**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO MEDSTATION BIOLOGICALS INCORPORATED FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF FLU VACCINE THROUGH NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER EMERGENCY CASES FOR VACCINATION PURPOSES USE**

**WHEREAS**, on March 9, 2020, the President signed Proclamation No. 922 declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines upon the recommendation of the DOH following the confirmed local transmission of the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19);

**WHEREAS**, to address the concern for the declaration of State of Public Health Emergency, a Resolution No. 2020-09-4 was enacted by Sangguniang Panlalawigan declaring the whole Province of Isabela under state of calamity due to the spread of African Swine Fever and 2019 Corona Virus Disease;

**WHEREAS**, despite government efforts, COVID-19 cases continue to rise, hence, proclamation 1281 was thereafter issued, extending the period of State of Calamity throughout the country for a period of one (1) year, effective September 13, 2021 to September 12, 2022;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Republic Act No. 10121, or the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010," the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council has recommended the further extension of the declared State of Calamity throughout the Philippines in order for the National Government and Local Government Units (LGUs) to continuously deliver COVID-19 related interventions, such as, but not limited to, COVID-19 vaccination program; utilize appropriate funds, including the Quick Response Fund, in their disaster preparedness and response efforts to contain the spread of COVID-19; monitor and control prices of basic necessities and prime commodities; and provide basic services to the affected populations;

**WHEREAS**, Presidential Proclamation No. 57 dated September 12, 2022 has been issued to further the extension of the period of State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Corona Virus Disease 2019 declared under Proclamation No. 929, S. 2020, as extended under Proclamation No. 1021, S. 2020 and Proclamation No. 1218, S. 2020

**WHEREAS**, in response to the current State of Public Health Emergency and State of Calamity, the BAC intends to procure Flu Vaccine; essential in compliance with the minimum health standards for COVID-19 mitigation;

**WHEREAS**, Section 53.2 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184 allows the resort of emergency purchase subject to conditions required by law;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC sees it proper to conduct emergency purchase of vaccines in connection with the public health emergency declared by the President of the Philippines throughout the country and the state of calamity declared by the Governor of the Province throughout the province;

WHEREAS, the BAC directly negotiated with a legally, technically and financially capable supplier namely, MEDSTATION BIOLOGICALS INCORPORATED;

WHEREAS, the offer of MEDSTATION BIOLOGICALS INCORPORATED was found to be responsive and compliant with the requirements set by the BAC;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE, HEREBY RESOLVES AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED TO RECOMMEND TO THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ISABELA, REPRESENTED BY THE GOVERNOR, HON. RODOLFO T. ALBANO, III, THE AWARD OF CONTRACT THROUGH NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER EMERGENCY CASES TO MEDSTATION BIOLOGICALS INCORPORATED FOR THE PROCUREMENT AND DELIVERY OF FLU VACCINE FOR VACCINATION PURPOSES USE PURSUANT TO AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 53 OF R.A. 9184;
