I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Following years of uncertainty, and a global pandemic that has proven to be one of the most challenging events in history, we soldiered on prepared to tackle what lay ahead. And as we continued to extract the possible from the impossible, this year taught us that, above all, our voices, no matter small, can change the world.

Tropical Cyclones

In 2022, tropical cyclones formed in seven major bodies of water, commonly known as the tropical cyclone basins. Tropical cyclones were given names by the Philippine Atmospheric Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) as soon as they enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility. During the year, 132 systems were formed. Five (5) affected the Province of Isabela namely: “Florita”, “Karding”, “Maymay” “Neneng” and “Paeng”. We may consider ourselves fortunate because we were not hit as hard as those in other provinces, especially in Eastern and Central Visayas, and Northeastern Mindanao who suffered untold misery and destruction.

COVID-19

As the third year of the COVID-19 era ended, the symptoms of the coronavirus mutations were less severe and less deadly compared to those in 2020 and 2021. It is fortunate that no new variant capable of fueling a surge. COVID-19 symptoms looked more like those of influenza. COVID-19 became less of a disruption in our lives making it possible to resume pre-pandemic activities like travel, attending large events, and going to school in person and unmasked. We have built enough immunity to COVID to allow life return to normal in many ways without huge surges and number of deaths.

Climate Change

Albeit a natural phenomenon, climate change is accelerated by human activity. Human behavior dictates the response to climate change: our readiness to accept the reality of climate change, and our willingness to embed climate change risk assessment and management in development strategies. Experts have been advocating for an approach that integrates disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation to build a level of resilience in a sustainable way.

Although disaster risk reduction also covers non-climate-related disasters, climate-related ones comprise the bulk of this Office’s concern. Climate change is predicted to increase the frequency and/or intensity of climate-related hazards. Populations already exposed to those hazards and effects will even be at greater risk.

Disasters and climate change have similar consequences in people’s lives. Populations exposed to hazards may also experience stresses due to long-term changes in climate. Changes in seasonality, unpredictable rainfall, and sea level rise affect livelihoods and health, thus making people more vulnerable to all types of shocks, events, and further change.

DISASTER PREVENTION AND MITIGATION, PREPAREDNESS, RESPONSE, RELIEF, RECOVERY, AND REHABILITATION PROGRAM:

The Provincial Disaster Risk reduction and Management Office (the “Office”, for brevity) continued to be in the forefront of disaster prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response, relief, rehabilitation and recovery programs of the Provincial Government.

As it has always been, the program thrust of the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (the “Council”, for brevity) of the Province of Isabela was geared towards keeping all member-agencies ready in terms of training, equipment, and personnel. The Council’s inherent duty for public safety dictates the provision of area security, search and rescue, recovery, evacuation, relief operations and rehabilitation towards a resilient and sustainable Isabela.

DISASTER PREVENTION AND MITIGATION

The disaster prevention and mitigation program of the Office continued to aim to check hazards and lessen their potential impacts by reducing vulnerability and exposure and enhancing capacities of communities through the following measures:

1. Weather, river water levels, Magat Dam inflow and outflow and the status of all overflow bridges were monitored daily. The coastal towns of Maconacon, Divilacan, Palanan, and Dinapigue were promptly informed of any gale warning. As soon as the monitoring team of the Office learned that a weather disturbance was an imminent threat to any part of the Province, the Office cascaded such information to all local chief executives, all local DRRM offices (“LDRRMOs”, for brevity), all city and municipal social welfare and development offices, the Armed Forces of the Philippines, the Philippine National Police, and the Bureau of Fire Protection. The LDRRMOs of the coastal municipalities were reminded of the implementation of the *“No Sailing, No Fishing, and No Swimming Policy”*. Relief packs were pre-positioned by the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office and its city and municipal counterparts. In addition, the monitoring team posted the information on various social media platforms like Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram. The assistance of radio and cable television stations was also sought. The Office is equipped with Text Messaging Alert System (TMAS) machines, and they were utilized to blast warnings to all cellular phone users within threatened areas.
2. Safety measures were strictly observed in conducting emergency response, inter-facility transfer, and mobility assistance services. Assessing the condition and history of a patient was also emphasized.
3. In compliance with Memorandum No. 77, the Office conducted daily disinfection of all offices within the Capitol compound as preventive measure against COVID-19 and other communicable diseases. The Office continuously conducted daily thorough cleaning of workplaces, ambulances, and other office vehicles. The rescuers themselves underwent disinfection every after any emergency response action to prevent the spread of the virus.

DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

The Office applied its disaster preparedness program that is designed to establish and strengthen the capacities of communities to anticipate, cope and recover from the negative impacts of emergency occurrences and disasters.

1. The Office established an Interim Preparatory Guidelines in the implementation of the National Vaccination Program. It recommended the creation and activation of the Emerging Task Organization of the Emerging Infectious Diseases (EID), Incident Management Teams with its roles, duties and responsibilities and the

creation and activation of the Provincial Crisis Management Committee (PCMC) and the Provincial Emergency Operation Center (PEOC). Likewise, the Office prepared Contingency Plans in preparation to the risks of man-made and natural hazards that may have an effect to the deployment and implementation of the COVID-19 Vaccination.

2. The Office spearheaded all the quarterly conduct of the 2022 Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill. Banners were posted in public areas and safety tips were flashed on the roadside LED wall of the Office as well as on social media platforms. The Office furnished copies of the Memorandum No. 32 series of 2021 to the different offices of the Provincial Government of Isabela in support on the advocacy of the National Government thru the Office of the Civil Defense in promoting earthquake preparedness and disaster resiliency with the integration of COVID-19 minimum public health standards.
3. The Office consistently disseminated and posted daily up-to-date information and advisories pertaining to the weather, Magat Dam updates and advisories, and the status of national and local roads and overflow bridges. Updates on weather and sea conditions of the coastal towns were posted in different social media platforms. Useful information was shown on the Office roadside LED wall for the consumption of the general public.
4. The Office continued to capacitate municipalities, communities, and agencies with the necessary skills, knowledge, and capabilities through the conduct of community-based disaster risk reduction and management trainings and other disaster management programs that will help them cope with the impacts of disasters and recover from them.
5. Provincial Administrator Atty. Noel Manuel R. Lopez, PDRRM Officer Atty. Constante A. Foronda Jr., and Provincial Public Safety Officer Kim Patrick G. Agbayani, led the operational pre-deployment briefing of the personnel of the DART Rescue 831, the Bureau of Fire Protection, and the Isabela Police Provincial Office on the response to be employed during the onslaught of Severe Tropical Storm “Florita” in August 22, 2022, and Super Typhoon “Karding” in September 24, 2022 at the BFP-PDRRMC Headquarters, Capitol Compound, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela.
6. The PDRRMO/DART Rescue 831 pre-positioned Water Search and Rescue assets including boats of various capabilities, rescue vehicles, and ambulances to allow a rapid response to the anticipated effects of Super Typhoon “Karding”, Severe Tropical Storms “Florita” and “Paeng”, and Tropical Depressions “Maymay” and “Neneng”.

DISASTER RESPONSE

Another aim of the Disaster Response program of the Office in 2022 was to provide life preservation systems and to meet the basic subsistence needs of any affected population based on acceptable standards during or immediately after a disaster.

1. The Office catered to a total of 218 medical cases; responded to 361 trauma incidents, majority of which were road crashes; assisted 36 inter-facility transfer of patients; and performed 20 emergency child births. The DART Rescue 831 served a total of 635 individuals in 2022;
2. The Office set up motorist assistance or “Lakbay Alalay” centers during the observance of the Holy Week, All Saints Day and All Souls Day. Stations were situated in front of the PDRRMC-BFP Headquarters. All city and municipal DRRM Offices and all city and municipal police stations were instructed to activate their respective Public Assistance Centers in strategic locations along the highways, rivers and coasts to continuously monitor their areas of responsibility for any untoward incident.
3. The Office led two (2) convoys of response, peacekeeping, and transport vehicles that conducted relief operations for the victims of Typhoon “Odette” in Visayas and Mindanao on January 26, 2022.
4. The Office provided support to the convoy by having, among others, a readily available medical response/emergency assistance. The Office also implemented health safety protocols during the:
 - Turn Over Ceremony for the new Fire Truck of BFP-Isabela on *January 28, 2022* at the Isabela Sports Complex, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela together with the Bureau Fire Protection.
 - Inday Sara Duterte “Caravan” at the Queen Isabela Park, Provincial Capitol Compound, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela on February 15, 2022.
 - DepEd DOS Regional Invitational Sporting Events (RISE) at Benjamin G. Dy Memorial Sports Complex, Cauayan City, Isabela on April 25, 26, and 27, 2022.
 - Philippine Motorcycle Tourism (PMT) Caravan, a Regional Initiated Ride in Your Valley of Fun! on April 25-28, 2022.
 - Fiesta Rally at Isabela Sports Complex, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela on May 1, 2022.
 - 19th Bike Pilgrimage from Guibang to Piat, Cagayan on June 18, 2022.
 - Mass Oath-Taking Ceremony of newly elected officials of the province of Isabela held at Isabela Convention Center, Cauayan City on June 29, 2022.
 - ROTC at the Isabela Sports Complex, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela on August 01 and August 14, 2022.
 - SWAD Isabela Educational Assistance pay out at SWAD Office, Capitol Compound, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela on August 20, 2022.

- Blood-Letting Activity at Isabela Multi-Purpose Evacuation Center, Capitol Compound, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela on August 26 and October 6, 2022.
 - Pasasalamat Concert on August 31, 2022.
 - Bambanti Festival 2023 Production Workshop Series 1 Dancers on September 22-23, 2022.
5. Provided Motorist/Public Assistance during the observance of the Lenten Season and Summer Vacation on April 12-16, 2022 at the roadside in front of the PDRMC-BFP Headquarters, Capitol Compound, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela.
 6. On April 18, 2022, the PDRMO DART 831 Water Search and Rescue (WASAR) Team conducted a retrieval operation at Brgy. Turod Banquero, Reina Mercedes and at the boundary of Alibagu, City of Ilagan and Upi, Gamu, Isabela.
 7. PDRMO/DART 831 provided medical assistance to the employees and clients of the PGI who experienced dizziness and/or nausea after the 7.3 magnitude earthquake that shook Northern Luzon and several parts of the country on July 27, 2022.
 8. Deployment of two (2) rescue teams to Jones and San Agustin, Isabela re: Typhoon “Karding” (NORU) on September 24, 2022.
 9. Conducted a retrieval operation on December 28, 2022 at the Cagayan River at Barangay Calamagui 1st, City of Ilagan, Isabela. The remains of the victim were successfully retrieved just minutes after the start of the operation.

DISASTER REHABILITATION AND RECOVERY

The Rehabilitation and Recovery program of the Office aims to restore and improve facilities, livelihood and living conditions and organizational capacities of affected communities and reduce disaster risks in accordance with the *“building back better”* principle. Such program was implemented in 2022.

With the help and active participation of the community and the Provincial Government of Isabela, the Office instituted proactive measures in reducing disaster risk factors. The Provincial Government of Isabela always saw to it that the communities affected are always assisted in restoring their living conditions by rebuilding their livelihood and damaged infrastructures. The Office also extended efforts in providing humanitarian assistance to lessen the burden of victims of natural disasters during recovery and capacitating the community by conducting Community Based Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (CBDRRM) Trainings and other disaster and complex emergency related trainings to better prepare them should disaster come.

III. OUR MISSION

“The program thrust of the **PROVINCIAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (PDRPMC)** of the Province of Isabela shall be pursued by keeping all member-agencies ready in terms of Training, Equipment and Personnel. The PDRPMC’s inherent duty for public safety dictates the provision of ***Area Security, Search and Rescue, Recovery, Evacuation, Relief Operations and Rehabilitation*** of affected areas in the province.

IV. NOTABLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS FOR 2022

Gawad KALASAG (Kalamidad at Sakuna Labanan, Sariling Galing Ang Kaligtasan) Search for Excellence in DRRM and Humanitarian Assistance serves as a recognition and award scheme of the country for various stakeholders who promote and implement DRRM, climate change adaptation and humanitarian programs that protect and shield high-risk communities against extreme hazards and render them more capable of addressing their vulnerabilities.

December 14, 2022 – The Province of Isabela received an award for being “Fully Compliant” in the National Gawad KALASAG Seal for Excellence in Disaster Risk Reduction and Management and Humanitarian Assistance.

On behalf of Gov. Rodito T. Albano III, PDRRM Officer, Atty. Constante A. Foronda Jr., received the award during the 22nd Gawad Kalasag National Awarding Ceremony held at The Manila Hotel, on December 7, 2022.

Fully compliant Local Government Units (LGUs) are those that generally adhere to the standards for the establishment and functionality of the DRRMOs.

Our ultimate goal in Isabela had always been to serve the people. The opportunity to serve and raising the bar in the culture of preparedness and resiliency is a reward in itself, far more important than all the awards and accolades combined.

A. ON DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

PDRRMO/DART Rescue 831 continued to acquire brand new rescue equipment to add to its existing stocks/inventory, installed a repeater antenna and equip rescuers in fulfilling its growing mandate.

Enumerated below are few of its acquisitions:

- a. three (3) units Toyota Hi-Lux pick-up truck and four (4) units Hyundai H100 to enhance the transport capability of the Office and of the DART Rescue 831;
- b. five (5) units Porta-Bote rescue boat with 15hp outboard motor;
- c. one (1) unit Barracuda rescue boat with 40hp OBM and trailer;

- d. twelve (12) units 40hp outboard motor;
- e. one (1) unit Isuzu Elf boom truck;
- f. fifteen (15) units mobile base and handheld radio

B. ON DISASTER RESPONSE

March 7, 2022 – The City Government of Puerto Princesa, Palawan headed by City Mayor Lucilo Bayron awarded the Provincial Government of Isabela with the 2022 MAYOR’S AWARD during the culminating events of Puerto Princesa City’s 150th Founding Anniversary held at Puerto Princesa Garden Island Resort on March 3, 2022.

The 2022 “Heroism” Mayor’s Awards were conferred in recognition of modern-day heroes – individuals and organizations – who served and voluntarily aided those devastated by Typhoon “Odette”, for love of God and man, seeing themselves connected with humanity and local communities of Puerto Princesa City.

On behalf of Gov. Rodolfo T. Albano III, the award was received by Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer, P/BGEN Jimmy U. Rivera Sr. (Ret.), MNSA, CESE.

The Provincial Government of Isabela dispatched two teams of “Project: Isabela Loves Visayas and Mindanao” on what is dubbed as their “longest mission” to date, a 28-day humanitarian and relief operation from January 27 to February 15, 2022 to communities affected by Typhoon “Odette” in Visayas and Mindanao.

C. PLANS, PROGRAMS, AND ACTIVITIES

- a. Conducted continuing training and education to enhance the already acquired knowledge and skills of the Provincial and Municipal DRRM Councils through participatory and community-based vulnerability assessments as the baseline data to mainstream Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) and Climate Change Adaptation (CCA) in local development planning process from provincial to city/municipal down to barangay levels;
- b. Seventy-six (76) trainings were conducted for 2,251 participating individuals from the AFP, Provincial Government of Isabela (Safety Officers), LGUs and Rescue Groups in the province, and Hospitals inside and out of the province. The trainings conducted were DOH mandated Basic Life Support with Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation and Standard First Aid, Ambulance Management Training Course and Weather Monitoring.
- c. Technical Rescue Training was participated by representatives of the different municipalities and rescue teams in the province. The trainings conducted were, 4 Rope Rescue Technician Course participated by 135 individuals, 4 Water Search and Rescue (WASAR) participated by 107 Individuals, 1

Mountain Search and Rescue (MOSAR) participated by 80 individuals, and 1 Flood Swift Water Rescue participated by 20 individuals.

- d. Provision of guidance to Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils of all Local Government Units (LGUs);
- e. LDRRMO General Assembly Meeting conducted last December 21, 2021
- f. Acquisition of rescue equipment and individual accoutrements, for DART Rescue 831 personnel;
- g. Maintained all records of emergency/rescue responses and monitoring of the weather disturbances that may enter our area of responsibility;
- h. Prepared DART Rescue 831 Personnel to respond in any worst-case scenarios, unfortunate and catastrophic and emergencies through skillful, keen and incisive planning - Incident Command System - Incident Action Plan (ICS-IAP) and preparation;
- i. Actively participated in the prevention, control and other activities of the Provincial Task Force on Covid-19 and other Emerging Infectious Diseases by following and assisting the PITF on Covid-19 in the strict enforcement of the guidelines and protocols imposed by the National Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF); and
- j. Performed other functions, duties and responsibilities as maybe directed by the Provincial Governor and Chairman of the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council.

E. LIMITATIONS/CHALLENGES

- a. Operational control of the different Rescuers during typhoons, floods and other complex emergencies;
- b. Oversight powers of the PDRRM Council Chairman over the LDRRMOs in the province; and

- c. Continuous acquisition of rescue equipment to be able to assist under-equipped LDRRMO's.

F. RECOMMENDATIONS

- a. Approval, acquisition and installation of the Radio Communications Plan submitted to the Provincial Governor in preparation for the completion of the Provincial Emergency Operation Center (PEOC).
- b. Creation and activation of DRRM Satellite Offices in the coastal municipalities of Divilacan and Palanan to assist the LDRRMC, rescuers and the coastal people in times of calamities and disasters.
- c. Construction of a covered garage for the newly acquired rescue vehicles, most especially the ambulances, the 27-footer fiber rescue boat, rigid hull inflatable boats (RHIB), rubber boats, and other rescue equipment to protect them from deteriorating due to exposure.
- d. Construction of a technical rescue building to serve as the structure for the conduct of training for emergency response personnel to perform rescue operations safely, efficiently, and effectively in the event of any emergencies. This will serve as a venue that can offer several trainings for confined space rescue, extrication, technical rope rescue, and disaster operations.

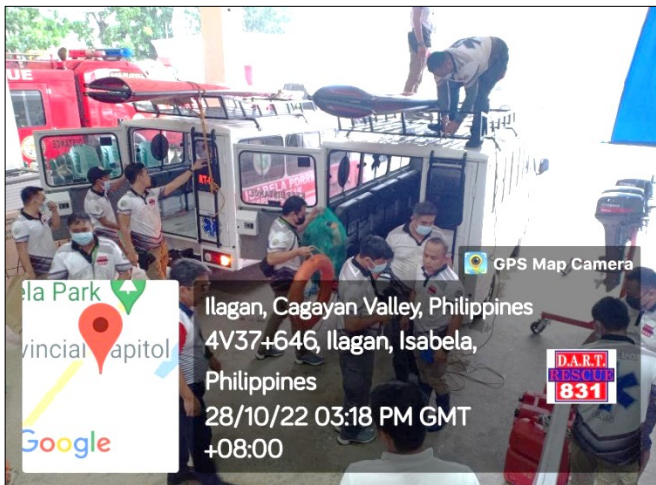

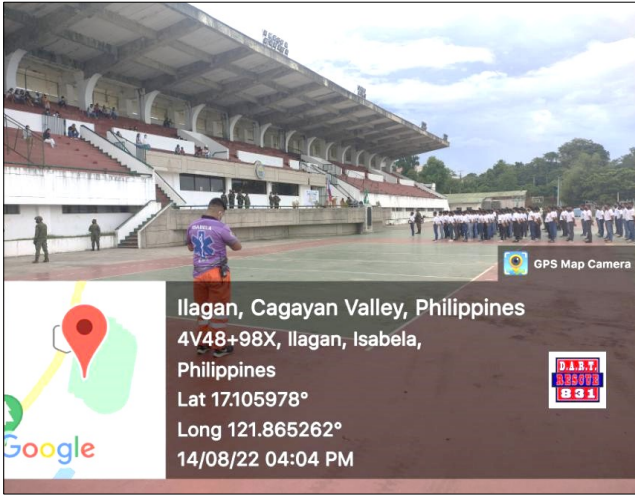

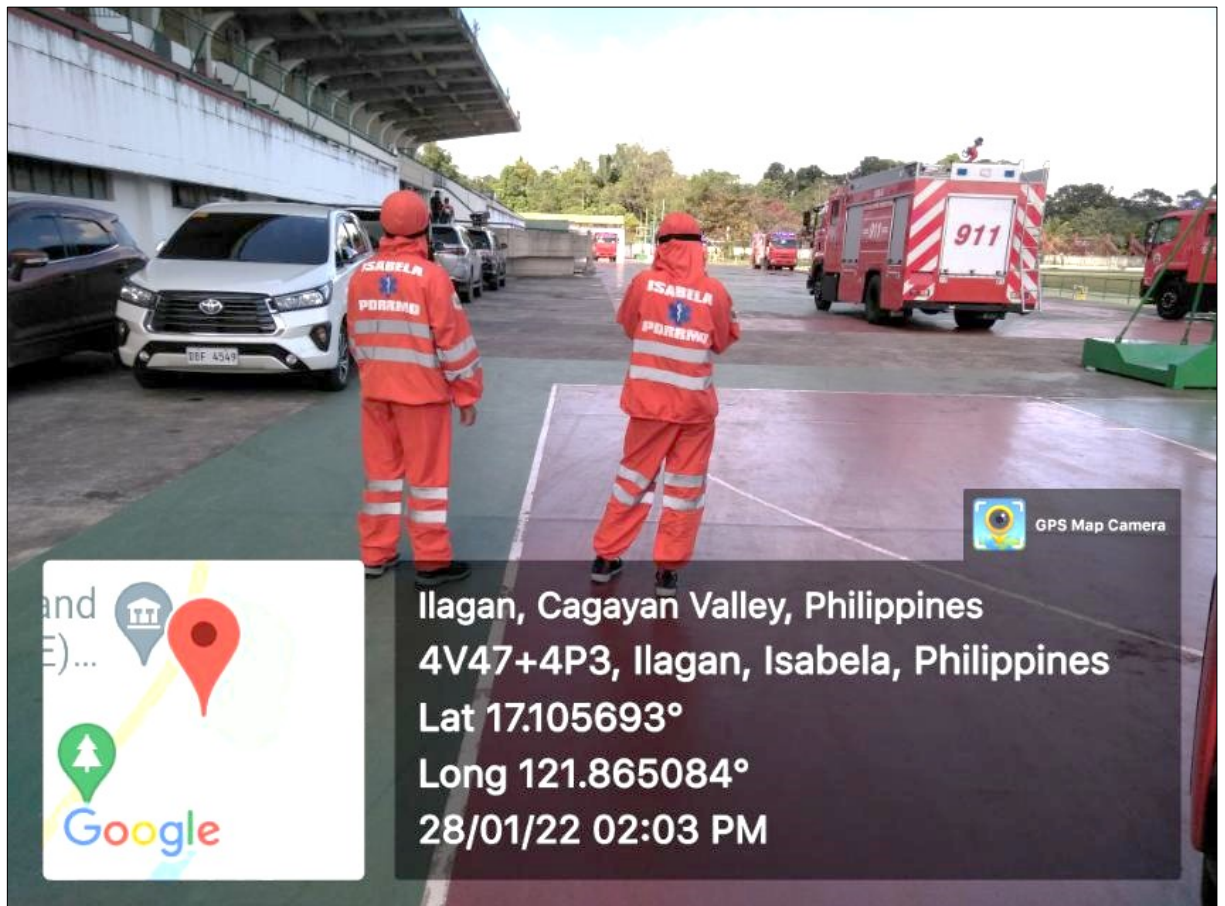
