The registration started upon the arrival of participants coming from the 42 Baragays of Jones, Isabela. Few minutes passed 8:00 in the morning; the program begun with the invocation and followed by the singing of the National Anthem lead by the teachers of Jones, afterwhich is the Isabela Hymn which was sang in Ilocano dialect. Mr. John Soriano, presented the different basic services the PGI offers and acknowledged focal personnel in charge in each services like on Agriculture (BROs ASP, PPP, PSP, LAMFP, PAIWI and livelihood); Health (BROs Healthcare & PhilHealth); Insurance (BROs PNB Gen & SSS); Scholarship (BRO Education) for their children and Nutrition (BRO Lusog).

It was 9:00 in the morning, the arrival of Gov. Bojie Dy, III, Vice Gov. Tony pet Albano, together with the Board Members headed by Hon. Abegail V. Sable, Hon. Alfredo V. Halili, with LMB President Hon. Francisco "Kiko" Dy and The Municipal Mayor of Jones and Vice Mayor Ronaldo Lucas. Hon. Letty Sebastian. Go after was Hon. Leticia Sebastian who delivered her welcome address to all the participants and other personnel present in the said event. Just after her speech, Gov. Bojie Dy, III delivered his most awaited message where he highlighted each of the said services the PGI offers. . He then discussed what could be the benefits to our fellow farmers the PGI programs offers. Commissioner on Climate Change Hon. Heherson Alvarez talks appreciated the production of different crops in the province wherein he marks the province as one of the largest crops producers in the country.

Subsequently, after highlighting the basic services of the Province, together with the officials present in the event, Gov. Bojie Dy, III awarded the bereaved family of Mr. Sacramento, a farmer who met an accident recently, the family received financial assistant followed by the awarding of SSS Card to farmers. There were 700 and more participants in the said event.
