RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ISABELA, REPRESENTED BY THE GOVERNOR, HON. RODOLFO T. ALBANO, III, THE SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT OF MEDICAL EQUIPMENT TO BE AWARDED TO GCMED PHARMACEUTICAL DISTRIBUTOR FOR HOSPITAL USE

WHEREAS, to effect responsive, accessible, comprehensive, efficient and immediate response to procure medical equipment to be awarded to GCMED PHARMACEUTICAL DISTRIBUTOR for hospital use, there is a need to procure goods using the Small Value Method of Procurement;

WHEREAS, Section 53 of R.A 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, provides for Negotiated Procurement whereby the Procuring Entity directly negotiated a contract with a technically, legally and financially capable supplier, contractor or consultant;

WHEREAS, Section 53.9 provides for Small Value Procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting Services, where the amount involve does not exceed the threshold prescribed in Annex "H" of this IRR: Provided, that in case of Goods, the Procurement does not fall under shopping in Section 52 of this IRR;

WHEREAS, upon review of the mode and the need to procure, the Committee recommends to procure through the Small Value Procurement Method;

THEREFORE, THE BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE RESOLVES AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED TO RECOMMEND THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ISABELA, REPRESENTED BY THE GOVERNOR, HON. RODOLFO T. ALBANO, III, TO ADOPT THE SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT OF MEDICAL EQUIPMENT TO BE AWARDED TO GCMED PHARMACEUTICAL DISTRIBUTOR FOR HOSPITAL IN PURSUANT TO AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 53.9 OF R.A. 9184;
