Supplemental Budget No. 5, S. of 2019, appropriating the amount of FORTY MILLION NINE HUNDRED SIXTY NINE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY PESOS (P40,969,790.00) from the share of the Municipality of Cabatuan, Isabela on the collection of Excise Taxes for CY 2016, pursuant to the provisions of Section 327 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

A RESOLUTION DECLARING APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2019-18 (SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 05, S. 2019) IN THE AMOUNT OF FORTY MILLION NINE HUNDRED SIXTY NINE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY PESOS (P40,969,790.00) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CABATUAN, ISABELA OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY SUBJECT TO SOME CONDITIONS

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **SP Member DELFINITO EMMANUEL L. ALBANO** duly seconded:

THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED:

RESOLVED, to declare Appropriation Ordinance No. 2019-18 of the Municipality of Cabatuan, Isabela **OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY** subject to the posting requirements under Section 59 of R.A No. 7160, and subject further to the following conditions:

1. The utilization of the projects to be funded from the Local Government share in the Burley and Native Tobacco Excise Tax for the Fiscal Years 2016 amounting to Forty Million Nine Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Pesos (P40,969,790.00) shall adhere with the provisions of LBM No. 79, dated June 14, 2019, on the Guidelines on the release and utilization of the shares of LGUs from the FY 2016 collections of Excise Tax on locally manufactured Virginia-type cigarettes under Republic Act No. 7171, and Burley and Native Tobacco Excise Tax pursuant to RA No. 8240, as amended by RA No. 10351, chargeable against the allocations to LGUs under the FY 2018 General Appropriations Act, Republic Act No. 10964, Continuing Appropriations.

However, the following projects are not in accordance with item 3.2 of LBM No. 79, on the Guidelines on the release and utilization of the shares of LGUs from the FY 2016 collections of Excise Tax, to wit:

- Expansion/Rehabilitation of Farmers Training Center for P230,000.00
- b. Provision of Generator to 128 Tobacco Farmers for P1,216,000.00
- The proposed projects must be governed by the provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, the Government Procurement Reform Act (GPRA) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;
- The appropriation for the following account should be properly classified to specific Account Code in accordance with COA Circular No. 2015-009 dated December 1, 2015, on Prescribing the Revised Chart of Accounts for LGUs:

RESOLVED FURTHER, to require the Municipality of Cabatuan, Isabela to comply with the herein conditions.
