities and Cities under the PINK AND YELLOW ZONE:

- Commercial Farms in this Area

Movement In and Out- ALLOWED

1. Live Pigs (Piglets, Fatteners, and or Breeders) are allowed except from the red zone.

2. Genetic Material (Breeder boar semen from pigs) must only come from zones other than the RED Zone. Movement out from this zone is allowed on destinations to Red and Yellow Zones only.
 3. Movement -in and out for growout piglets will require VHC, SP and Certificate of Farm Disease- Free Status valid for 30 days all issued by BAI.
 4. Movement-In- of genetic materials requires VHC, SP, CFDFS-ASF 30 days validity, Company Certification if Closed Herd Management/Swine Breeder Farms Accreditation Program for movement everywhere except from the RED ZONE. Receiving of Genetic materials from the RED ZONE is not allowed. Genetic materials from ASF Free areas shall be allowed transit provided that these are to be delivered directly to destination.
 5. Limit entry. Only person and vehicles involved in pig farming shall be allowed. Farm workers are not involved in any hog raising outside the premises. All will be subjected to necessary biosecurity protocols such as showering and changing of clothes. Government employees who validate the health status of the farm are allowed entry provided they have complied with quarantine protocols. Internal and delivery vehicles shall be cleaned and disinfected upon in and out of the farm. With Accreditation/Handlers license,
- Backyard Farms in this area

Movement In and Out- ALLOWED

1. Live Pigs (Piglets, Fatteners, and or Breeders) are allowed entry except from the RED Zone. Accompanied by VHC, SP and CFDFS-ASF.
 2. Piglets coming from backyard farms in this area are allowed on YELLOW ZONE only. Pigs for slaughter allowed on RED AND YELLOW ZONE. Accompanied with VHC and SP.
 3. Genetic Materials from YELLOW Zone can be brought to areas within the YELLOW Zone and RED Zone. Accompanied by VHC, SP and CFDFS-AS.
 4. Feed deliveries for Backyard farms shall only come from Yellow, Light Green and Dark Green Zones. Feeds from this backyard farms are allowed to enter the RED Zone.
- Slaughterhouse
 1. Abattoirs from this area can accept pigs from within the Yellow Zone, Light Green and Dark Green Zone Only.
 2. Pork products coming out from slaughterhouses within the Yellow Zone can be brought to Yellow, Red and Light Green Zones only.
 - Stockyard
 1. Operation within this area is allowed provided that stocks must be sourced from Yellow, Light Green and Dark Green Zone only.
 2. Vehicles moving in and out should be subjected to thorough cleaning and disinfection. Vehicles should have necessary documents- Accreditation/ Handler's License.
 - Wet Market/ Meatshop
 1. Selling of pork meat and products are allowed in this zone provided that this are sourced from Yellow, Light Green and Dark Green Zones Only.

Accompanied with necessary government permits such as MIC (NMIC/Local) and/or SP.

- Pork- based producing plant
 1. All product movements must be accompanied with necessary permits such as LTO and CPR issued by FDA and Shipping Permit.
 2. Yellow zone can receive Fresh, Frozen and Semi processed pork inventories from Yellow, Light Green, Dark Green and ASF Free Countries.
 3. Yellow zone can receive fully cooked inventories from all zones.
 4. Fresh, Frozen and Semi processed pork inventories from plants located in this zone can bring out their products to YELLOW and RED zones only;
 5. Fully cooked, canned products can be brought to all zones.
- Cold Storage
 1. Cold storage from this zone can only accept and store pork from Yellow, Light Green, Dark Green Zones.
 2. They can only deliver to Yellow and Red Zones.
 3. These should be accompanied by a CMI and a SP.

LIGHT GREEN ZONE (PROTECTED ZONE)

Municipalities under the LIGHT GREEN ZONE

BENITO SOLIVEN SAN MARIANO TUMAUNI

- Commercial Farms in the area

Movement In and Out- ALLOWED

1. Movement of pigs are allowed within the Light Green Zone and allowed to be brought to the Yellow and Red Zones. Accompanied with VHC and SP.
2. Pig can be brought to commercial farms in this area sourced from Dark Green, Light Green and Yellow Zones only.

From Free and Protected Zones: CFDS-AFS issued by BAI, VHC and BAI issued SP or its deputized quarantine officers.

From Surveillance Zone: BAI Certificate of Laboratory Compliance as Breeder Farm, BAI CFDFS-ASF, VHC, SP issued by BAI or its deputized quarantine officers, Authority to ship issued by BAI Director

3. Only breeder pigs and genetic materials from Yellow, Light Green and Dark Green Zones will be allowed to be brought to commercial farms from this zone. Accompanied with HVC, SP, CFDFS-ASF, BAI Certificate of Laboratory Compliance. Genetic materials from ASF Free areas shall be allowed provided that these are to be delivered directly to destination.
4. Feeds that can be delivered out from this farms should only reach zones other than those that are in Dark Green Zone. Feeds coming in can be brought inside this farms from all zones except Red Zones.

- **Wet Market/ Pork Based Manufacturing Plant /Cold Storage Warehouse**
 1. All movement of pork, pork products and Pork by-products shall be accompanied with necessary permits such as LTO and CDA issued by FDA and SP.
 2. The Light Green Zone can received fresh, chilled, frozen and semi processed from within the Light Green Zone, Dark Green Zone and ASF Free Countries. Can also receive fully cooked inventories from all zones.
 5. The Light Green Zone can moved out and sell fresh, chilled, frozen and semi processed inventories to all zones except Dark Green Zone. Can also deliver and sell fully cooked inventories to all zones.

- Live Pigs (Piglets, Fatteners, and or Breeders, Genetic Material (Breeder pig, boar and semen from pigs), Agri-supplies, Vet. Medicines, Feeds, chilled, frozen and semi processed inventories, fully cooked, thermally processed inventories coming from this Zone can be delivered to all Zones.
- Only breeder pigs, genetic materials, chilled, frozen and semi processed inventories from Dark Green Zone are to be received in this area.
- Feeds sourced from Light and Dark Green Zones are allowed.
- Fully cooked, thermally processed inventories from all zones are allowed.
- No pork from other zones is allowed.
- All movements shall be accompanied with VHC, SP, CFDFS-ASF, BAI Certificate of Laboratory Compliance as Breeder. Genetic materials from ASF Free areas shall be allowed transit provided that these are to be delivered directly to destination.
