A RESOLUTION REMINDING ISABELEÑOS SHELTERED IN EVACUATION CENTERS TO CONTINUALLY OBSERVE ANTI-COVID-19 PROTOCOLS, SUCH AS, AMONG OTHERS, PHYSICAL DISTANCING AND THE WEARING OF FACE MASK AND FACE SHIELD TO PREVENT COVID-19 TRANSMISSIONS

WHEREAS, the Province of Isabela experienced widespread devastation due to the occurrence of torrential rains and the successive entry of typhoons Rolly, Siony, and Ulysses within a 12-day period, particularly: Typhoon Rolly on November 01, 2020; Typhoon Siony on November 06, 2020; and Typhoon Ulysses on November 12, 2020;

WHEREAS, such events caused water levels in the Province to rapidly rise which eventually resulted to massive flooding across Isabela. Consequently, countless Isabeleños were moved to evacuation centers to ensure their safety and to provide them with temporary shelter until water levels subside to manageable levels;

WHEREAS, the Province of Isabela is experiencing a public health crisis due to the spread and persistence of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, considering the highly-infectious nature of COVID-19, evacuation centers have the potential to turn into COVID-19 hotspots if evacuees will fail to observe anti-COVID-19 protocols;

WHEREAS, this Honorable Body recognizes the severity of the hardships currently being experienced by our people. However, anti-COVID-19 protocols must still be observed to prevent further aggravation of the current COVID-19 crisis;

WHEREAS, this Honorable Body urges all government personnel deployed in evacuation centers to remind evacuees to observe anti-COVID-19 protocols such as, but not limited to, physical distancing, and the wearing of face mask and face shields, and emphasizes its call to exhibit compassion in the enforcement of anti-COVID-19 laws, ordinances, and other related issuances in such areas;

**WHEREFORE**, premises considered, upon motion of Hon. Emmanuel Joselito B. Añes, duly approved and seconded in a session duly assembled it was –

RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVES, TO PASS A RESOLUTION REMINDING ISABELEÑOS SHELTERED IN EVACUATION CENTERS TO CONTINUALLY OBSERVE ANTI-COVID-19 PROTOCOLS, SUCH AS, AMONG OTHERS, PHYSICAL DISTANCING AND THE WEARING OF FACE MASK AND FACE SHIELD TO PREVENT COVID-19 TRANSMISSIONS
