

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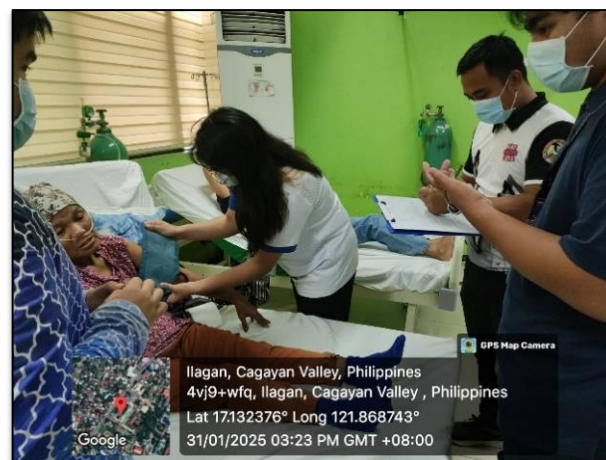

After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to Isabela Doctor's General Hospital City of Ilagan, Isabela for proper disposition.



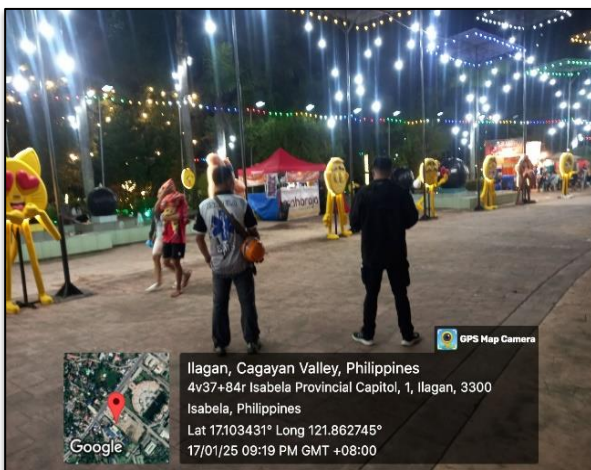
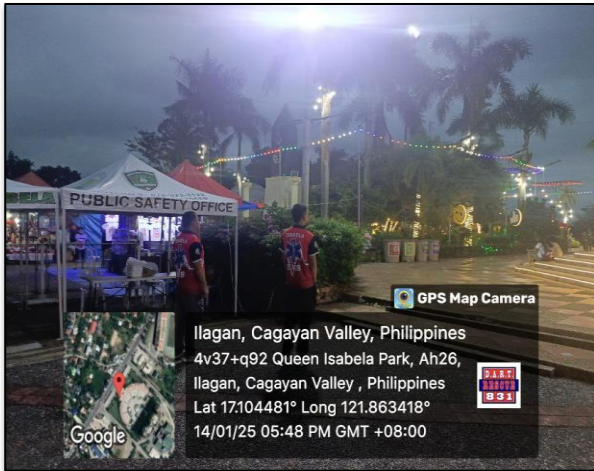
Team responded a **Trauma Incident** at Junction, Brgy. Upi, Gamu, Isabela last **January 27, 2025**. The patient was combative stage, left eye knockout with avulsion, avulsion on occipital area of the head and nose bridge, laceration at right index, and possible clavicular fractured (closed). After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to Isabela Doctor's General Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Medical Incident** at Purok 1, Brgy. Song-song, Gamu, Isabela last **January 31, 2025**. The patient was conscious, weak looking, difficulty in breathing, easy fatiguability, and past Medical of asthma. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDY Sr. Memorial Hospital City of Ilagan, Isabela for proper disposition.



PDRRMO/DART 831 provided transport of patient to the patient UTZ examination reveal: Pseudomyxoma Peritonei – (To consider Cancer). The patient transferred from Brgy. Rizal, Delfin Albano, Isabela to Philippine General Hospital, Taft Avenue, Metro, Manila last **January 16-17, 2025**.

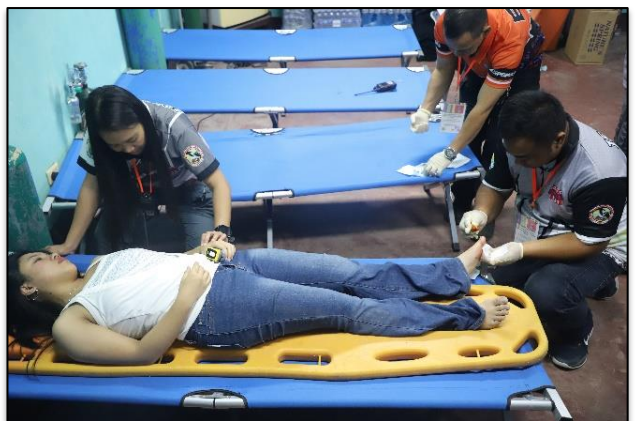
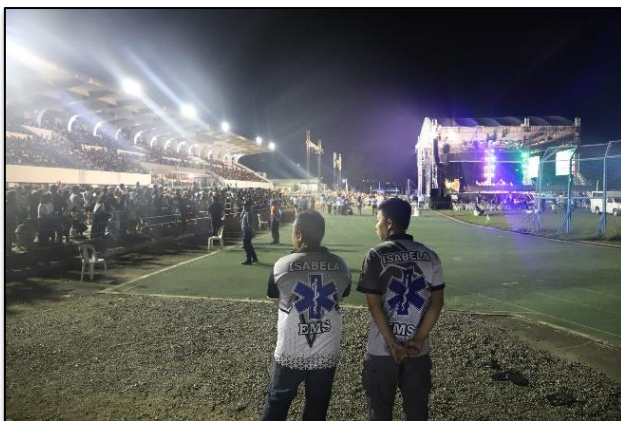
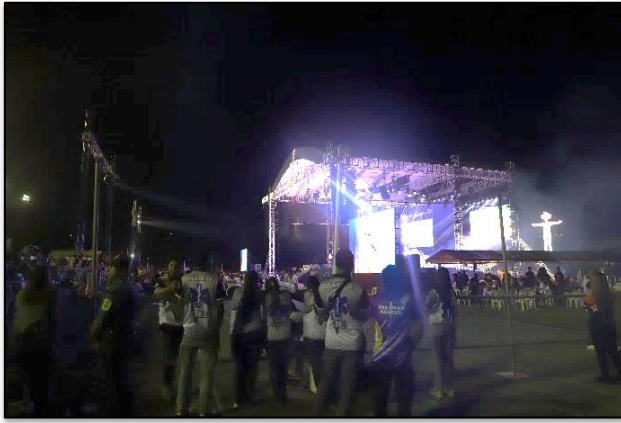
