

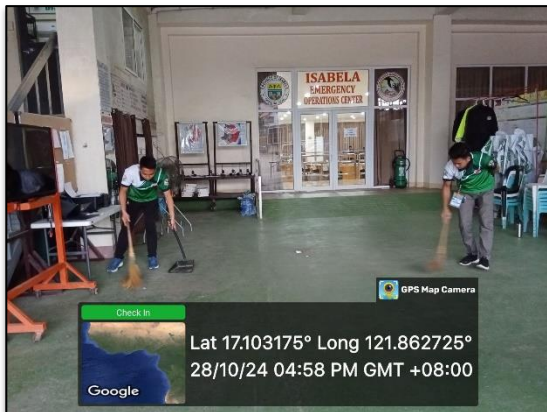

After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was mediatly brought to GFNDy Sr. Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Trauma Incident** at Sitio Landing, Brgy. Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela last **October 27, 2024**. The was conscious. He suffered abrasion on right arm, right knee, and right foot. Driving under influence of liquor as verbalized by patient (DUI). After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was mediatly brought to GFNDy Sr. Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Trauma Incident** at Brgy. Marana 1st, City of Ilagan, Isabela last **October 31, 2024**. The patient was conscious. He suffered contusion on right upper eyebrow, avulsion on upper and lower extremities. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was mediatly brought to City of Ilagan, Medical Center (CIMC) for proper disposition.



PDRRMO/DART 831 provided transport of patient to the patient diagnosed: pulmonary mass with massive pleural effusion S/P limited thoracotomy with pleural biopsy. The patient transferred from Brgy. Aurora, Alicia, Isabela to University of Santo Tomas Hospital, Sampaloc, Manila last **October 29, 2024**.



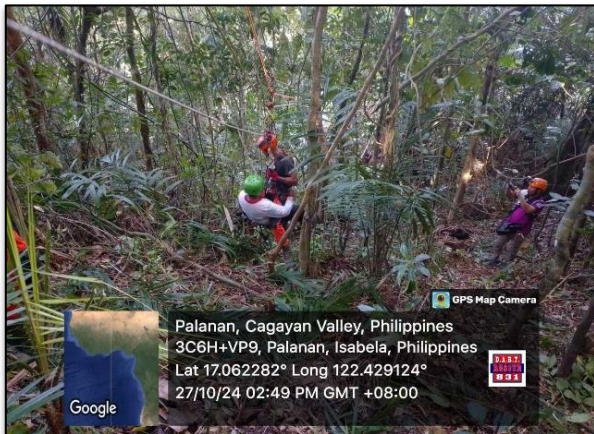
