

The patient conscious, sitting on scene, pale looking, cold clammy skin, experiencing blurry vision and abrasion on left knee. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDY Sr. Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Trauma Incident** at Brgy. District 3, Gamu, Isabela last **May 25, 2024**. The patient was suffered open fracture on right leg, abrasion at the back, and back of the head. Driving under influence of liquor as verbalized by the patient. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDY Sr. Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Trauma Incident** at Bypass Road, Tumauni, Isabela last **May 27, 2024**. The patient was conscious and coherent, he suffered abrasion on left hand and left hip with pain scale 8/10. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to St. Mathias Medical, Center, Isabela for proper disposition.



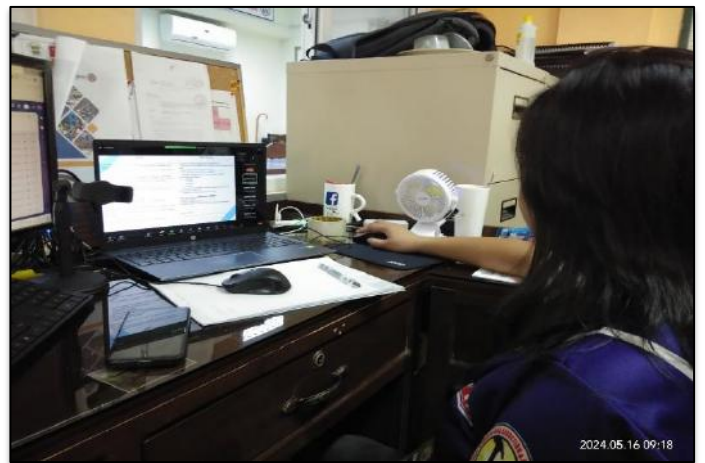
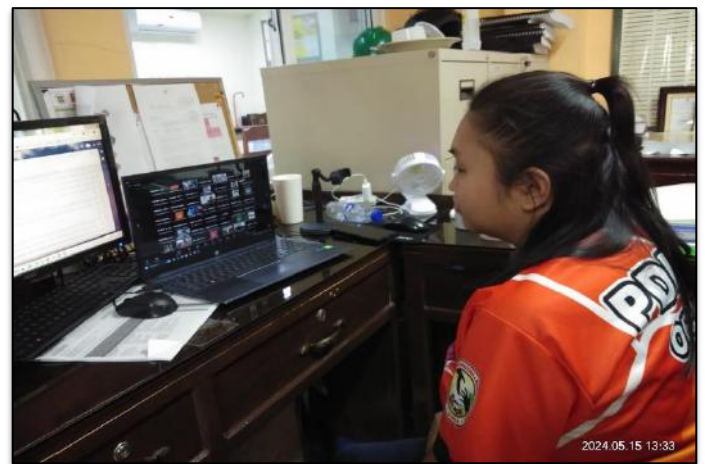
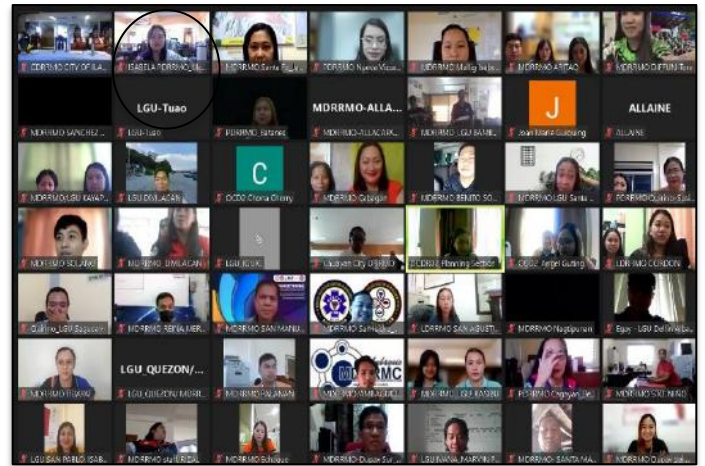
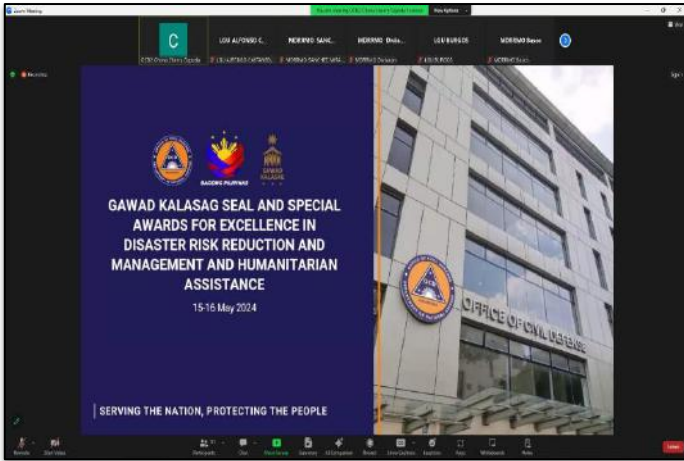

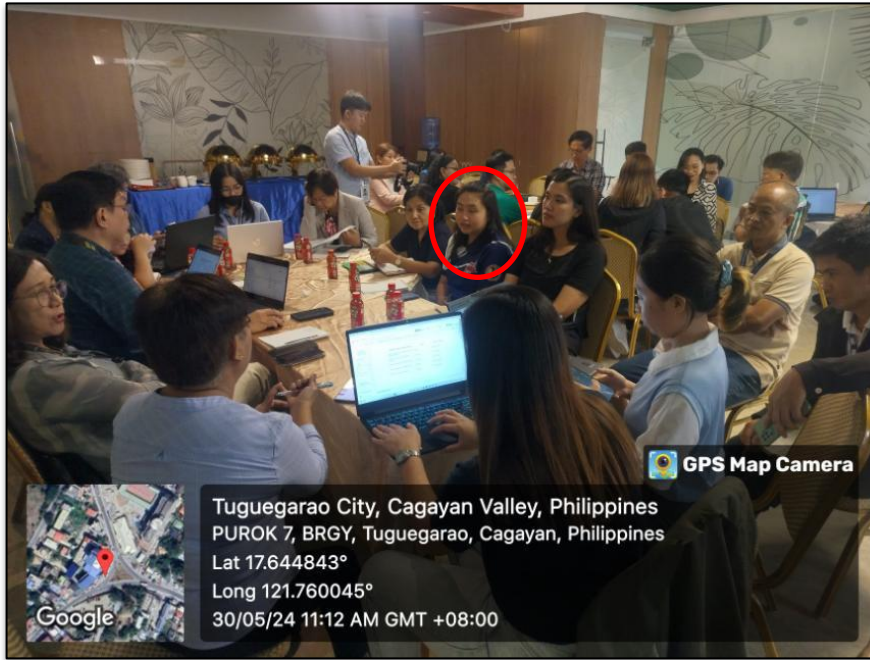
