




Team responded to a *Medical Incident* at District 1, Gamu, Isabela last *November 21, 2021*. The patient lose of consciousness and said to be with history of diabetes mellitus and hypertension on medication. After immediate intervention by Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) the patient was brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.







Team responded to a *Medical Incident* at P4 District 1, Gamu, Isabela last *November 29, 2021*. The patient was conscious and coherent, suffered headache, dizziness, body weakness, on and off fever since November 26, 2021. After immediate intervention the patient was brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.


